SERIES -- This is the 16th time Texas and LSU have played. The series began in 1896, LSU scoring a 14-0 victory. The last renewal was in 1954 with Texas winning 20-6. This is their first bowl-game meeting.

WEATHER -- 54 degrees; wind SW @ 13 MPH; 86% humidity. Forecast: Partly cloudy, temperature expected to rise to 60 degrees by 4 p.m., approximate time this game will be winding up.

COIN TOSS -- LSU captain 78 Miller; Texas co-caps 31 Culpepper, 61 P. McW's. LSU won the toss and elected to receive; Texas chose to defend the south goal -- to your right. That gives UT the advantage of the wind, such as it is.

Statement from LSU Coach Charles McClendon:

As the television crew finished its dressing room interview with LSU Coach Charles McClendon, he remarked, "it sure is good to be on TV, winner take all." (This has been his policy in previous LSU TV games where he said he would not be on television for a post game interview if his team lost).

Concerning the game itself, he said it was a "cleanly played well officiated game. It was tough out there. Just ask our players and they will tell you how tough Texas was, and I am sure that they & (Texas) would say the same about us.

"We came over to Dallas to have a good time, and we had a good time. Our players enjoyed themselves and worked hard to make a good showing. It was, like all victories, a team effort.

"I was extremely proud of the whole team, and especially proud of our 18 seniors. They gave us the leadership again today that they have consistently given all year and it was a pleasure to coach such a dedicated group of ~~big~~ young men.

"Texas is a strong team and let no one deny it. They did ~~not~~ not go undefeated by accident in the competition they faced all season. We knew that we would be in for 60 minutes of football and we got 60 minutes of football.

"The complicated defenses that Texas was throwing at us--I believe they were stunting more than usual--forced us to throw the ball more. Our reverse away from the motion was our most ~~and~~ consistently successful running play, because their linebackers were going with the motion.

"I did not feel safe with a 10 point lead going into the fourth quarter, because Texas has come back many times this year."

The Tiger coach was proudly displaying the game ball presented to him by tackle Fred Miller, the LSU captain. "They gave me the first one (after the Tigers trimmed Texas A&M in the season opener, 21-0) and they gave me the last one."
