QUOTES FROM MISSISSIPPI STATE HEAD COACH PAUL DAVIS:

"ISU ran their sweep real well on us and hurt us outside early in the game, especially with that option play.

"As a matt r of fact, they may have run outside a little sit more than we expected them to."

When asked why he chose to kick off after winning the opening toss of the coin, Davis said: "It was a wet field and we felt that if we gave them the football first, any early miscakes because of the field would be in our favor.
