"Needless to say, we're happy to have won. I think it was a typical LSU game. Coach McDonald and his staff had them ready to play."

"They had the ball an awful lot. I think that we made some big plays and that was what won it for us. I don't know everyone who made a big play. I know that Wayne Adkinson came from a mile away to cover on that halfback pass they threw."

"I probably made a mistake in not substituting more. Some of our physical people got tired in the fourth quarter. But we felt that we had to have them in there so much."

"We had some people hurt that we lost for awhile during the game. Musao, of course, Adkinson, Basco. And of course Wade didn't play at all."

We played good enough to win, but I said before the game Alabama didn't make many mistakes and yet we had to keep our mistakes at a minimum. Unfortunately we had three important turnovers or mistakes and that's enough to beat you when you're playing a team like Bama.

Our defense was just sensational. They went right at them and contained them. After all they only scored one touchdown and it's been a long time since anyone's held Alabama to only one touchdown. Our boys were ready and they did themselves proud. They never quit even though we had a lot of bad breaks.

Our field position was terrible virtually the entire game, but we stayed right in there. We had trouble getting our passing game going in the first half, but it clicked better in the second half and we were in it all the way.

I'm proud of the Tigers and they showed a national television audience what kind of stuff they're made of.
