Our problems...rather obvious...at halftime we were in range and then we made mistakes defensively at the start of the second half.

LSU has fine quarterbacks. Jones throws the ball well, and they have fine receivers. Lyons runs better than Jones, but they both compliment each other.

Mark Green got a hip pointer in the first quarter. He only played one series.

I was disappointed in the mistakes we made. On the interception, we didn't ~~xxxx~~ read the coverage, didn't pick it up.

In spots our defense played well, ~~xxx~~ real well. Our secondary had its good moments and its bad ones. We gave Jones too much time at times.

No, I won't compare LSU with Nebraska. They are both fine football teams.

The turning point was letting them ~~fx~~ get that first score of the second half. Then the interception made us play catch up ball.

LSU has a fine defensive team. They are quick and aggressive. Sure, we made mistakes, but then LSU had something to do with it too.

There was some ~~finxse~~ finesse out there tonight by the Tigers. We managed to break those tendencies we established last week and that helped us move the ball and go for some big plays. Those Aggies are tough at the line of scrimmage, making us go outside quite a bit

Dantin sure had a lot of zip out there. He really ran that football.

Once again that tandem quarterback system paid off. Lyons spelling Jones, set them up so Bert could have another ~~fine~~ great night. He's gotta be one of the best in the country. I called that last touchdown play, the one that was nullified. It wasn't intended to 'pour' it on the Aggies, it was because no other LSU player has ever thrown four touchdown passes in one game and we wanted him to have the chance. He did it, but that penalty killed it.

The Tigers just before we came out for the second half seemed like they were losing, but they got fired up and we went out and won and won big. We're going to keep our fans loose, I can tell you. We may not play consistent football, but it'll be exciting.
