QUOTING AUBURN HEAD COACH RALPH JORDAN:

Obviously LSU came to play and took the momentum from the beginng...After we got the interception and scored I thought we might catch fire but obviously that didn't happen... When they got that touchdown right before the half we had to start doing some things we din't want to do and that is play catch up...It lloked like we were going to intercept that pass but give credit to the LSU receiver for just taking it away... Also, I thought Bert Jones did a masterful job on those first two drives...He got them on top and they stayed hot...If anybody had told me before the game that LSU would run over and around us anf pass at will I never would have believed it,ibut they did... They thouroughly dominated play all night...Jones was hot but he had a lot of help... I was somewhat encouraged by the way the second offense movedthe ball near the end... Some of those people were playing for the first time this year, but I think they'll be playing some more from now on...Chris Linderman played for the first time and he looks like he can rest Henley some.

CHARLES MC CLENDON, LSU

This was beyond my fondest dream. I never thought when I became head coach that I would be the man to erase Coach Moore's record. Every boy who has worn the Purple and Gold since I have been here deserves the crêdit for this accomplishment. Charles Povey and Doug Hamley have been with me since the first year and Dave McCarty came along in 1963. But all the coaches deserve the credit. Tonight they got these boys ready and wasn't it great. It was nice becoming the winningest coach in LSU history, but what makes it even nicer is doing it by beating a fine ball club like Auburn.

t touchdown pass at the end of the first half swung things back our way. Lynn LeBlanc thought of using that play and it was somethin;. That Brad Boyd did a great job of taking the ball away from the Auburn defender.

And how about that goal line stand at the end of the game. They really bowed their necks and stopped them.
