LSU defends the north goal. Temperature at kickoff is 72 degrees, with winds from the southeast at five miles per hour. Humidity is 82%. The field is wet from late afternoon rains.

Betanzos kicks off to Cunningham at the 8, fumbled, and recovered by LSU's Andrews at the 16. Cunningham gets an 8-yard kickoff return.

## HOW TO READ THE PLAY-BY-PLAY

The play-by-play, a new method of telling you exactly what happens in LSU's games, is just like the media types use in writing traditional game stories on LSU football. Now, you have a record of every play. At the beginning of each section the team of possession is listed with the time it took over the ball.

The time listed after team means the time that school took possession of the ball. LSU 13:00 means LSU got the ball with 13:00 minutes left in the quarter.

The figures before each play are the yardline the team took over, and the down and yardsage situation. L20 1-10 means LSU's plays starts from its own 20 with a first and 10.
