

QUOTES FROM LSU HEAD COACH JERRY STOVALL

"We did not have the consistency out there tonight which would allow us to win. We had 2 plays at the half and only 10 points to show for it, so the offense did not show any onsistency. The defense forced us to do different things, and they blitzed well, and we could not beat anyone without good offensive consistency."

"Garry James got injured in the first half and did not play in the second. We expect that he will be back next week. We also expect Mike Gambrell to be back next week. I am not aware of any other injuries which would keep players out of the game next Saturday."

"There were almost eight minutes left in the game when I decided to kick the field goal because I didn't know what the next eight minutes would hold. We were looking to get points out of the drive and get the ball back two or three more times. We always look to get points out of our drives, but if there had been less time left in the game, we might have decided to do something different."

"You don't like to here the boos from the stands when you make a decision like the field goal call. It means there are a lot of people second guessing your decision, but you can't let their reactions determine the decisions you have to make as the coach."

"I think the teams we face primarily try to take the run away from us. If they can get Dalton and Garry out of the attack, than that's what they will try to do."

"I think there were a combination of things which hindered our passing game tonight. The coverages were good, sometimes we held the ball a little too long, there may have been some pattern run incorrectly, or maybe we could have thrown the ball away in a couple of instances. I think it was a combination of these things which hurt us tonight rather than having one factor which hurt the passing game."

"Eric Martin had another excellent night, and he is just a class wide receiver. He caught seven or eight balls and he was really hit hard a couple of times, but he had another outstanding game for us."

"We'll go back to the drawing board for work this week. I'm not looking to make any personnel changes just because of the outcome of tonight's game. We will study the films to see exactly what we did, and if the grades warrant any changes, they will be made. I have never made a change where a grade didn't warrant it, I don't deal that way."

QUOTES FROM THE KENTUCKY LOCKEROOM

HEAD COACH JERRY CLAIBORNE:

"We made so many mistakes and still came back to win the game. That was the great part of the victory. We are just elated to have our first SEC win."

"I'm proud of how our players came back to win. The defense was outstanding tonight.

In the second half the offense did a much better job. We made some first downs to give
us some field position. The special teams also did a great job of keeping that field position

"Our pass rush was outstanding tonight. We were rushing the passer most of the night with three and four people which allowed us to get more people back in the pass coverage."

"They've been throwing the short-ball a lot so we weren't suprised by the great number of short passes they threw. We tried to give the short one up but not one deep."

QUARTERBACK RANDY JENKINS:

"Tiger Stadium is a great place to play. On our first drive we couldn't hear and had to cut our splits down so everybody could hear the signals."

"We tried to spread their defense out more on reverses in the second half because they are so tough up the middle. We were able to do this because we had field position, we didn't have that in the first half. You can't open up back at your own fifteen yard line."

"I didn't think they had respect for us coming in but I think they do now."

DEFENSIVE TACKLE JEFF SMITH:

"We were prepared for their toss sweeps. Their formations and their linemen tipped off many of their plays. Right before the first half we felt we could tell what plays they were going to run."

"Their tackles are big but a little slow. But they were very strong."

"The good pressure we were able to put on the quarterback without blitzing helped our linebackers out a lot in their coverage."
