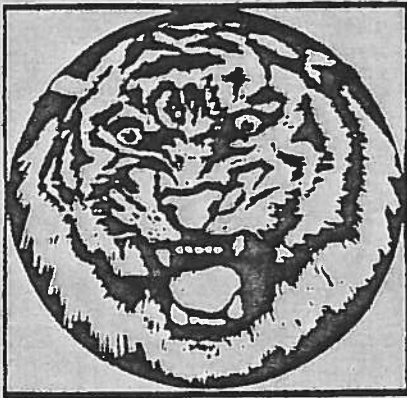

South Carolina wins the toss and defer their choice to the second half (new NCAA rule).  
LSU elects to receive.  
South Carolina will kick off and defend the north goal.
