QUOTES FROM HEAD COACH JERRY STOVALL

"I think you saw out there tonight what the wishbone is supposed to do. They were able to move the ball down the field, they kept possession of the ball and they ran the clock. It seemed as if they kept the ball for the entire 60 minutes of the game and we couldn't get it. The defense, also, didn't play very well."

"We wanted to do three things against the 'bone--stop the dive, the quarterback and the pitch, but we were unable to do all three. The defense was poor all night, lots of arm-tackling. We did come up with a couple of turnovers which we turned into scores, but overall our defense was poor, and that's very upsetting to me."

"We ran the ball well tonight, especially Garry James. He broke a long run for us for a score, and that's something we haven't had much of this season. The running game and our ability to score points after turnovers were a few of the bright spots out there tonight."

"We did sustain a number of injuries during the course of the game. Jeffery Dale, of course did not play a down tonight, and he may be back next week. Rydell Malancon broke his forearm during the first half and couldn't return. Tommy Campbell injured a knee, and I don't know if surgery will be required. Jeff Brignac hurt a leg and Steve Rehage bruised a hand and it may be broken."

"We just have to forget our record and prepare the same way for Tulane as we have all year. We will have a couple of days off which we normally don't have, but basically we will have the same routing as always."

"I think we played together as a unit for the past two ball games before tonight. The defense particularly has come a long way during that period. They rose from last to fourth in the conference as a unit, but they played tonight as if they had never seen the wishbone. They've really worked hard and tried hard as a unit and they had begun to really jell, but tonight's effort gave no indication of the progress we've made."

Concerning the question of the team's reaction to the rumors of the coaching position:

"I certainly hope the team hasn't been affected by what has been going on. You read and hear many things through the papers, the radio and television and it makes it hard to keep everything in perspective. I think the team has done a great job of not thinking about whatever they hear. This team just wants to play football."
