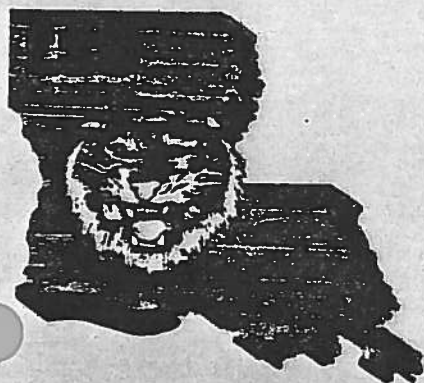

Bill Arnsperger (LSU head coach) -- "This was a big win for us. It was an exciting game for the fans. There are nothing like these (LSU) fans. My heart goes out to them. They (the fans) were instrumental in the victory. I'm sure they've been instrumental for a long time, but I'm the new kid on the block."

(On Arizona's last offensive play) "That was a big play. Jeffery Dale made a big it. He (Alfred Jenkins) tried to fumble the ball out of bounds (for the first down)."

(On LSU's defense) "(Coach) Archer and the rest of the defensive assistants did a great job. I was pleased with our defense all night. We had a lot of good hits. We got good pressure on him (Jenkins) all night. But he's a fine athlete and broke containment."

"I was proud of our offense. They finally held in there and got some points. We've started a (winning) streak, now we have to keep up."

ARIZONA COACH LARRY SMITH'S POST-GAME COMMENTS:

"It was a hell of a close ballgame. I'm especially proud of defense; they were on the field an awful long time. I'll tell you, one of these days we're going to win one in the last minute, you wait and see."

"I really felt we had to get it at the 40 (on Arizona's last drive), because a 60-yard field goal is not a high percentage. I thought that percentage (from 40 yards) was much better -- to get the first down on third-and-four and then be in position for the field goal after that."

"In the second half, we started executing and got it rolling. But we had a penalty that knocked us back. The big thing was when they completed that pass down there in the endzone."

"He didn't call that on me (on second-half personal foul called on an assistant coach). Somebody said something to the official, but the guy they called it on was standing right there by me and he didn't say a word. It was a heresay penalty, I tell you."
