

"Teah. I think if you watch TV you'll see I was in from the waist up. I don't know what he (the referee) was looking at but I was over the goal line.

"Car defense did the job. They kept LSU out of the endzone. Execution by the offense. We didn't have it.

"I thought it would be a lot higher scoring personally. If we can play the way we're capable of playing it will be a good game.

"This is one of the toughest losses, especially after reading exexymments the papers with everyone saying how we're low lifes and that we're from the weakest conference. If the SEC's the best, we're not far behind. I didn't see many of the 75,000 leaving early.

What about your postgame meeting with LSU's Shawn Burks?

"He's a great dude. We were talking after the game. It was just two guys getting together and saying a prayer. They have a lot of quality proprie guys on their defense."

DID YOU THINK YOU WOULD COME BACK AFTER HURTING YOUR ANKLE?

"I was really optimistic. I've never had a feeling like that before. I heard a pop and it was numb but there were no broken bones. They think its pulled muscles. It hurt but you have to play with pain.

LSI was about what we expected. They were aggressive against the run. They looked like they were not used to covering against the pass but they have some great athletes back there and they made up for it with their ability. They are a class team with class people. It's fun to play against teams like that.

I though Steve scored. People have a habit of blowing him dead early because he gives it a fifth and sixth effort. LSU put up a good stand and they held us. That's what the defense is supposed to do."

CS. Coach Leon Fuller

I thought we played hard, not well. Our mistakes were critical at times. LSU made some good plays when they had to.

AT 11:24 OF FOURTH QUARTER CSU FAILED ON 1-YARD TD RUN BY STEVE BARTALO - I thought we scored. When you're on the road in a different conference you have to knock it in 3 yards for it to count.

Q5 RELLY STOUFFER WENT OUT OF THE GAME IN THE FIRST QUARTER AND WAS REPLACED BY FRESHMAN CHRIS RULE -- It hurt us when Kelly went out. We had to alter our game plan a great deal in the second half. I think we could've be a real-threat-to-secre more or a trhreat to score with Kelly in there. We ran the football more (with Rule) so he could get his confidence. He (Rule) made some freshmen mistakes.

Quotes from LSU Coach Bill Arnsaparger:

"Fifteen-yard penalties make it tough defensively. With all the pushing and shoving we'll have to something to stop it."

"The defense played well all night. Offensively we had problems in the first half. In the second half we came back out, worked at things we do well, and the defense continued to play well."

"We're just happy to get number two."

"You don't have bad offense if you don't have to punt. We had tremendous improvement but the 15-yard penalties are disturbing. It destroys you and they were unnecessary."

"A big plus on defense was when we came up with the goal-line stand."

(On starting slow): "We still kept our poise and knew what we could do."

(On Stouffer): "He's a fine quarterback. He came back with a real gutty performance. I really respect the guy. When he was out I'm sure it hurt their offense. He's as good a passing quarterback as we'll face."
