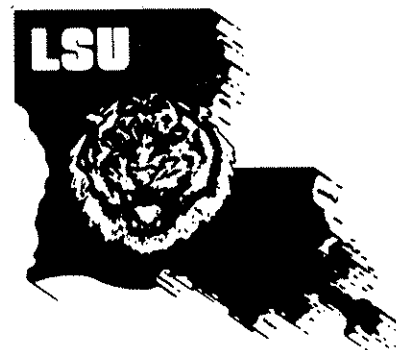

"The game was a great tribute to the Miami team. They came and played hard, they played with enthusiasm, they played with excitement, and it's a great tribute to a great bunch of guys.

"Our football team didn't possess those things. Football is a game that involves physical and emotional desire. Our emotion was false, our enthusiasm was false, our desire was false, and our excitement was false. When that happens you're going to get beat. Tonight was a good example of that.

"I'm really in a daze, we had aspirations to win this thing and gosh, it's great for us to win this thing as a whole. We spent a lot of time in the winter getting ready for them. We knew this would be the biggest game of the year for us and following last week's disappointing loss, this is even sweeter. We played as well as we could for as long as we could and it was a tribute to our team.

Linebacker Pete Mather: "Hey, we went out there and tried to do what we do best. We played tough, hard-nosed defense and we just concentrated and I think we wanted it more than they did. We haven't had one of these wins in a long time. People are going to stop and read about it tomorrow and say, 'No way.'"

"I think they were looking back at the A&M win and looking ahead to Florida. They had the 75,000 fans for them but we put it to our best use. I just think they didn't execute the plays. They were trying their hardest, I'm sure. Possibly they were practicing this week after a big win over A&M and coming on to play a MAC team like Miami, they weren't ready for us. Quarterback Terry Morris: (On first quarter TD pass to Andy Schillinger) -- "They hadn't been covering Andy all night on the deep pass. We ran a few other plays and they never looked at him, they didn't pay attention to him. So we decided to go to him deep just to see what would happen. We got him before in other games and it turned out O.K."

We were streaking all three receivers -- the tight end, our X and our Z. It's basically my choice and Andy broke on him and had him beat the whole time."

This is a great win. We call it a "Tomahawk Victory." Anytime we win outside the league that's a "Tomahawk Victory." And we knocked off the No. 7 team in the nation and it's a pretty good feeling."

We knew we would have to be balanced and they did shut down our running attack somewhat. We were able to run a little bit at times. Coming in we knew we were going to have to throw the ball to beat them. We were able to take what they gave us. We didn't put on a spectacular display but we did what we had to do to win."
