LSU PLAYER QUOTES

KEITH MELANCON (OG) -- (On the problems with blocking): "It was our fault.

We didn't give Tommy enough time to throw the ball.

If you dont give him the time to throw, then the entire offensive scheme will be affected."

(On the Nebraska rush): "They rushed the passer real well today, they just made it difficult for us to throw the ball. When they would rush three men, there would be eight men on the coverage making it tough. We had to pick up the four man blitz in order for the passing game to be effective and we didn't."

TOBY CASTON (LB) -- (On the game in general): "It's real depressing because people seem to only remember you for your final performance and in my final one, we were blown out."

(On the physical nature of Nebraska): "They were bigger guys than we were, but I think that we were every bit as physical as they were if not more."

- VENDELL DAVIS (WR) -- (On the Nebraska coverage): "They were mostly zoning us on the coverages and putting a lot of pressure on Tommy (Hodson) which obviously made it difficult to throw the ball. When your quarterback can't throw the ball properly, these things are going to happen."
- NACHO ALBERGAMO (C) -- (On the game in general): "They just came out and played better than we did. They didn't physically beat us, they just out-executed us."

(On Danny Noonan): "He's good, but I've played and even practiced against a lot better. I think I did my job on him today."

NOTE: Coach Armsparger will not be available Friday, but will be at his office in Baton Rouge Saturday.

QUOTES FROM LSU HEAD COACH BILL ARMSPARGER

"I think the story of the game is evident. Our offense did not generate anything to move the football and score points. The first half we were physically whipped. We couldn't hold them out (on the offensive line) and when we did we were called for holding."

"The second half we had the opportunity to come back, but we couldn't do anything. Our field position was good and then we would get sacked. Today our players were whipped on the offensive line."

"The defense played well considering the position they were in, but we just could not beat a good Nebraska team today."

"The penalties we committed were physical mistakes. We were not able to get in front of brushing lineman."

"This is as hard a working group as I've ever been associated with. We worked well this week, were able to spend a lot of time viewing films and preparing. I thought our preparation was good."

'On Nebraska defensive line: "They whipped us. They didn't do anything different. You could see that in the films. We didn't protect the quarterback well and that didn't give Tommy (Hodson) enough time to look for the second man. He had to scramble 15 to 20 yards on that first touchdown drive."

On final game as LSU coach: "I thanked the squad for everything they've done. They've done everything we've asked of them for the past three years. We should be judged on what we've done from what happens from here on. They players will go on to be doctors, lawyers, some of them professional football players."

Will you miss coaching: "Yes, I'll miss the association with the players. I told them that. They meant a lot to me as a coach and they mean a lot personally."

"Tom Osbourne said a few weeks ago that Oklahoma had the best personnel in the country, but that Nebraska was not far behind. I think they proved that today."

On turning point in game: "When they blocked that punt. They only got three points out of it, but we lost some critical field position. Another key was our inability to protect the quarterback and give him the opportunity to find the open receiver."

On talk before game among players of two teams: "I don't think talk affects a ballgame. That all stops with the start of the game."

QUOTES FROM NEBRASKA HEAD COACH TOM OSBORNE

"I am really proud of our team this year. In 25 years, 14 as a head coach and 11 years as an assistant coach, I have never been around a team that responded as well to a lot of different problems as this team.

"I was really pleased with our effort today. We had a lot of intensity and played very well even though the game was for not a national championship.

"Our defense did a tremendous job despite bad field position. And our offense did a good job. We wore them down some.

"A bad aspect was the injury to wingback Von Sheppard on the first play. It looks serious and he may have to have knee surgery.

""While we were in a minority in the stands, I was extremely pleased with the way the team handled the crowd.

"I think our players rushing the passer thought they were held a lot. And credit to our people for putting the pressure on Hodson. We noticed in the films he had not been nushed very hard

"I thought the drive at the start of the second half was a big factor and not letting ISU get anything out of the blocked field goal was another factor for us.

This is an awfully nice win for us. We told them we wanted to substitute and do things we had to so we could be dominant in the fourth quarter."

OUOTES FROM NEBRASKA PLAYERS...

Kevin Parsons, LB (on NU Def.) "This was our defenses' biggest game of the year. Our defense and especially the linemen's pass coverage was very aggressive and quick. LSU has a great offensive line, but our intensity was tremendous and we played with hunger and wore them down."

Neil Smith, DT from New Orleans, LA (key point in game) "After they blocked the kick, our defense just kept pushing at them, and we kept yelling we weren't going to let them in the endzone. Broderick Thomas got a big sack, then Noonan got a big one and we just took over from that point."

(On playing at home) "We felt we had a lot to prove after all that happened this week, we gave New Orleans a going away gift. The game was very intense, but once we settled down, we controlled the game."

Danny Noonan, MG (on NU def) "The first series, LSU got some big plays and scored but after that they seemed to lost intensity and we wore them down in the second half. I'd have to say that our pass pressure was the key to the game.

(on comparing this game to two years ago vs. LSU) "I think this time was a lot different. There was a lot more animosity between the players and we got treated a lot differently."

(On importance of game) "This was my last game and it was very important to me and the team. I'm really glad that we could finish 10-2."

Tom Welter, OT "(On difference in 2nd half for NU Offense) "The second half we got our offense going. It was a typical Nebraska game, we kept pushing and eventually we were successful. I knew we were going to wear them out eventually and we did."

(On the NU def.) "They were outstanding!! They made our job a lot easier. They were going crazy out there and getting sack after sack, I felt like we wouldn't have to score any more (at 17-7) because the defense wasn't going to let LSU score."

(On first TD drive) "Coach Osborne got us on the side line and said we had to score before the half, and we knew we had to , we didn't want to be behind at half time."

Steve Taylor, QB, MVP (on being taken out for one series) "I was a little upset. We were strugg'ling at that time, but that's when I like to be in the game. Sitting out, I got my composure back and went back in and got the job done. (after going back in) We were able to wear LSU out and played out type of ballgame--power football, we got our passing game going and we let them know that we are capable of throwing the ball."

(ON MVP award) "It means a lot to me, I have received a MVP award in high school, but never in college. It means a lot because I wasn't picked as an All-Big Eight player, and I feel that now I've proved that I'm that type of player and that I can play on that level."
