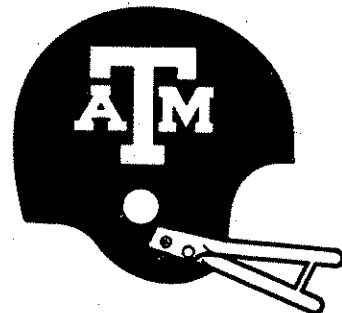

JACKIE SHERRILL QUOTES FROM THE LOCKER ROOM

There's no question that we didn't perform offensively tonight and that's the biggest ~~xxx~~ problem we've got. We struggled and all we got was three downs and a punt. We threw the two interceptions and fumbled the football and so we were pretty well out of it in the first half. I thought the second half we performed well. We moved the ball well and started coming back. Then we moved from our 20 to the one yard line and we didn't put it in there. Then we let them go 99 yards for a touchdown. Our team was kind of tired by then.

Interceptions are going to always kill you. You can't turn the ball over.

(ON a week off before Alabama)--We go back and get ready and put some things in, change a few things and get ready to play Alabama on the 17th.

(QUARTERBACKS)---I thought Chris (Osgood) was able to do some things. He threw the ball extremely well. I thought he had more ~~xxx~~ zip to him than Bucky and Lance. But we didn't give ourselves much of a chance with any of them.

(On Hodson)--"We just couldn't get to him. We were on a different turf. We were on the grass than our regular faster track and that slowed our rush down a little bit. You've got to give them credit. They are a good football team. Hodson makes a big difference in ~~xxx~~ anybody's football team.

They did a good job of protecting Hodson there's no doubt about that. It was in their game plan to get rid of the ball quick and they did a good job about that.

Right now we don't have any cylinders going.
