#### LSU head coach Mike Archer:

"There's not much I can say; I'm extremely proud of our football team. As bad and horrendous everyone said we were last week, we came out tonight and played with pride. I told our football team before we left the hotel this afternoon that Texas A&M would not reach their offensive average (548 yards). I thought our defense played exceptionally well; we should have had a shutout. Some dumb penalties helped them on their scoring drive.

"We gave out two game balls tonight. We gave out a game ball to our defensive coaching staff and we gave a game ball to John Purdy, our trainer. John and his staff basically worked 24 hours a day from the time we got back from Nashville last Saturday to get our players ready. (LSU had 24 players who missed practice time this week with injuries and illness).

"Todd Kinchen is obviously a tremendous athlete. He turned the game in our favor in the second half. Our football team never quit; it was a very emotional win. I hope this is the team that shows up at Florida next weekend. I think when our players see Florida on film, they'll know they're facing maybe the best team in the SEC.

"It's a nice win. Our defense did an exceptional job at the line of scrimmage. We were banged up and I asked our players to play as long and as hard as they possibly could. We played a lot of guys on defense, and that helped us.

"In the second half, it was obvious they were just going to try and knock us off the line of scrimmage. We did some things differently on defense and made some adjustments. We got some breaks -- I think we had four or five turnovers. Our defense played with a lot of pride.

"As young as this team is, I don't know who's going to show up next week."

### MIke Hewitt

About last week

"I wouldn't say embarrassed, I'd say it woke us up. We played our hearts out. We had our chances to win and we didn't take advantage of them."

"This week we did our homework. we lined up and it was just who was going to whip . whose butt."

"Ithink our studying the film really helped us this week."

"That (studying the film) gave us the advantage. That gave us a little confidence."

"I was more pumped this week than I was against Georgia."

### Todd Kinchen

About the 79 yd TD

"We were just going to throw a little underneath pattern adn I was supposed to get what I could...All I did was run behind the purple and gold guys... I made one move, then another and that was it...Just 2 moves..."

How did this week differ from last? "It was incredibly different...We threw the ball underneath more, not a lot deep... I was able to do a lot more..."

About the punt return

"I was just going to fair catch it, but he line drived it, so I thought I'm just going to get what I can... I just made one move and left the rest up to the other guys."

"I don't think they gave up, it was a big emotional knockdown for them, and it was great for us."

"It was just the epitome of what we've been doing...we have a lot of penalties...If we could straighten that out we'd be a much better ball club."

RB Darren Lewis: "I got hit late and the guy pushed me. I pushed back, but I guess I hit him in the head."

OT Matt McCall: "They were a good team. They kept rottating defensive lineman in and that kept them fresh. We didn't play on our level and it really affected us. We tried to run alot, but brought their backers hard and the secondary was hitting good. They were overloading us at the line of scrimmage.

"They came out better prepared and that gave th3em an edge. We wanted to do well. We had a good game plan, but the execution wasn't there."

OLB William Thomas: "They were a whole different team than the one we saw on the fimls. They really got pumped for their home crowd. They came out and did some different things. They were shifting the tight end and once they found something that worked, they stuck with it."

(On Kinchen) "That's exactly what he looked like on film. We jsut needed for someon3e to hit him and hold on to him."

Head Coach R.C. Slocum: "Our inability to move the ball consistently was frustrating. I thought we would be able to score more points than we did. We moved into scoring position early, then Darren (Lewis) got ejected. That penalty really hurt. It took us out of scoring position. You have to credit LSU. There's no question I was disappointed with our special teams play. The blocked punt allowed them to get a field goal. When you lose your starting tailback, it hurts, but Randy (Simmons) came in and made some good plays. The fact that we got a penalty (on the play where Lewis was ejected) hurt us more, probably, than losing Darren. LSU did a good job of playing our option. We've run some option plays in every game this season. Vanderbilt had good success with it against them last week. That was part of our game plan. I think we can still have a good team. We hung in there and played hard. We knew LSU had a bunch of good players. We just came up short. It's not like we were knocked aro8nd. We competed well. It's good for us to play in this kind of game. Lance (Pavlas) didn't have a great night. We had three interceptions in the first half, but that's probably a credit to LSU's defense. There were a couple of throws we shouln'd have thrown.'

#### AGGIE NOTES

\*Texas A&M had not thrown an interception in its three previous games this season. \*Sean Wilson's 66-yard punt in the first half was the longest of his career. LSU Notes after 17-8 win over Texas A&M:

LSU had four interceptions in tonight's game (Derriel McCorvey -- 2; Anthony Marshall and Corey Raymond -- 1 each). The last time the Tigers picked off four passes was last season vs. Mississippi State (a 44-20 LSU win on Nov. 18, 1989 in Tiger Stadium).

The 79-yard scoring pass from Chad Loup to Todd Kinchen was LSU's longest since Tommy Hodson connected with Sammy Martin on an 80-yard strike in a 49-16 win over Rice on Sept. 19, 1987, in Tiger Stadium. The longest scoring pass play in LSU history was an 82-yard TD aerial from Steve Ensminger to Carlos Carson in a 24-17 loss to Georgia on Oct. 14, 1978, in Tiger Stadium.

With 84 yards rushing tonight, LSU's Harvey Williams moved into fourth place on the school's all-time rushing list. Williams now has 2,238 career rushing yards, moving past Brad Davis, who ran for 2,165 yards from 1972-74, and Garry James, who gained 2,217 yards from 1982-85.
