OLE MISS POSTGAME NOTES

** The Rebels shutout LSU for the first time since 1966 when they took a 17-0 victory in Baton Rouge. This was the 28th shutout of the 81-game series, the last shutout was in 1985 when LSU shutout the Rebels 14-0. The last time the Rebels shutout an opponent was Memphis State in 1991, taking a 10-0 victory.

** With a 32-0 victory, the Rebels take their largest margin of victory over the Tigers since 1963 when they defeated LSU 37-3 in Baton Rouge.

** The last time the Rebels defeated LSU in Jackson was in 1975 when they took a 17-13 win.

** The Rebels scored 16 points in third quarter. This is the first points in the third quarter for the Rebels since the Tulane game, the second game of the season.

** Cory Philpot recorded his fourth 100-yard game of the year with 13 carries for 103 yards.

** Sebastian Williams, who started the first five games at offensive tackle before being moved to nose guard, recorded his first career sack against the Tigers tonight. He also had a tackle for a loss, a pass broken up and two tackles.

** Dwayne Amos grabbed two LSU passes tonight. He has three this season. The last time a Rebel had two oskies in one game was Danny Boyd in this year's opener with Auburn.

** Sophomore tight end Chris Turner caught his first career touchdown pass tonight. That was only the third catch of his career.

** With 12 points against the Tigers, Brian Lee now has 190 ~~game points~~ points. He needs 17 points in the remaining three games to become Ole Miss' all-time leading scorer. Bryan Owen currently holds the school record with 206 points from 1985-88.

OLE MISS HEAD COACH BILLY BREWER:

"Well, it's Halloween. This was a great win for our football team. I contend that this team is still improving. If we take things one game at a time, we've got three good games ahead of us."

"A lot of people played well for us tonight both on offense and defense. They have an explosive team with a lot of weapons that can hurt you, but we were able to shut them down when we had to. I think it's been since 1966 when Ole Miss has shut out LSU. The defense played outstanding."

ON FRESHMAN QB LAWRENCE ADAMS:

"Lawrence did some outstanding things. We have two fine, outstanding quarterbacks. He made some option plays where he just jumped through the crack. He's got very good feet and is a very calm and poised athlete. Wherever we were tonight, we'd decided he was going to play the third series."

ON QB RUSS SHOWS:

"Russ responded very well. He's very competitive and he's an athlete. This kid had really played well, and he gets better each week. He's worked so hard and is trying to be a difference on this football team."

OLE MISS PLAYER QUOTES

Cassius Ware-"We played a hard, complete game defensively tonight. A couple of times they made some big plays against us but we would either come up with the big play or grab an interception. Now we have to get ready for a tough game against Memphis State. They seem to play their best against Ole Miss. It will be another game where our defense will have to come with some big plays."

Russ Shows-"Our line played great tonight, as they do week in and week out. We came out and wanted to make things happen offensively. We started slow, but rebounded in the second quarter. Our receivers made some great catches and our backs ran hard. It was an all out offensive effort tonight. We have to build on this win, stay focused and move forward."

Cory Philpot-(on the 56 yard run) "It was a 31 draw designed for me to get outside. I made a cutback and saw a hole. My last cutback I tried to go inside, but I slipped on the grass."

Dewayne Dotson-"I thought we had a pretty good game plan for LSU. We executed and didn't give up the big play. It's a great feeling to get a shutout. We worked hard all week in practice preparing for their offense. This should give us great confidence going into next week's game with Memphis State. They proved today their offense can put up the points."

Lawrence Adams-"The coaches said I might get into the game early against LSU. When they called my number, I was ready to roll. When I am the quarterback, I offense is no different than when Russ is in there. All I can say is when it's time for me to go in, I ready to go. I feel comfortable when I am out there. I just want to contribute."

LSU HEAD COACH CURLEY HALLMAN

"In this kind of game, you have to make good things happen. Tonight, only bad things happened to us. Not to take anything away from Billy and his team, because they put together a good game plan and whipped us tonight."

"I have alot of young guys and the Ole Miss defense did a good job of coming after our inexperienced players."

"Even though we made some mistakes, it wasn't because we weren't prepared. We work on these things at practice every day."

"There are alot more obstacles going to occur than what happened to us tonight. We have to do the little things and not make the mistakes that we made in this ball game."
