POST-GAME QUOTES FROM CURLEY HALLMAN FOLLOWING WIN OVER TULANE

"I think you know how much I appreciate this victory. It's been a long dry spell. It was good for our seniors. They've had a trying time this season. I'm very happy for everyone associated with the LSU program.

"The game was as close as I expected it to be. We did some good things and some bad things during the first half. Our backs ran the ball hard, while Chad (Loup) did an excellent job running the team.

"Rodney (Young) had a big interception there near the end. Corey White played an excellent game. He played real hard. He was one we had doubts about coming in, with his cracked ribs.

"Tulane executed on our mistakes. They did a fine job of taking advantage of what we did wrong.

(Say anything to team at the half?)
"Basically, the only thing I shared with them was the old cliche' that the first
five minutes of the second half is where you have to take charge. You have to set the
tempo in those first five minutes. It's very important. Also, just enjoy yourself and
get excited about playing this ball game.

"In my athletic career, since I was a high school manager under Hootie Ingram, this has been the longest dry spell I've been associated with.

LSU PLAYER QUOTES:

..OBERT TOOMER:

"I'm happy we broke the losing streak, but we still didn't play as well as we could. We are starting to come around a little, but we had a couple of break downs tonight. This really helps us out, but it doesn't erase the entire year. Hopefully we can turn it up a notch now.

"The offensive had more control of things tonight and the offensive line executed well at times. We just kept telling them they were doing a good job and to keep it up."

RODNEY YOUNG:

"This was my first career interception and it felt good. I just broke on the ball. The quarterback threw it straight to me. The receiver was well covered. I was suprised he threw it that way.

"Anytime you go out and play, you want to play well, but we will take the win regardless if its a one point or 70 point win. This game doesn't turn our season around, but its another step in building some positive things."

ANTHONY WILLIAMS:

(On his final game in Tiger Stadium)

"It felt good to have my family down on the field before the game started. I didn't think much about it being my final home game until I was sitting in the locker room and heard the band start playing. I knew then it would be my last time to run out on that field as an LSU player. It sent chills up my spine. I'll never forget that.

"The bottom line was to win this ballgame. Of course we didn't want to lose to Tulane, we wanted to stop this snowballing effect."

Post-game quotes from Tulane coach Buddy Teevens

"It is certainly disappointing. I thought the kids played real hard. We made some mistakes early on that resulted in some scores on their end. We thought we came back and had some opportunities."

On the field goal attempt late in the game....
"We opted for the field goal down close feeling that we would need a field goal to win and we had enough time to get the ball back and do some things. We did get that possession and we had a call that was a little bit tough. I'm still not sure what happened and that ended up being the ball game."

On the turnovers....

"Those (turnovers) hurt us real early, a fumble and an interception both led to scores. You don't want to make those but they did."

On the reversal of the call late in the fourth quarter...
"He (the official) came over to explain. My impression was that he had blown the ball dead, said it was an incomplete pass. The ball slipped out of Billy's hand as he was engaged in the throwing motion. The official said he was going backwards when he let go of the football.

"I don't know, it looked to me his initial call was incomplete pass and thats what we took and then to have another guy come in and overrule the call, I have some difficulty with that."

More on the reversal call....

"Thats the ball game right there. If its an incomplete pass we go down and pick up a first and ten, who knows. But we are not with our backs to the wall giving up six more points."

TULANE PLAYER QUOTES FOLLOWING LSU-TULANE GAME

WR Steve Ballard on the game

"It could have been better if we would have won. We had the opportunity to win, we just didn't get the breaks or the calls."

On tying the Tulane record

"I finally got a record, but it hurts to go out and when you feel like you played well enough to win but still fall short."

On his TD catch

"They played me one on one and blitz and Billy (Duncan) read it well. I used a corner move and had him beat. I saw the end zone and then dove at the five."

QB Billy Duncan on the late fumble...

"I was trying to throw the ball. I thought I was going to throw it and it slippeed out of my hands. I saw thew ball going backwards so I went chasing after it but I also heard the whistle blow. It's just one of those things that happened. I can't blame the whole game on that."

"Turnovers hurt us. We moved the ball and we had things we could do and we hurt ourselves a lot. You have to give them credit because they capitolized when we screwed up."

RB Terrance Strickland on the game....

"There were a few calls that we didn't feel went our way. We had too many turnovers and thgey got the momentum going in the second half. Things just didn't go our way."
