We've been inconsistent at times against the run, but we thought we could play them the way we played Virginia (a Clemson win), because we thought they were very similar in their schemes and their backs. I think we've got good quickness on defense. But we've got a lot of things to build on. You gotta look at yourself at where you started.

Two series in a row we get motion penalties, and it's tough to start a first and 15. The play was hard enough...and it was tough enough to get first throws, and those things take you out of it and puts you in a hole. We had our chances to get it done, but didn't...and we couldn't run everytime, although we were pretty successful with our running game.

Raymond Priester played like he always does, and he got a lot of those yards on his own.

But we saw from the start that it was going to be a defensive game, and both teams showed that they have defenses to be proud of.
