Quote from LSU Coach Charles McClendon

I think that the game tonight proved that South Carolina certainly merited the wins that they have scored so far this season. They seem to be getting stronger each week.

They surprised us somewhat with their defense in the first half. It wasn't quite the type defense we were expecting. We had to make some adjustments at halftime and made a good comeback. I'm naturally disappointed over the blocked kick. Our kicking game has been good, but I just don't like to see them blocked and turned into touchdowns.

Nelson Stokley had another fine game. He got struck a few blows tonight and really got tired late in the game. That's why I had to get him out of there. Needless to say, I'm always pleased with a win and congratulate Coach Bass on a fine job."

Quote from South Carolina Coach Marvin Bass:

"We had a real fine effort and were in the ball game all the way. I wish we could have pushed that one over after Bryant's interception. Playing down here presents some problems, but nevertheless we like to play here and are looking forward to coming back next year. We played as well as we could against a fine football team and our young players grew up a lot by having played here. Stokley is a fine athlete; a great athlete; he keeps pressure on you all the time. LSU is well coached and an all-around good outfit. This is a better LSU team than the one that beat us 42-0 in 1961 at Columbia, because it is more explosive with Stokley and Moreau. The fans saw two great receivers tonight in Moreau and our J. R. Wilburn.

On the blocked punt, we had a 10 man rush, which we have used a great deal this season and so far we have blocked four. Roy Don Reeves, one of our safety men blocked the one tonight. He also blocked one against Duke.

We face Maryland next week and hope to make a run for the Atlantic Coast Conference title. We certainly wish LSU luck the remainder of the way."
