"LSU didn't make mistakes....They played very good....They played like a top ten team.....

"We expected to do more offensively....we never got anything established.... just didn't put it together.....that kept the burden on the defense.....

"LSU played good defensively.....No. the field had no effect on our play....it was the same for both teams.....

"They wore us down....our defense hung in there tough....it was only 7-0 at halftime.....

"Jones is one of finest passers in college football.....LSU executed their passing game very well.....

"Jeff Mack was sick to his stomach much of the first half.....we won't know how serious our injuries are until Sunday or Monday....."

COACH CHARLES MC CLENDON

The big thing was we controlled the football, 83 plays to their 48. This slowed their momentum. We were able to get ahead and they had to play catch up. That makes it tough for a team.

Coming out in the second half after we forced them to punt, we came back with those two field goals and that turned the game also. Our kids were really ~~pulling~~ pulling for (Juan) Roca and when he hit that long one it did something to them. You know he's not even on scholarship.

The defense rose the occasion and showed their mettle. We came up with some big plays for losses. we also concentrated on pursuit. I thought John Wood played a great game. That Roadrunner is a true player, a big time performer. He didn't break Ameche's record against us, but you can't take it away from him. He's a great one.

Our offense was up to the challenge. Our timing was a little off in our throwing, but we also dropped some well thrown passes. However, that in itself loosened up the Badger defense and allowed us to use Lyons on the sprint out. If we couldn't have gotten outside we would have been in trouble.

We lose Joe Winkler with a broken ankle. Don't know when he'll be able to play, at all this season.

Wisconsin is a fine ball club and we respected them. That long pass was a broken assignment on our part, but it caused us to tighten up and we were able to put points on the board even with our lead threatened.
