TYLER LAFAUCI AND JOE WINKLER

Two members of the 1973 LSU squad, offensive guard Tyler Lafauci and safety Joe Winkler, were named to the Academic All-America team following the completion of last football season. Lafauci also was named to several All-America teams besides making All-SEC and being named as the Most Valuable Offensive Player for the Bengals. Winkler, who like Lafauci earned three monograms as a Tiger gridder, saw only limited duty last season due to a serious ankle injury.
