CHAMPIONSHIP MEET INFORMATION

AWARDS

Championship team trophies, scholar-athlete trophies and the Commissioner's trophy, presented to the athlete scoring the most points at the championship, will be presented as soon as possible following the conclusion of the competition on Saturday.

Individual and relay medals will be awarded to the top three (3) finishers in each event. The award presentation will take place at the South End of Bernie Moore Track Stadium.

BUS DROP OFF/PARKING

Buses will drop off at Lot 105 on Chimes Street and proceed to park in Lot 406. See map on Page 16.

COACHING BOXES

Field event coaches will have access to designated coaching boxes on the infield during the competition. (See Map)

COMPETITION BIBS

Competition bibs must be worn on the front and back of the jersey. Pole vault athletes may wear one bib on the back of their jersey. High jump athletes may wear one bib on the front of their jersey. All athlete competition bibs, along with 8 pins per athlete, will be included in the packets picked up at the technical meeting.

CREDENTIALS

Athlete wristbands will be issued to each declared student-athlete. Wristbands must be visible at all times to gain admittance into the track facilities. Bib numbers are not acceptable for admission into either venue.

Coaches Credentials will be distributed in accordance with NCAA limitations on size of coaching staffs. Two team managers per gender and two administrators may also receive a credential. Two medical credentials per gender will be available for trainers and/or team physicians.



ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Per NCAA rules, the use of electronic devices will not be allowed in warm up and/or competition venues.

ELIGIBILITY

All student-athletes must be certified as eligible by the institution as required by the SEC and NCAA prior to participating in the SEC Championships

EVENT CHECK-IN

Running Events: Athletes must check in before the start of the preceding event at Clerk of Course in the Southwest Corner of Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. The first running event of each day and the Men's and Women's 4x400 Meter Relay teams must check in no less than 20 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the respective event. Relay teams must turn in a relay card when they check in at the Clerk of Course. All athletes must have their spikes checked prior to check-in. See Map for Spike Check at gate 13.

High Jump: Athletes will be allowed to begin specific warm ups at the site 60 minutes prior to the start of competition. Athletes must be checked in 20 minutes prior to the start of the event. Checkin is located at the event. Officials will not escort athletes. Athletes will report directly to the event through gate 11.

Pole Vault: Athletes will be allowed to begin specific warm ups at the site 75 minutes prior to the start of competition. Athletes must be checked in 20 minutes prior to the start of the event. Checkin is located at the event. Officials will not escort athletes. Athletes will report directly to the event through gate 11.

Throws and Horizontal Jumps: Athletes will be allowed to begin specific warm ups at the site 30 minutes prior to the start of competition. 20 minutes prior to the start of competition will be allotted for flight specific warm ups. All student-athletes must have checked-in with the event official at least 20 minutes before the scheduled start of the first flight of the competition. Check-in is located at the event. Officials will not escort athletes. Athletes will report directly to the event through gate 11.

GIFT SUITE

Each student-athlete eligible to participate in and travel to an SEC Championship Event and who has not previously received a participation gift at the 2022 Cross Country or 2023 Indoor Track and Field Championship will receive a championship participation gift from the Southeastern Conference. The gift suite will be located in the Southwest Corner of Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. The gift suite will be open from 10AM – 5:30PM on Wednesday, May 10th. Teams are encouraged to visit the gift suite as a group.

HEAT SHEETS

Heat sheets and live results will be available online (http://www.deltatiming.com). At the end of each day of competition, heat sheets for the next day and results from that day will be available to coaches on http://www.deltatiming.com.

HOSPITALITY

The hospitality area will be provided for all coaches, media, team medical staff, officials, and administrators with a valid championship credential. Student-athletes will not be allowed in this area. The hospitality area will be located on the Main Floor of the PMAC entering through the NorthWest Portal of the PMAC across from GATE 8 of Bernie Moore Track Stadium.

INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES

LSU will follow the SEC protocol for severe weather. Preparations to protect teams, officials, staff and spectators will begin when lightning is detected within a 20 mile radius. If lightning is detected within 8 miles of the venue competition will be halted and teams will go to Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. Communication of these procedures will come directly through the Championship Committee, Conference Office and LSU Athletic Operations.

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-INS

Implement inspections will be held Outside of Gate 4 of Bernie Moore Track Stadium. Inspections for all throwing events will begin 2 hours prior to the scheduled start of competition. All implements need to be inspected no later than 1 hour prior to the scheduled start of competition. Implements will be transported to the event site 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition.

INTERVIEW AREA

Interview Area will be located on the South Bleachers of the Carl Maddox Fieldhouse, next to the Warmup Area.

PARKING

Buses will Park in Lot 406. Those with parking passes will be able to park in Lot 105, including Media. Spectators will be able to park in any other open lots on campus.

POLE SHIPPING

LSU will NOT accept delivery of pole vault poles. Poles must be shipped to your hotel.

PROTEST TABLE - \$100

The protest table will be located in the Bernie Moore Track Stadium Weight Room All protests relating to matters which develop during the meet should be made as quickly as possible, and no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the event in question. Protests must be made by a coach and submitted to the officials at the protest table. A \$100 fee must accompany each filed protest. The fee is only refundable if the result is overturned. Meet officials will deliver the protests to the referees' written decision will be returned to the protest table.

If an athlete is disqualified, the head coach or his/her representative must be notified immediately by the meet referee. Any resultant protest must be filed as soon as possible, but no later than 15 minutes after disqualification.

RELAY CARDS

Relay cards should be submitted to officials at the clerk's table during athlete's check-in 30 minutes prior to the start of the relay. NOTE: only one member of the relay team is required to check in for relays. Relay cards will be available in your packet and extras will be provided at the clerk of course.

RESULTS/TIMING

Delta Timing Group will handle all the entries, timing and results for the championships. Results can also be viewed on the 2023 SEC Championships Official website at www.secsports.com, http://www.deltatiming.com and https://lsusports.net/2023-sec-outdoor-track-field-championships

SPIKE CHECK

Only 1/4" pyramid spikes are permitted (3/8" recessed pyramid spikes are permitted for High Jump & Javelin). All spikes must be checked at the spike check window inside Gate 13 prior to accessing Bernie Moore Track or entering Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. Athletes will not be allowed to compete without having their spikes tagged. Any athletes competing with nontagged spikes will be disqualified.







STARTING HEIGHTS

In the men's and women's high jump, the opening height will be 10 centimeters lower than the 8th best declared mark. In the men's and women's pole vault, the opening height will be 30 centimeters lower than the 8th best declared mark.

Starting heights and progressions will be determined by the championship committee. The committee may set progressions following traditional high jump and pole vault protocols keeping In mind regionally qualifying marks and SEC records.



TEAM PACKETS

Team packets will be delivered at the technical meeting. Coaches should expect to find the following in each packet: athlete wristbands, coach and staff credentials, final instructions, relay cards, competitor bibs and pins, protest forms, parking passes, etc.

TEAM CAMPS

Teams will receive a Reserved Tent on the Tennis Court next to Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. Spaces will include:

- 1 TV (this will broadcast in-house event and/or results feeds or cable TV)
- 2 8ft tables
- 10- Chairs
- 1 20-amp quad electrical box (2 of the 4 outlets will be occupied)
- 1- Fan

Team Camps will NOT be permitted inside Carl Maddox Fieldhouse

ATHLETIC TRAINING INFORMATION

Location

The medical area is located in the Team Tent Staging Area. This area will be open 90 minutes prior to the start of each meet day and during practice times

Please be mindful of the following while using the medical area:

Please properly sanitize all areas with cleaning supplies provided Please keep hydrocollator pads/towels in treatment area at all times Limited cold tubs will be available in the tent space next to the medical tent

Modalities

This medical area will be equipped with all essential first aid materials, electrical stim units/accessories, ice, and hydrocollators. All medical treatments must be supervised by the team certified athletic trainer. If an athletic trainer is not accompanying your athlete and or institution, a letter from the athletic trainer must be presented with the treatment and parameters to be provided. This must be presented prior to treatments being administered.

Hydration

A water station will be set up at the Indoor practice track and throughout the competition facility. Gatorade products will be provided to your team camp area as well.

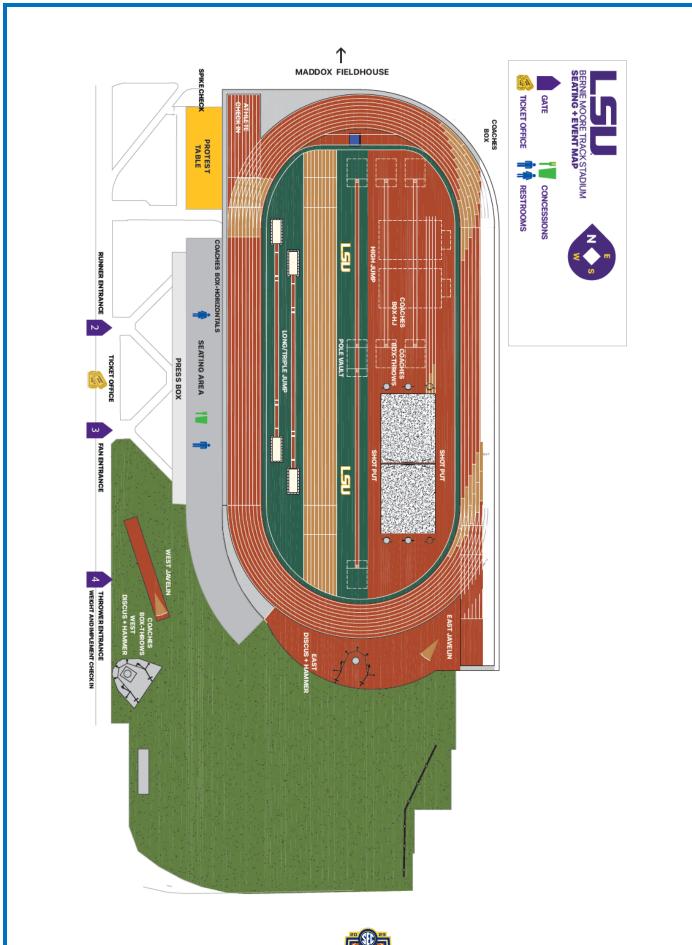

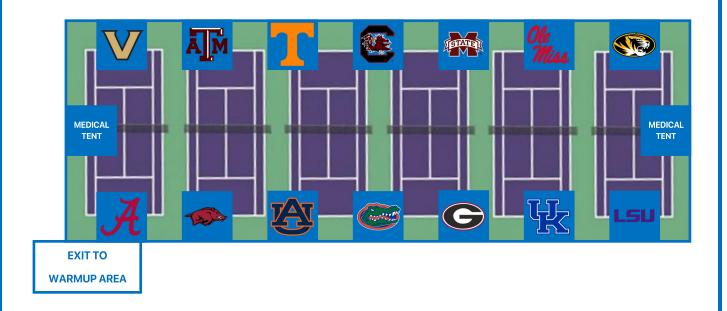

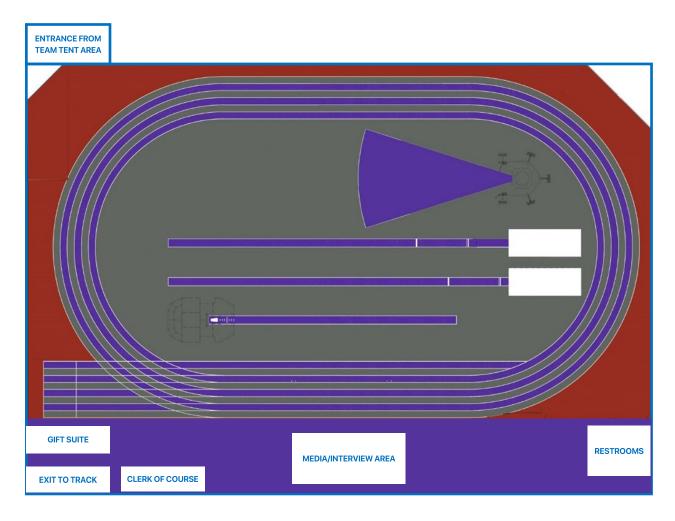




TEAM CAMP MAP

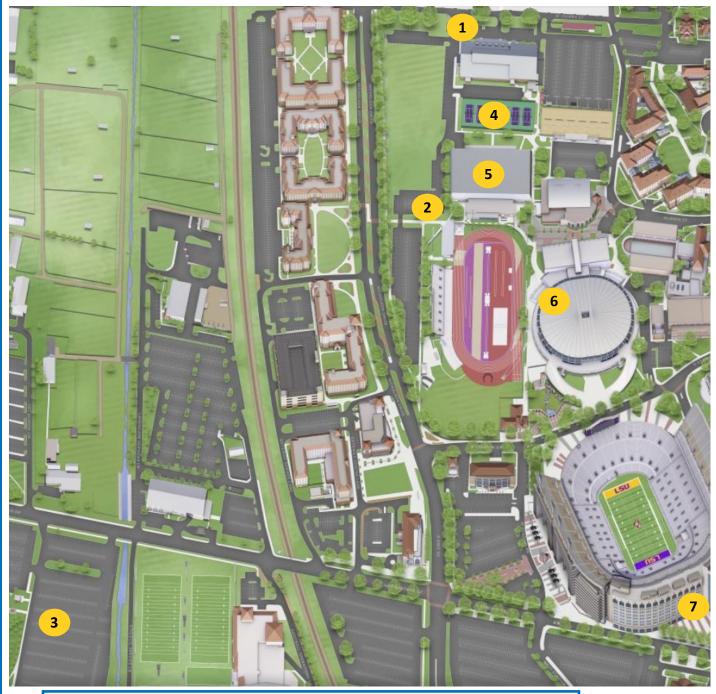


CARL MADDOX FIELDHOUSE MAP
