She leads LSU in steals with 74, is second in assists with a 3.2 average, and is third in rebounds with a 7.0 average... She is third in career assists at LSU with 305 and sixth on the career rebound list with 475... Walker scored in double figures in every game this season, over thirty in seven of the final eight games.
