TIGERS ON THE TUBE

LSU will play on television six times in 2007. The Tigers will make two appearances on CST (Channel 37), including the Sept. 23 match against Florida and the Oct. 17 match against Ole Miss, both in the Maravich Center. LSU will also take on Florida in Gainesville on SEC Regional Sports Network (FSN Southwest - Channel 38) on Oct. 26. In addition, Pelican Sports (Digital Cable Channel 113) has picked up a trio of Tiger matches. The local cable access station will televise the Nov. 4 match against Tennessee, the Nov. 18 match against Auburn and regular season finale against Tulane on Nov. 24.

HEAD COACH FRAN FLORY

Going into her 10th year as head coach at LSU, recording a 155-115 (.574) record ... Overall record in her 17th year as a head coach is 265-229 (.536) ... Three-time Louisiana Coach of the Year (2001, 2005, 2006) ... In 2006, guided the Tigers to back-to-back SEC West titles, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1992 season and a school record 16 SEC wins ... In 2005, guided the Tigers to first SEC West title in school history, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 13 years ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1993 season and most SEC wins since 1992 ... In second stint with LSU ... Was an assistant coach from 1988-1991 ... Helped Tigers to three conference titles, three SEC tournament titles and two Final Fours ... Spent five years as the head coach at Kentucky, compiling a 78-80 (.494) record ... In first year, led Wildcats to a 29-4 record and took UK to the second round of the NCAA Tournament en route to being named the Tachikara/AVCA South Region Coach of the Year ... Played at Texas from 1980-1983 ... Member of the 1981 AIAW National Championship team ... Named All-Southwest Conference in 1982.

QUICK HITS

- ▶ LSU moved up two spots to No. 20 in the AVCA/CSTV poll, marking the 21st-straight week the Tigers have been ranked dating back to the first weekly poll of 2006.
- ▶ LSU has held five of its 15 opponents to hitting percentages below .100. Only three times has an opponent hit over .200. The Tigers held UL-Monroe to a negative hitting percentage.
- ▶ **ODD WOMEN OUT:** LSU is 28-5 (.848) in odd numbered games this year, but only 13-10 (.565) in even numbered games. The Tigers are 11-4 in game one of their matches, but just 9-5 in game two. LSU is almost unstoppable at 14-1 in game threes, but has only won three of its seven game fours. The Tigers are undefeated in their three game fives.
- ▶ **ELENA MARTINEZ** has recorded double-digit digs in every match this year and leads the SEC and ranks 16th in the NCAA with 5.70 digs per game. She broke the LSU record with 34 digs in a five-game match against Iowa and again with 33 digs in a four-game match against Arkansas. **MARTINEZ** has now recorded 20 or more digs in nine of the Tigers' 15 matches this season.
- ▶ A pair of Tigers rank in the top six in the SEC in blocks per game. **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** ranks fifth, while **BRITTNEE COOPER** ranks sixth in the SEC in blocks per game. In a four-game loss to Florida, **COOPER** posted a career-best 11 blocks, the seventh most in school history. In a four-game win over Rice, **DEGIROLAMO** recorded 12 blocks, a career best and the fourth most blocks in a four-game match.
- ▶ **MARINA SKENDER** is second on the team and fourth in the SEC with 0.55 aces per game. For her career, she has recorded 140 aces, only four away from breaking into the top 10 in LSU career history. After breaking the Tiger single-season aces per game record last year, **SKENDER** now ranks fifth in LSU career service aces per game.

OPPONENT NOTES

ALABAMA (8-7, 5-1 SEC)



After struggling in non-conference play to open the season, Alabama was on a roll in league play until meeting up with Florida. The Crimson Tide are currently 8-7 overall and 5-1 in conference play. After winning only three pre-conference matches, Alabama began the SEC slate a perfect 5-0 before falling to the Gators. The Crimson Tide are led by Crystal Hudson with 4.02 kills per game and Bridget Fuentez with 3.50 kills per game, the only pair from the same team to rank in the top 10 in the SEC in kills per game. Hudson also leads Alabama and ranks seventh in the league with a .342 hitting percentage, and is the only Crimson Tide player averaging over a block per game. Amy Pauly leads Alabama with 4.93 digs per game, one of two Crimson Tide players averaging over three digs per game.

MISSISSIPPI STATE (6-9, 1-5 SEC)



Mississippi State enters the weekend at 6-9 on the year and 1-5 in SEC play, tying them for last in the league. The Bulldogs' only conference win was a three-game sweep of Arkansas, as MSU has lost two straight at home. Cristina Jucan leads the Bulldogs and ranks 10th in the SEC with 3.45 kills per game, while no Bulldog ranks in the top 10 in the SEC in hitting percentage or blocks per game, with no Bulldog averaging over a block per game. Erin Seago leads the Bulldogs with a .319 hitting percentage, while Lauren Kowal has a team-best 0.73 blocks per game. Megan Lukasek leads MSU and ranks seventh in the league with 4.09 digs per game. One of the league's best serving teams, the Bulldogs have five players with over 10 aces this year, including three with more than 20.

LAST TIME OUT

The LSU volleyball team swept a pair of SEC matches on the road, coming from a game back to defeat Auburn, before becoming the first team this year to sweep Georgia in three games. The Tigers have now defeated Auburn in 12 consecutive meetings and 13 of their last 14. The last loss to Auburn for LSU was in 2000. The Tigers also extended their winning streak to four straight over Georgia, with the last loss to the Bulldogs coming in 2004. Sophomore Brittnee Cooper tied her career high with 14 kills against Auburn before coming back with a career-best 16 kills against Georgia. For her efforts, which also included hitting for a .478 clip for the week, she was named the SEC Player of the Week.

LSU IN THE CSTV/AVCA POLL

After taking a pair of SEC matches on the road, including becoming the first team this season to sweep Georgia, the LSU volleyball team moved up two spots in the AVCA/CSTV Coaches poll to No. 20. It marks the 21st consecutive week the Tigers have been among the Top 25, the longest streak since being ranked for 52 straight weeks from 1989 through 1993.

LSU VS. RANKED TEAMS

LSU is scheduled to play two matches against nationally ranked teams during the 2007 season, both against No. 6 Florida as part of the SEC round robin schedule. In addition, the Tigers have one match scheduled against a team that is currently receiving votes in the national poll. LSU will take on Tulane at home in November. The Tigers also dropped a four-game match to Iowa State, which is now receiving votes in the poll, and defeated Ole Miss in three when the Rebels were receiving votes.

DIG FOR THE CURE



In an effort to raise awareness and money for the world's most common cause of cancer death in women, LSU volleyball kicks off the "Dig for the Cure" campaign against Alabama.

The month-long campaign will help to raise money for breast cancer awareness through the Susan B. Komen For The Cure Foundation. Donations will be accepted throughout the month of October, which has been designated Breast Cancer Awareness Month, with the proceeds of the campaign going directly to the Komen Foundation.

Fans are asked to make pledges either per dig for the Alabama and Arkansas matches, or they can make direct monetary contributions. Representatives from the Komen Foundation will be on hand at the matches to accept donations, along with several fan friendly fundraisers that will help raise money throughout the month.

The "Dig for the Cure" campaign was originally started in 2003 by Charlotte head coach Lisa Marston, whose mother was a breast cancer survivor, and has spread to volleyball programs across the country in recent years. Last year, the campaign raised over \$72,000 nationally.

THE GOLD STANDARD

In a promotion dubbed the "Gold Game", the LSU volleyball team broke the single-match volleyball attendance record against South Carolina on Sept. 21. The Tiger faithful clad all in gold topped 2,300 as LSU shattered the previous record of an estimated 2,250 against Kentucky in 1992. With an attendance of 2,308, LSU marked its third 2,000-plus attendance in school history and the first since the 1992 record. Along with the 920 that attended the match against Florida the following Sunday, the 13th largest attendance in school history, and the two-day Mizuno Tiger Classic to start the year, the Tigers are averaging 992 in attendance this year, the largest average attendance in Fran Flory's 10-year tenure.

ON FIRE OR COLD AS ICE

LSU has one of the toughest serving teams in the league and when the Tigers are on track, they are very good, but with that risk can come consequences. The Tigers lead the SEC with 2.21 service aces per game, led by **KYNA WASHINGTON** with 37 and **MARINA SKENDER** with 31. Eight Tigers have recorded an ace, all with four or more. Conversely, LSU is also averaging 3.71 service errors per game. Recording a .865 serving percentage, the Tigers' best effort came against UL-Monroe when LSU had 17 aces. After recording a season worst 21 service errors against Auburn, the Tigers rebounded with their only single-digit service error total of the year with eight against Georgia, including a flawless third game.

Juniors **KYNA WASHINGTON** and **MARINA SKENDER** are ranked in the top four in the SEC. **WASHINGTON** ranks second in the league and 16th in the NCAA with 37 aces this season for an average of 0.67 aces per game. **SKENDER** is fourth in the conference and 51st in the country with 31 aces this year and is averaging 0.55 aces per game.

SERVING SKENDER

For her career, **MARINA SKENDER** has recorded 140 service aces, which averages out to 0.517 aces per game. After setting the school record with a .675 service ace per game average in 2006, the Zagreb, Croatia, native moved into the top 10 in career service aces per game. **SKENDER** now ranks fifth in career aces per game and is four aces from breaking into the top 10 in career aces.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

The Tigers boast a pair of dominate players up the middle this season. **LAUREN DEGIROLMAO** made an immediate impact last year in her redshirt freshman season, and with the emergence of **BRITTNEE COOPER** this year, LSU has one of the most impressive duos in the league.

DEGIROLMAO currently ranks fifth in the SEC and 40th in the NCAA with 1.43 blocks per game, followed closely by **COOPER** in sixth in the league and 42nd nationally with 1.42 blocks per game, the only two players from the same team ranked in the top six. Offensively, **DEGIROLMAO** leads the team, ranks sixth in the league and 69th in the country with a .353 hitting percentage, while **COOPER** ranks second on the team at .299. **DEGIROLMAO** also ranks second on the team with 3.27 kills per game, followed by **COOPER** with the third best average on the team at 2.83 kills per game.

The duo also became the first LSU players to record double-figure blocking matches in the same season since **REGAN HOOD** and **MEGAN HEINZ** accomplished the feat in 2003. **HOOD** recorded a 10-block match against Mississippi State, while **HEINZ** had 10-block matches against Arkansas and Ole Miss.

MARTINEZ LEADS THE SEC, RANKS 13TH IN NCAA IN DIGS PER GAME

In her first year as the starting libero, junior **ELENA MARTINEZ** has recorded double-digit digs in every match this year, leads the SEC and ranks 16th in the nation with 5.70 digs per game. Lara Newberry of Chattanooga leads the nation with 7.00 digs per game. **MARTINEZ'S** current mark would shatter the school record of 4.69 digs per game recorded by **KASSI MIKULIK** last season if she reaches 400 digs this year. In addition, she is on pace to also break the single-season digs mark of 535 set by **MIKULIK** last season. With 319 digs this year, she could break the record in November. **MARTINEZ** broke the LSU record with 34 digs in a five-game match against Iowa and again with 33 digs in a four-game match against Arkansas. **MARTINEZ** has now recorded 20 or more digs in nine of the Tigers' 13 matches this season.

SKENDER NEARS 700 CAREER DIGS

Junior **MARINA SKENDER** is only one dig away from becoming just the 26th player in LSU history to record 700 career digs. This season, she is second on the team in digs and digs per game. Last season, both **KASSI MIKULIK** and **DANIELA ROMERO** each topped the 700-dig plateau.

MARTINEZ POSTS 300 SEASON DIGS

With her 12 dig against Auburn on Sept. 28, junior **ELENA MARTINEZ** became just the second player since 2002 to record 300 digs in a season. She needs only 81 digs to move into the top 10 in single-season digs in school history.

WASHINGTON, SKENDER CLOSE TO 1,000-KILL MARK

Juniors **KYNA WASHINGTON** and **MARINA SKENDER** are both closing in the 1,000-kill mark. In just their third years, **WASHINGTON** is now just 117 kills away from becoming the 14th player in LSU history to post 1,000 career kills, while **SKENDER** is only 143 kills away from becoming the 15th Tiger to reach the millennium mark.

WASHINGTON is currently third in the SEC averaging 4.18 kills per game and is on pace to break the 1,000-kill mark in November. **SKENDER** is currently not on track to reach the 1,000 mark this year, but after moving from the right side to the outside, she has increased her swings and the opportunity to reach the milestone this season.

COOPER NAMED SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BRITTNEE COOPER was named the SEC of the Week on Oct. 1. Against Auburn, **COOPER** tied her then career high with 14 kills, while also hitting at a .417 clip, her second best hitting percentage of the season. She followed that up with 16 kills and a .545 hitting percentage, both career bests, against Georgia. In addition, she tied for the match high with four blocks against the Bulldogs. For the week, **COOPER** averaged a team-best 4.29 kills per game while leading the team with a .478 hitting percentage and 4.86 points per game.

COOPER BLOCKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

Against No. 6 Florida on Sept. 23, **BRITNEE COOPER** recorded a career-high with 11 blocks, tying her for the seventh most total blocks in a four-game match. Along with nine block assists, she tied for the sixth most block assists in a four-game match.

WASHINGTON EARNS BACK-2-BACK SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

KYNA WASHINGTON was named the Southeastern Conference Player of the Week on Sept. 17, her second-straight weekly honor. Against Ole Miss, **WASHINGTON** recorded the second most kills in a three-game match in school history with 24, two shy of Monique Adams' record of 26 against Oklahoma in 1991. In addition, she posted eight digs, three blocks, while hitting an amazing .378 against Ole Miss. Against Arkansas, **WASHINGTON** recorded her third-straight 20 kill match, leading all players with 20 kills. In addition, she led the match with four service aces while recording 17 digs. For the week, she averaged an amazing 7.21 points per game while posting 6.29 kills and 3.57 digs per game.

MARTINEZ BREAKS LSU FOUR-GAME DIG RECORD

Against Arkansas on Sept. 16, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 33 digs in the four-game win, breaking the LSU record for digs in a four-game match. **MARTINEZ** bested the previous record of 31 digs held by **LUCIANA REIS** against Kansas in 1993. With her third 30-dig match of the season, **MARTINEZ** also broke the school record for 30-dig matches in a season and for a career. **REIS** had been the only previous Tiger with a 30-dig match and she posted two during the 1993 season.

LONERGAN IN TOP 10 IN ASSISTS IN FOUR-GAME MATCH

With 67 assists against Arkansas on Sept. 16, **MAGGIE LONERGAN** tied for the 10th most assists in a four-game match in LSU history. The 67 assists was also the second most for Lonergan this season after recording 68 in a five-game win over Iowa.

WASHINGTON RECORDS SECOND MOST KILLS IN THREE-GAME MATCH

Against Ole Miss on Sept. 12, **KYNA WASHINGTON** recorded 24 kills, the second most kills in a three-game match in LSU history. **WASHINGTON** was only two behind the school record of 26 set by **MONIQUE ADAMS** in 1991. Going into game three, **WASHINGTON** was on the brink of the record with 22 kills. With the dominating performance by the Tigers in game three, **WASHINGTON** was left with little time on the front row and only posted two kills, leaving her two shy of the mark.

LONERGAN IN TOP 10 IN ASSISTS IN THREE-GAME MATCH

With 52 assists against Ole Miss on Sept. 12, **MAGGIE LONERGAN** posted the eighth most in a three-game match in LSU history. She had the most assists in a match since **KATIE KUBENA** set the school mark with 65 against Mississippi State in 2000. It also marked the second most assists for **LONERGAN** in her career.

WASHINGTON NAMED SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KYNA WASHINGTON was named the Southeastern Conference Player of the Week on Sept. 10. Named to the Iowa Challenge All-Tournament team, the junior led the team in kills per game with 5.25. In addition, she led all three matches in kills, including a career-high 28 kills against Iowa. In the weekend opener against Iowa State, she had set a season best with 19 kills before her output against the Hawkeyes. Also against the Cyclones, **WASHINGTON** tallied a season-high 19 digs while also tying her season high with six blocks. Against Drake, she recorded a season-best .361 hitting percentage as she hit at a .290 clip for the week.

MARTINEZ, WASHINGTON ON IOWA CHALLENGE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

ELENA MARTINEZ and **KYNA WASHINGTON** were named to the Iowa Challenge All-Tournament team. **MARTINEZ** broke the LSU record for digs in a match with 34 against Iowa. **LUCIANA REIS** had been the only player in Tiger volleyball history with two 30-dig matches, recording matches of 30 and 31 digs in 1993. Against Drake, **MARTINEZ** also recorded 22 digs, tying her for the sixth most digs in a three-game match in school history.

WASHINGTON led all three matches in kills, while recording a career-high 28 against Iowa. In the weekend opener against Iowa State, she had set a season best with 19 kills before her output against the Hawkeyes. Also against the Cyclones, **WASHINGTON** tallied a season-high 19 digs while also tying her season high with six blocks. Against Drake, she recorded a season-best .361 hitting percentage, while hitting .290 for the week.

MARTINEZ RECORDS MOST DIGS IN ANY MATCH IN LSU HISTORY

Against Iowa on Sept. 8, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 34 digs, breaking the overall LSU record for digs in a match by five. In addition, the 34 digs was the most in a five-game match in school history, besting the previous record of 28 by six. **MARTINEZ** now joins **LUCIANA REIS** as the only players to ever record 30 digs in a match twice as **REIS** accomplished the feat twice in 1993 and **MARTINEZ** had 30 against Rice in week two.

MARTINEZ TIED FOR SIXTH MOST DIGS IN THREE-GAME MATCH

Against Drake on Sept. 8, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 22 digs, tying her for the sixth most digs in a three-game match in school history. The record of 30 digs was set by **LUCIANA REIS** against Arkansas State on Oct. 22, 1993. The last time a player recorded 22 or more digs in a three-game match was **KASSI MIKULIK** with 26 against Ole Miss last season.

MARTINEZ NAMED SEC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ELENA MARTINEZ was named the SEC Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 4. The New Orleans native helped lead the Tigers to a 3-0 record with wins over Illinois, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Rice. In the week-end finale against Rice, **MARTINEZ** recorded 30 digs in the four-game win, which tied for the second-most digs in any match in LSU history. It also marked the second most digs in a four-game match by a Tiger. In the week-end opening win against Illinois, she posted 20 digs in the five-game match, before posting 19 in a three-game win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.

THREE NAMED TO MIZUNO INVITATIONAL II ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** was named the Most Valuable Player of the Mizuno Invitational II, while junior **KYNA WASHINGTON** and sophomore **BRITTNEE COOPER** were named to the all-tournament team. It marked the second-straight MVP honor for **DEGIROLAMO** and the second all-tournament team for **COOPER**. **DEGIROLAMO** tied for the fourth most total blocks in a four-game match with 12 and the sixth most block assists with nine. In back-to-back matches, **DEGIROLAMO** tied her career high with 17 kills against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Rice. Against the Islanders, she also hit a team-best .531 with seven blocks and six digs. With her 12 blocks and 17 kills against the Owls, it marked her fourth career double-double. **WASHINGTON** had 15 kills against Rice after posting 11 in the match against Corpus Christi, while hitting .360 with four digs and four service aces against the Islanders. **COOPER** posted 11 kills and seven blocks against the Owls.

MARTINEZ TIED FOR SECOND MOST DIGS IN LSU HISTORY

Against Rice on Sept. 1, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 30 digs, tying her for the second-most digs in any match in LSU history. It also marked the second most digs in a four-game match by a Tiger. The last time an LSU player posted 30 digs was **LUCIANA REIS** with a school-record 31 against Kansas on Dec. 4, 1993. The only other 30-dig match in school history was also by **REIS** in a three-game match against Arkansas State on Oct. 22, 1993.

DEGIROLAMO BLOCKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

Against Rice on Sept. 1, **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** tied for the fourth most total blocks in a four-game match with 12 and the sixth most block assists with nine. The last time a Tiger posted 12 blocks in a four-game match was **JULIE STEMPEL** against Southern California on Nov. 16, 1989, and the last LSU player to post nine block assists in a four-game match was **DEGIROLAMO** last season against Kentucky on Sept. 17.

DEGIROLAMO, SKENDER, COOPER ON TIGER CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** was named the Most Valuable Player of the Mizuno Tiger Classic, while junior **MARINA SKENDER** and sophomore **BRITTNEE COOPER** were named to the all-tournament team. A middle blocker, **DEGIROLAMO** led the tournament with a .517 hitting percentage, breaking her career high with a .750 clip against New Orleans. Averaging 3.09 kills per game, she failed to record an error in her first two contests. In addition, she led the tournament with 1.36 blocks per game. **SKENDER** posted the second best hitting percentage on the team at .382, while recording 2.18 kills per game, 0.73 service aces per game, 2.36 digs per game and 0.82 blocks per game. **COOPER** recorded a career-best nine blocks against Saint Louis as she finished the weekend with 1.30 blocks per game. In addition, she posted 2.30 kills per game while hitting .245.

TIGERS POST EIGHTH MOST ACES IN A THREE-GAME MATCH

Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU recorded 17 service aces, the eight most aces in a three-game match in school history. The mark was four behind the school record of 21 aces, which was recorded against Mississippi State on Nov. 12, 1987.

TIGERS HOLD UL-MONROE TO NEGATIVE HITTING MARK

Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU held the Warhawks to a -.025 hitting percentage, the lowest hitting percentage since holding Nicholls State to a -.056 mark on Aug. 26, 2006. It marked the fourth time in Fran Flory's 10-year tenure at LSU that the Tigers have held an opponent in negative figures hitting. In 2002, Alcorn State also recorded a negative hitting mark, posting a -.043 clip on Aug. 30, 2002, while Georgia hit -.051 on Oct. 3, 1999.

LSU RETURNS THREE STARTERS FOR 2007

The Tigers return three starters from the 2006 team that won the SEC West and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Junior **MARINA SKENDER**, a 2006 first-team All-SEC selection, led the team in kills and aces and ranked second in digs. She broke the LSU single-season record for aces per game with the 11th most single-season aces. Junior **KYNA WASHINGTON** ranked second on the team in kills and fourth in digs. Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO**, who earned Louisiana Freshman of the Year honors and was an SEC All-Freshman selection, led the team in blocks and hitting percentage. She earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors on four occasions, the most of any freshman, and recorded the third most season blocks per game in school history.

LSU BRINGS IN ACCOMPLISHED FRESHMEN

The Tigers bring in a quintet of accomplished freshmen to compliment the talented returning players LSU has in place. **SHANNON BALIKOWSKY** earned a redshirt last season and will begin the 2007 season as a freshman. A Baton Rouge phenom, **BRITTNEY JOHNSON** was the Most Valuable Player for Louisiana classes 3A and under. She was also named the state's top volleyball player in all classes while playing at the setter position. A Texas all-state selection and two-time Dallas Morning News Player of the Week selection, **ANGELA BENSEND** comes in as an outstanding outside hitter. The towering 6-4 **TANIA SCHATOW** comes in as the "Best Volleyball Player in Michigan" as rated by Rise Magazine. The last addition to the 2007 class, **HALEY REUTHER** from New Orleans was selected Miss Louisiana Volleyball in 2006.

LSU CLAIMS BACK-TO-BACK SEC WESTERN DIVISION TITLES

The Tigers claimed the outright SEC Western Division title last season after sharing the championship with Arkansas in 2005. With a 16-4 SEC mark, LSU finished four games ahead of Alabama in the West in 2006. The Tigers also finished in second place overall, three games behind Florida. Since the SEC went to the divisional format in 1995, LSU had finished as high as second on three occasions, but never won before 2005. The last time LSU won an SEC title was when the Tigers won three straight overall championships from 1989-1991.

LSU POSTS GREAT 2006 NUMBERS

With a 26-5 overall record and a 16-4 mark in SEC play in 2006, LSU recorded the most wins by a Tiger team since the 1992 season and broke the school record for the most conference wins in school history. In 1992, LSU finished the season at 26-9 overall. In 1991, the Tigers were 13-1 in SEC play and won their last SEC championship.

TIGERS ARE 25-6 IN SEASON OPENERS

LSU improved to 25-6 all-time in season openers with a 3-0 win over New Orleans at home in the Mizuno Tiger Classic. The Tigers have also won seven straight dating back to 2001. The Tigers are 47-2 overall against New Orleans, including a 3-0 record in season openers. LSU also knocked off the Privateers at home to start the 1982 season and defeated New Orleans on the road to open the 1993 season.
