# YVETTE GIROUARD

## HEAD COACH

**EIGHTH YEAR AT LSU • 28TH YEAR OVERALL**  
**1,122-351 (.762) OVERALL • 363-101 (.782) AT LSU**



In seven seasons at LSU, Yvette Girouard's effect on the Tiger softball program has been powerful. With each year, she continues to add to her legacy as one of the greatest coaches in the history of women's softball by helping LSU maintain its place among the nation's elite in the collegiate ranks.

Girouard, who was inducted into the Louisiana Softball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in June 2002 and the National Fastpitch Coaches Association Hall of Fame in December 2005, ranks fifth among the career leaders in NCAA Division I wins and fourth in winning percentage; and fifth among the active NCAA Division I coaching leaders in wins and third in winning percentage.

With 26-straight winning seasons to her credit, she has guided her athletes to 39 All-America honors, including 11 while at LSU, 16 Academic All-America honors and taken her teams to 16 NCAA Regionals.

No stranger to Oklahoma City, Girouard is just the third coach in NCAA history to take two programs to the Women's College World Series after leading ULL to three WCWS appearances in the 1990s and LSU in 2001 and 2004.

## TIGERS IN THE TIGER CLASSIC

This will be the ninth time LSU has hosted the Tiger Classic. The Tigers are 40-6 all-time in the tournament, having captured the tournament title in 1999, 2000, 2001, 2005, 2006 and 2007. Last season, LSU swept through the Tiger Classic, winning all six games on its way to the tournament championship. The Tigers outscored their opponents 34-6 with one run-rule win and an extra-inning win in the championship game.

## TIGERS IN SEASON OPENERS

Since the Tigers reinstated softball in 1997, LSU is 10-1 in season openers, including an 8-0 record at Tiger Park. The Tigers' only season opening loss was a 5-3 loss to Illinois to open the 2005 season at the UNLV Softball Classic. Last season, LSU topped Memphis, 3-1, in the season opener as part of the Easton Tiger Classic at Tiger Park. In 11 season openers, LSU has outscored its opponents 105-9 overall, and has posted seven shutouts.

## LSU POSTS SECOND-MOST WINS

In just its 12th year since reinstatement in 1997, the LSU softball program has proven to be among the elite in the nation. The Tigers have averaged 52.7 wins per year in its previous 11 years, which is by far the best in the SEC in that span. In the nation, LSU is second to only Arizona, which has averaged 55.0 wins a season over the past 11 years. The Tigers also are third in winning percentage behind only Arizona and UCLA. The Tigers rank ahead of national champions Michigan, Oklahoma, California and Fresno State.

## LSU DOMINATES SEC SERIES

Dating back to 1997, LSU has competed in 108 series against conference foes and has only lost 15. The Tigers have swept 30 three-game series since the SEC adopted the three-game format in 2001 and taken 21 more series wins in that time period. This year, LSU is 2-0 in mid-week doubleheader series since the SEC changed to a 28-game schedule. Prior to 2001, the league played four game

series against divisional opponents and double-headers against cross divisional rivals. LSU swept nine four-game series and 15 doubleheaders while taking six series, 3-1. LSU now has an SEC series record of 83-15-10 (.815).

### **LSU VS. RANKED TEAMS**

This year, the Tigers have one of the toughest schedules in the nation. LSU is scheduled to play 17 games against eight nationally ranked teams, including eight games against four teams ranked in the Top 10. Fourteen of the Tigers' games against ranked opponents are against fellow SEC teams, making the conference one of the toughest in the nation. In addition, LSU has added games against top-ranked Arizona and top 10-ranked Northwestern in out-of-conference play.

### **LSU AMONG THE ELITE IN THE POLLS**

LSU enters the 2008 season ranked No. 9 in the NFCA/USA Today coaches preseason poll, the same position the Tigers began the 2007 season. LSU has now been ranked for 30 straight weeks after having been ranked for 103 straight weeks from Feb. 28, 1998 until March 30, 2005. In all, LSU has been ranked in 134 of the 155 polls (.865) that have been released since the program was reinstated in 1997. The Tigers have also been ranked in the top 10 for 88 total weeks.

Since ESPN/USA Softball began its softball poll on Feb. 25, 2003, LSU has been ranked in 70 of the 79 polls (.886). The Tigers enter the season ranked No. 7 in the preseason poll, matching their 2007 ranking which was the highest preseason ranking for this poll in school history. The Tigers have now been ranked in the top 10 for 39 total weeks.

### **LSU RANKED NO. 8 IN ALL-TIME POLL**

In 12 years, the LSU softball program has gone from its inaugural season in 1997 to being ranked the eighth-best all-time program. The Tigers are the youngest program to be ranked in the top 10, and are one of only two teams in the top 15 that did not begin competition until after the poll began. The USA Today/NFCA All-Time Top 50 poll was compiled using the points each team received in the polls for weekly rankings from the 1995 season to the present poll.

### **MORE THAN A DECADE OF DOMINANCE**

In its 12th season of softball in the modern era, LSU has achieved an unrivaled tradition of success. The Tigers have won more SEC Championships than all other conference schools combined, while remaining one of only two schools in league history to record the triple crown (Division, Overall and

## LSU VS. LOUISIANA TEAMS

In 2008, the Tigers have nine games against Louisiana schools, including three against Nicholls State, two against Southeastern Louisiana and UL-Monroe, and one against McNeese State. LSU is 106-5 (.955) all-time against in-state schools. The Tigers had their 55-game winning streak snapped on April 25, 2007, vs. Southeastern Louisiana, after not having lost to a Louisiana school since an April 18, 2001 loss to UL-Lafayette, 2-1. The Tigers boast undefeated records against Centenary (13-0), Grambling State (6-0), Louisiana Tech (10-0), UL-Monroe (3-0), McNeese State (16-0), Northwestern State (22-0) and Southern (5-0). LSU's only losses to in-state schools have come to UL-Lafayette, Southeastern Louisiana and Nicholls State. The Tigers are 12-3 (.800) all-time against ULL, 9-1 (.900) against the Lady Lions and 11-1 (.917) all-time against the Lady Colonels.

## TIGERS PICKED SECOND IN SEC WEST

LSU was picked to win the SEC West in a pre-season poll by the league's coaches. The Tigers earned 19 points, just behind Alabama with 11 points. Mississippi State came in third with 33 points, followed by Ole Miss with 48 and Auburn with 49.

Florida led the SEC Eastern Division with 11 points. Tennessee ranked second with 19 points followed by Georgia with 29 points. South Carolina and Kentucky completed the division with 35 and 46 points respectively.

Alabama was also picked to win the overall SEC title with eight championship votes, while Florida had two votes and LSU had one.
