TIGERS ON THE TUBE

LSU will play on television six times this season. The Tigers will make two appearances on Cox Sports Television (Channel 37), including the Sept. 23 match against Florida and the Oct. 17 match against Ole Miss, both in the Maravich Center. LSU will also take on Florida in Gainesville on SEC Regional Sports Network (FSN Southwest - Channel 38) on Oct. 26. In addition, Pelican Sports (Digital Cable Channel 113) has picked up a trio of Tiger matches. The local cable access station will televise the Nov. 4 match against Tennessee, the Nov. 18 match against Auburn and regular season finale against Tulane on Nov. 24.

HEAD COACH FRAN FLORY

Going into her 10th year as head coach at LSU, recording a 155-115 (.574) record ... Overall record in her 17th year as a head coach is 265-229 (.536) ... Three-time Louisiana Coach of the Year (2001, 2005, 2006) ... In 2006, guided the Tigers to back-to-back SEC West titles, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1992 season and a school record 16 SEC wins ... In 2005, guided the Tigers to first SEC West title in school history, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 13 years ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1993 season and most SEC wins since 1992 ... In 2004, she led the Tigers to a third place finish in the SEC West, the seventh consecutive year LSU finished at least third in the West ... In second stint with LSU ... Was an assistant coach from 1988-1991 ... Helped Tigers to three conference titles, three SEC tournament titles and two Final Fours ... Spent five years as the head coach at Kentucky, compiling a 78-80 (.494) record ... In first year, led Wildcats to a 29-4 record and took UK to the second round of the NCAA Tournament en route to being named the Tachikara/AVCA South Region Coach of the Year ... Played at Texas from 1980-1983 ... Member of the 1981 AIAW National Championship team ... Named All-Southwest Conference in 1982.

QUICK SETS

- ▶▶ With a 26-6 record in 2006, LSU recorded the most wins in a season since also posting 26 in 1992. The Tigers recorded their 20th 20-win season, including their second straight, but only the third since 1993.
- ▶▶ With a 16-4 record, LSU broke the school record for most SEC wins in school history, breaking the previous record of 13 recorded in 1991. It marked only the fifth time the Tigers have recorded double-figure wins in SEC play, including back-to-back seasons in 2005 and 2006, but just the third time since 1992.
- ▶▶ The Tigers posted six straight conference sweeps to start the 2006 schedule in the Maravich Center before losing the first game to Florida on Nov. 3. Last year, LSU lost only nine games at home, going 36-9 (.800) in games in the PMAC.
- ▶▶ LSU moved up to No. 22 in the AVCA/CSTV poll, marking the 16th-straight week the Tigers have been ranked, beginning with the first weekly poll of the 2006 season. The Tigers were ranked as high as No. 10 twice during the 2006 season, the highest ranking for the Tigers since coming in at No. 8 on Sept. 7, 1992.
- ▶▶ Marina Skender had a service ace in 27 of LSU's 32 matches in 2006 with Rice, first Florida, second Arkansas, Marquette and California the only matches she did not record an ace. She finished ranked fifth in the NCAA in service aces per game while breaking the LSU record for aces per game in a single-season. The junior now ranks fifth in career service aces per game.

OPPONENT NOTES

ILLINOIS (2-1, 0-0 Big 10)



Illinois began the season last weekend in the Dayton Flyer Classic, going 2-1, to finish second. The Illini knocked off Bowling Green on the first day of competition. Illinois then swept IPFW on day two before facing host Dayton in the final match. That match, which decided the tournament champion, went to five games with the Flyers outlasting the Illini, despite a pair of match points for Illinois in game four. Freshman Laura DeBruler and senior Vicki Brown were named to the all-tournament team for the Illini.

RICE (1-2, 0-0 C-USA)



Rice opened its season last weekend as the Owls hosted the Mizuno Invitational. Rice posted a 1-2 record, including a pair of hard fought five-game matches. The Owls began the tournament with a three-game loss to Louisiana Tech. Rice came back in day two to knock off eventual tournament champion Lamar in five games, before falling to Oral Roberts in five, 18-16. Junior Jessica Jolderness was named to the all-tournament team for Rice.

TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI (2-1, 0-0 SLC)



Texas A&M-Corpus Christi began its season at the Texas A&M Invitational last weekend, finishing second in the tournament. The Islanders went 2-1, with a lone loss to the host Aggies in their first outing. Corpus Christi came back to sweep both Prairie View A&M and Centenary. For her efforts on the weekend, middle blocker Lauren Paslay was named to the all-tournament team and went on to take home Southland Conference Player of the Week honors. Jordan Wagner was also named to the all-tournament team for the Islanders.

LSU IN THE CSTV/AVCA POLL

After winning the Mizuno Tiger Classic last weekend to open the 2007 season, the LSU volleyball team moved up one spot in the AVCA/CSTV Coaches poll to No. 22. The No. 22 national ranking marks the 16th consecutive week the Tigers have been among the Top 25, the longest streak since being ranked for 52 straight weeks from 1989 through 1993.

LSU VS. RANKED TEAMS

The Tigers are scheduled to play two matches against nationally ranked teams during the 2007 season, both against No. 7 Florida as part of the SEC round robin schedule. In addition, the Tigers have seven matches scheduled against teams that are currently receiving votes in the national poll. LSU will take on Notre Dame at home in October. The Tigers will also face three teams in the conference that are receiving votes - Tennessee, Arkansas and Ole Miss.

SERVING SKENDER

For her career, junior Marina Skender has recorded 117 service aces, which averages out to 0.518 aces per game. After setting the school record with a .675 service ace per game average in 2006, the Zagreb, Croatia, native moved into the top 10 in career service aces per game. Skender now ranks fifth in career aces per game and is 28 aces from breaking into the top 10 in career aces.

DEGIROLAMO, SKENDER, COOPER ON TIGER CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Sophomore Lauren DeGirolamo was named the Most Valuable Player of the Mizuno Tiger Classic, while junior Marina Skender and sophomore Brittnee Cooper were named to the all-tournament team. A middle blocker, DeGirolamo led the tournament with a .517 hitting percentage, breaking her career high with a .750 clip against New Orleans. Averaging 3.09 kills per game, she failed to record an error in her first two contests. In addition, she led the tournament with 1.36 blocks per game. Skender posted the second best hitting percentage on the team at .382, while recording 2.18 kills per game, 0.73 service aces per game, 2.36 digs per game and 0.82 blocks per game. Cooper recorded a career-best nine blocks against Saint Louis as she finished the weekend with 1.30 blocks per game. In addition, she posted 2.30 kills per game while hitting .245.

TIGERS HOLD UL-MONROE TO NEGATIVE HITTING MARK

Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU held the Warhawks to a -.025 hitting percentage, the lowest hitting percentage since holding Nicholls State to a -.056 mark on Aug. 26, 2006. It marked the fourth time in Fran Flory's 10-year tenure at LSU that the Tigers have held an opponent in negative figures hitting. In 2002, Alcorn State also recorded a negative hitting mark, posting a -.043 clip on Aug. 30, 2002, while Georgia hit -.051 on Oct. 3, 1999.

TIGERS POST EIGHTH MOST ACES IN A THREE-GAME MATCH

Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU recorded 17 service aces, the eight most aces in a three-game match in school history. The mark was four behind the school record of 21 aces, which was recorded against Mississippi State on Nov. 12, 1987.

LSU RETURNS THREE STARTERS FOR 2007

The Tigers return three starters from the 2006 team that won the SEC West and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Junior Marina Skender, a 2006 first-team All-SEC selection, led the team in kills and aces and ranked second in digs. She broke the LSU single-season record for aces per game with the 11th most single-season aces. Junior Kyna Washington ranked second on the team in kills and fourth in digs. Sophomore Lauren DeGirolamo, who earned Louisiana Freshman of the Year honors and was an SEC All-Freshman selection, led the team in blocks and hitting percentage. She earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors on four occasions, the most of any league freshman, and recorded the third most single-season blocks per game in school history.

LSU BRINGS IN ACCOMPLISHED FRESHMEN

Shannon Balikowsky earned a redshirt last season and will begin the 2007 season as a freshman. A Baton Rouge phenom, Brittney Johnson was the Most Valuable Player for Louisiana classes 3A and under. She was also named the state's top volleyball player in all classes while playing at the setter position. A Texas all-state selection and two-time Dallas Morning News Player of the Week selection, Angela Bendsend comes in as an outstanding outside hitter. The towering 6-4 Tania Schatow comes in as the "Best Volleyball Player in Michigan" as rated by Rise Magazine. The last addition to the 2007 class, Haley Reuther from New Orleans was selected Miss Louisiana Volleyball in 2006.

TIGERS ARE 25-6 IN SEASON OPENERS

LSU improved to 25-6 all-time in season openers with a 3-0 win over New Orleans at home in the Mizuno Tiger Classic. The Tigers have also won seven straight dating back to 2001. The Tigers are 47-2 overall against New Orleans, including a 3-0 record in season openers. LSU also knocked off the Privateers at home to start the 1982 season and defeated New Orleans on the road to open the 1993 season.

TIGERS ARE 13-10 IN SEC OPENERS

LSU is 13-10 in SEC openers, including a 7-6 mark at home, a 5-4 record on the road and a 1-0 record at neutral sites. The Tigers have now won three in a row. LSU came back from an 0-2 deficit to defeat the Lady Vols in Knoxville and snap Tennessee's 12-match home SEC winning streak last season.

LSU PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN SEC WEST

LSU was picked to finish second in the SEC Western Division in a preseason poll by the league's coaches. The Tigers received 17 points, while Alabama was picked to win the West with 14 points. The Lady'Backs were picked third with 28 points, followed by Ole Miss with 36 points. Auburn and Ole Miss rounded out the West with 47 and 53 points respectively.

In the East, Florida, who had earned at least a share of the last 16 SEC championships, was picked to win the title with 10 points and 10 first-place votes. Kentucky, who advanced to the 2006 NCAA Tournament, came in second with 22 points, followed quickly by Tennessee with 25 points. Rounding out the East are Georgia with 41 points and South Carolina with 42.

The Gators were also selected as the overall league champion ahead of the Wildcats, who are receiving votes in the poll, by way of a 10-to-1 vote.

Points were compiled on a 1-2-3-4-5-6 basis for the Western Division and 1-2-3-4-5 for the Eastern Division. Each coach was not allowed to vote for his or her own team and each coach also voted for one team as an overall conference champion
