TIGERS ON THE TUBE

LSU will play on television seven times in 2007. The Tigers will make two appearances on CST (Channel 37), including the Sept. 23 match against Florida and the Oct. 17 match against Ole Miss, both in the Maravich Center. LSU will also take on Florida in Gainesville on SEC Regional Sports Network (FSN Southwest - Channel 38) on Oct. 26. In addition, Pelican Sports (Digital Cable Channel 113) will televise the Nov. 4 match against Tennessee, the Nov. 18 match against Auburn and regular season finale against Tulane on Nov. 24. CWKYT in Lexington will broadcast the Tigers' match at Kentucky on Oct. 14.

HEAD COACH FRAN FLORY

Going into her 10th year as head coach at LSU, recording a 155-115 (.574) record ... Overall record in her 17th year as a head coach is 265-229 (.536) ... Three-time Louisiana Coach of the Year (2001, 2005, 2006) ... In 2006, guided the Tigers to back-to-back SEC West titles, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1992 season and a school record 16 SEC wins ... In 2005, guided the Tigers to first SEC West title in school history, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 13 years ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1993 season and most SEC wins since 1992 ... In second stint with LSU ... Was an assistant coach from 1988-1991 ... Helped Tigers to three conference titles, three SEC tournament titles and two Final Fours ... Spent five years as the head coach at Kentucky, compiling a 78-80 (.494) record ... In first year, led Wildcats to a 29-4 record and took UK to the second round of the NCAA Tournament en route to being named the Tachikara/AVCA South Region Coach of the Year ... Played at Texas from 1980-1983 ... Member of the 1981 AIAW National Championship team ... Named All-Southwest Conference in 1982.

QUICK HITS

- ▶ LSU has held seven of its 26 opponents to hitting percentages below .100. Only five times has an opponent hit over .200. The Tigers held UL-Monroe to a negative hitting percentage (page 8-9).
- ▶ **ELENA MARTINEZ** has recorded double-digit digs in every match this year and leads the SEC and ranks 34th in the NCAA with 5.47 digs per game. She broke the LSU single-season record for digs and now has 573 this year. She also holds the record for digs in a four and five-game match. **MARTINEZ** has now recorded 20 or more digs in 16 of the Tigers' 26 matches this season (page 6).
- ▶ A pair of Tigers rank in the top five in the SEC in blocks. **BRITTNEE COOPER** ranks second in the SEC in blocks per game, while **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** ranks fifth. Against Notre Dame, **COOPER** posted a career-best 13 blocks, which tied for the eighth most in LSU history. Against Rice, **DEGIROLAMO** recorded 12 blocks, a career best and the fourth most blocks in a four-game match (page 5).
- ▶ **MARINA SKENDER** is second on the team and fifth in the SEC with 0.46 aces per game. For her career, she has recorded 156 aces, moving her into eighth place all-time in LSU career history. After breaking the Tiger single-season aces per game record last year, **SKENDER** now ranks sixth in LSU career service aces per game (page 5).

OPPONENT NOTES

MISSISSIPPI STATE (11-14, 6-10 SEC)



Mississippi State enters the weekend having won two of its last three and sits at 11-14 overall and 6-10 in SEC play. The Bulldogs are fourth in the SEC Western Division and seventh overall. Since LSU knocked off Mississippi State in four games earlier in the year, 19-30, 30-22, 30-19, 30-25, the Bulldogs are 5-3 with two of the three losses coming on the road. Mississippi State is one of the toughest serving teams in the SEC and average 2.04 aces per game, including four players with 30 or more aces. Cristina Jucan leads the Bulldogs with 3.33 kills per game, followed by Jamie Joyner with 3.25 per game. Erin Seago leads Mississippi State with a .321 hitting percentage. One of the worst blocking teams in the conference, the Bulldogs do not have a player averaging over a block a game, led by Lauren Kowal with 0.80 blocks per game. Megan Lukasek leads Mississippi State with 4.57 digs per game, the only player averaging over three digs per game on the team.

ALABAMA (15-10, 12-4 SEC)



Alabama comes into the weekend at 15-10 on the season and 12-4 in SEC play, in first place in the Western Division and second overall, having won seven of its last eight matches. The Crimson Tide are 6-4 at home on the year, but have lost only one conference match at the CAVE, that in four games to nationally ranked Florida. Three of Alabama's four league losses came in consecutive matches against Florida, LSU and Ole Miss. The Tigers topped the Crimson Tide in five games at home, 31-33, 30-23, 33-35, 30-21, 15-7. Crystal Hudson leads a trio of Alabama player with over three kills a game, followed by Bridget Fuentez and Brooks Webster with 3.98, 3.67 and 3.06 respectively. Hudson also leads the Crimson Tide with a .356 hitting percentage and 1.05 blocks per game, the only Alabama player with over a block per game. Amy Pauly leads the Crimson Tide with 5.31 digs per game, while Fuentez is averaging 3.78 digs per game.

LSU-ALABAMA SERIES RECORD: LSU leads 23-21.

LAST TIME OUT

The LSU volleyball team defeated Kentucky in five games on Friday before sweeping Tennessee on Sunday, avenging losses to both teams in five games on the road earlier in the season. The Tigers are now 6-3 in five-game matches on the year. It marks the most five-game matches played by an LSU team since playing 11 in 1994. The Tigers have also won the most number of five-game matches since the 1987 team also won six. LSU is now one game behind Alabama in the SEC Western Division standings, tied with Ole Miss, which LSU swept this season. Against Kentucky, **ELENA MARTINEZ** broke the LSU single-season record for digs, passing **KASSI MIKULIK'S** record of 535 set last season. **MARTINEZ** is now 83 digs away from breaking the SEC single-season record set by Shelly Gross of Georgia in 1986. Against Tennessee, **MARINA SKENDER** became the 15th LSU player to record 1,000 career kills and just the sixth junior to accomplish the feat.

LSU IN THE CSTV/AVCA POLL

After knocking off Kentucky and Tennessee at home last weekend, LSU gained four votes in the AVCA/CSTV poll this week, but were still among the other teams receiving votes. It marks the third straight week LSU has not been ranked after snapping a 23 consecutive weeks in the top 25 dating back to the first weekly poll of the 2006 season.

LSU VS. RANKED TEAMS

LSU lost both matches it played this season against nationally ranked teams, falling in four games to then No. 6 Florida at home, 3-1, and was swept by No. 10 Florida in Gainesville. The Tigers also dropped a four-game match to Iowa State, which has received votes at two times this year, swept Arkansas when the Lady'Backs were receiving votes, and defeated Ole Miss in three when the Rebels were receiving votes.

THE GOLD STANDARD

In a promotion dubbed the "Gold Game", the LSU volleyball team broke the single-match volleyball attendance record against South Carolina on Sept. 21. The Tiger faithful clad all in gold topped 2,300 as LSU shattered the previous record of an estimated 2,250 against Kentucky in 1992. With an attendance of 2,308, LSU marked its third 2,000-plus attendance in school history and the first since the 1992 record. Along with the 920 that attended the match against Florida the following Sunday, the 13th largest attendance in school history, and the two-day Mizuno Tiger Classic to start the year, the Tigers are averaging 992 in attendance this year, the largest average attendance in Fran Flory's 10-year tenure.

ON FIRE OR COLD AS ICE

LSU has one of the toughest serving teams in the league and when the Tigers are on track, they are very good, but with that risk can come consequences. The Tigers are second in the SEC with 1.83 service aces per game, led by **KYNA WASHINGTON** with 54, **MARINA SKENDER** with 47, **ELENA MARTINEZ** with 29, **MAGGIE LONERGAN** with 21 and **MICHELLE HENSGENS** with 20. Eight Tigers have recorded an ace, all with four or more, including five with 15 or more.

Conversely, LSU is also averaging 3.16 service errors per game. Recording a .882 serving percentage, the Tigers' best effort came against UL-Monroe when LSU had 17 aces. After recording a season worst 21 service errors against Auburn, the Tigers rebounded with their first single-digit service error total of the year with eight against Georgia, including a flawless third game.

HOW MAY I SERVE YOU...

Juniors **KYNA WASHINGTON** and **MARINA SKENDER** are ranked in the top five in the SEC in service aces per game. **WASHINGTON** is second in the league and 32nd in the NCAA with 54 aces this season for an average of 0.54 aces per game. **SKENDER** is fifth in the conference and 80th in the country with 47 aces this year and is averaging 0.46 aces per game.

SERVING SKENDER

For her career, **MARINA SKENDER** has recorded 156 service aces, which averages out to 0.491 aces per game. After setting the school record with a .675 service ace per game average in 2006, the Zagreb, Croatia, native moved into the top 10 in career service aces per game. **SKENDER** now ranks sixth in career aces per game and against Mississippi State moved into the top 10 in career service aces in school history, where she is currently eighth.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

The Tigers boast a pair of dominate players up the middle this season. **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** made an immediate impact last year in her redshirt freshman season, and with the emergence of **BRITNEE COOPER** this year, LSU has one of the most impressive duos in the league.

COOPER currently ranks second in the SEC and 19th in the NCAA with 1.52 blocks per game, while followed closely by **DEGIROLAMO** in fifth in the league and 42nd nationally with 1.36 blocks per game, the only two players from the same team ranked in the top five. Offensively, **DEGIROLAMO** leads the team, ranks 132nd in the country with a .318 hitting percentage, while **COOPER** ranks second on the team and 298th in the nation at .270. **DEGIROLAMO** also ranks second on the team with 3.35 kills per game, followed by **COOPER** with the fourth best average on the team at 2.72 kills per game.

The duo also became the first LSU players to record double-figure blocking matches in the same season since **REGAN HOOD** and **MEGAN HEINZ** accomplished the feat in 2003. **HOOD** recorded a 10-block match against Mississippi State, while **HEINZ** had 10-block matches against Arkansas and Ole Miss.

MARTINEZ BREAKS SINGLE-SEASON DIGS RECORD

With her 16th dig against Kentucky on Nov. 2, junior **ELENA MARTINEZ** broke the LSU single-season record for digs. She now has 573 for the year and topped the previous record of 535 set by became **KASSI MIKULIK** last season. **MARTINEZ** now ranks fifth in single-season digs in SEC history and is eight away from moving into third place and only 83 digs away from breaking the SEC single-season digs record set by Shelly Gross of Georgia in 1986.

MARTINEZ LEADS THE SEC, RANKS 40TH IN NCAA IN DIGS PER GAME

In her first year as the starting libero, junior **ELENA MARTINEZ** has recorded double-digit digs in every match this year, leads the SEC and ranks 34th in the nation with 5.54 digs per game. Lara Newberry of Chattanooga leads the nation with 7.15 digs per game. **MARTINEZ'S** current mark would shatter the school record of 4.69 digs per game recorded by **KASSI MIKULIK** last season. **MARTINEZ** broke the LSU record with 34 digs in a five-game match against Iowa before tying that mark again against Kentucky. She also recorded the record for digs in a four-game match with 33 against Arkansas. **MARTINEZ** has now recorded 20 or more digs in 16 of the Tigers' 26 matches this season.

SKENDER NEARS 900 CAREER DIGS

Junior **MARINA SKENDER** became just the 15th player in LSU history to record 800 career digs, now just 21 digs away from becoming only the 12th Tiger to reach 900 digs for her career. This season, she is second on the team in digs and digs per game. Last season, both **KASSI MIKULIK** and **DANIELA ROMERO** each topped the 1,000-dig plateau.

WASHINGTON/SKENDER TOP 1,000-KILL MARK

With 14 kills against Notre Dame on Oct. 23, junior **KYNA WASHINGTON** became the 14th player and only fifth junior in LSU history to record 1,000 career kills. **MARINA SKENDER** joined **WASHINGTON** in reaching the 1,000 kill mark herself with her 14th kill against Tennessee on Nov. 4 to become the 15th Tiger and sixth junior to reach the millennium mark.

The pair are the first to accomplish the feat in the same season since 2005 when **IVANA KUZMIC** and **JELENA MIJATOVIC** each posted their 1,000th career kill, although both were transfers and only played two seasons at LSU. **WASHINGTON** and **SKENDER** are also the first juniors to reach the milestone in the same season since **NYLA SHEPHERD** and **JULIE STEMPER** reached the 1,000-kill mark during the 1990 season.

CUYLER NAMED TO ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT FIRST TEAM

LAUREN DEGIROLAMO was one of six student-athletes named to the ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District VI First Team. Athletes were selected from all NCAA Division I institutions in Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico, Oklahoma and Texas. **DEGIROLAMO** and members of the first team will advance to the national ballot for a chance at Academic All-America honors to be announced Nov. 28.

A redshirt sophomore, **DEGIROLAMO** leads LSU with a 3.91 overall grade point average in math with a secondary education concentration. A two-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll, she would like to become a high school math teacher following graduation.

RETURN TO SENDER

With a career high 13 blocks against Notre Dame on Oct. 23, 11 blocks against Ole Miss, 10 blocks against Tennessee and 11 blocks against Florida, **BRITTNEE COOPER** posted four double-figure blocking matches this season. She became the first player at LSU to post four double-figure blocking matches in a season since **IVANA KUZMIC** in 2005.

MARTINEZ TIES MOST DIGS IN ANY MATCH IN LSU HISTORY

Against Kentucky on Nov. 2, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 34 digs, tying the overall LSU record for digs in a match by five. In addition, the 34 digs tied the most in a five-game match in school history. **MARTINEZ** also recorded 34 digs in a match against Iowa earlier this year.

MARTINEZ TIED FOR SECOND MOST DIGS IN A FIVE-GAME MATCH

Against Notre Dame on Oct. 23, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 29 digs, tying her for the second-most digs in a five-game match in LSU history. It also tied for the seventh most digs in match ever by a Tiger. The 29 digs tied with her own performance against Alabama on Oct. 5, just one behind her school record of 34 against Iowa on Sept. 8.



COOPER BLOCKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS, AGAIN

Against Notre Dame on Oct. 23, **BRITTNEE COOPER** tied for the seventh most total blocks in a five-game match with 13 and the eighth most block assists with 11. The last time a Tiger posted 13 blocks in a five-game match was **IVANA KUZMIC**, also against Notre Dame, on Sept. 18, 2005, and the last LSU player to post 11 block assists in a five-game match was **KUZMIC** against Ole Miss on Oct. 3, 2004.

BENSEND NAMED SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

ANGELA BENSEND was named the SEC Freshman of the Week on Oct. 22. She averaged 2.43 kills per game last week and led the team with a .424 hitting percentage. In addition, **BENSEND** averaged 1.29 blocks, which included a career-high six blocks against the Rebels. In both matches, she led LSU in hitting percentage and tied for the team high with 11 kills against Arkansas.

MARTINEZ RECORDS TIED FOR THIRD MOST DIGS IN A FOUR-GAME MATCH

Against Ole Miss on Oct. 17, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 30 digs, which tied her own mark for the third most digs in a four-game match in school history. **MARTINEZ** now has three of the top four dig marks in a four-game match in school history. She was three behind her school record of 33 digs against Arkansas on Sept. 16.

DEGIROLAMO NAMED SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LAUREN DEGIROLAMO was named the SEC Defensive Player of the Week on Oct. 8. Against Alabama, she was two kills shy of her career best with 17, while also leading LSU with six blocks, while posting a match-high .467 hitting percentage. **DEGIROLAMO** topped that performance against Mississippi State. DeGirolamo tied for the match high with 18 kills, one shy of her career best, while hitting at a match best .457 clip. She also led the match with nine blocks, one block shy of giving her the fifth double-double of her career.

COOPER NAMED SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BRITTNEE COOPER was named the SEC Player of the Week on Oct. 1. Against Auburn, **COOPER** tied her career high with 14 kills, while also hitting at a .417 clip, her second best hitting percentage of the season. She followed that up with 16 kills and a .545 hitting percentage, both career bests, against Georgia. In addition, she tied for the match high with four blocks against the Bulldogs. For the week, **COOPER** averaged a team-best 4.29 kills per game while leading the team with a .478 hitting percentage and 4.86 points per game.

COOPER BLOCKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

Against No. 6 Florida on Sept. 23, **BRITTNEE COOPER** recorded a career-high with 11 blocks, tying her for the seventh most total blocks in a four-game match. Along with nine block assists, she tied for the sixth most block assists in a four-game match.

WASHINGTON EARNS BACK-2-BACK SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

KYNA WASHINGTON was named the Southeastern Conference Player of the Week on Sept. 17, her second-straight honor. Against Ole Miss, **WASHINGTON** recorded the second most kills in a three-game match in school history with 24, two shy of **MONIQUE ADAMS'** record of 26. In addition, she posted eight digs, three blocks, while hitting an amazing .378. Against Arkansas, **WASHINGTON** recorded her third-straight 20 kill match, leading all players with 20 kills. In addition, she led the match with four aces while recording 17 digs. For the week, she averaged an amazing 7.21 points per game while posting 6.29 kills and 3.57 digs per game.

MARTINEZ BREAKS LSU FOUR-GAME DIG RECORD

Against Arkansas on Sept. 16, **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 33 digs in the four-game win, breaking the LSU record for digs in a four-game match. **MARTINEZ** bested the previous record of 31 digs held by **LUCIANA REIS** against Kansas in 1993. With 67 assists against Arkansas on Sept. 16, **MAGGIE LONERGAN** tied for the 10th most assists in a four-game match in LSU history. The 67 assists were also the second most for Lonergan this season after recording 68 in a five-game win over Iowa.

With 52 assists against Ole Miss on Sept. 12, **MAGGIE LONERGAN** posted the eighth most in a three-game match in LSU history. She had the most assists in a match since **KATIE KUBENA** set the school mark with 65 against Mississippi State in 2000. It also marked the second most assists for **LONERGAN** in her career.

WASHINGTON NAMED SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KYNA WASHINGTON was named the SEC Player of the Week on Sept. 10. A member of the Iowa Challenge All-Tournament team, she led the team with 5.25 kills per game. In addition, she led all three matches in kills, including a career-high 28 kills against Iowa. Against Iowa State, she had set a then season best with 19 kills. **WASHINGTON** also tallied a season-high 19 digs while also tying her season high with six blocks. Against Drake, she recorded a season-best .361 hitting percentage as she hit at a .290 clip for the week.

MARTINEZ, WASHINGTON ON IOWA CHALLENGE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

The record of 30 digs was set by **LUCIANA REIS** against Arkansas State on Oct. 22, 1993. The last time a player recorded 22 or more digs in a three-game match was **KASSI MIKULIK** with 26 against Ole Miss last season.

The last time an LSU player posted 30 digs was **LUCIANA REIS** with a school-record 31 against Kansas on Dec. 4, 1993. The only other 30-dig match in school history was also by **REIS** in a three-game match against Arkansas State on Oct. 22, 1993.

DEGIROLAMO BLOCKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

Against Rice on Sept. 1, **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** tied for the fourth most total blocks in a four-game match with 12 and the sixth most block assists with nine. The last time a Tiger posted 12 blocks in a four-game match was **JULIE STEMPEL** against Southern California on Nov. 16, 1989, and the last LSU player to post nine block assists in a four-game match was **DEGIROLAMO** last season against Kentucky on Sept. 17.

DEGIROLAMO, SKENDER, COOPER ON TIGER CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** was named the Most Valuable Player of the Mizuno Tiger Classic, while junior **MARINA SKENDER** and sophomore **BRITTNEE COOPER** were named to the all-tournament team. A middle blocker, **DEGIROLAMO** led the tournament with a .517 hitting percentage, breaking her career high with a .750 clip against New Orleans. Averaging 3.09 kills per game, she failed to record an error in her first two contests. In addition, she led the tournament with 1.36 blocks per game. **SKENDER** posted the second best hitting percentage on the team at .382, while recording 2.18 kills per game, 0.73 service aces per game, 2.36 digs per game and 0.82 blocks per game. **COOPER** recorded a career-best nine blocks against Saint Louis as she finished the weekend with 1.30 blocks per game. Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU recorded 17 service aces, the eight most aces in a three-game match in school history. The mark was four behind the school record of 21 aces, which was recorded against Mississippi State on Nov. 12, 1987.

TIGERS HOLD UL-MONROE TO NEGATIVE HITTING MARK

Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU held the Warhawks to a -.025 hitting percentage, the lowest hitting percentage since holding Nicholls State to a -.056 mark on Aug. 26, 2006. It marked the fourth time in Fran Flory's 10-year tenure at LSU that the Tigers have held an opponent in negative figures hitting. LSU RETURNS THREE STARTERS FOR 2007

The Tigers return three starters from the 2006 team that won the SEC West and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Junior **MARINA SKENDER**, a 2006 first-team All-SEC selection, led the team in kills and aces and ranked second in digs. She broke the LSU single-season record for aces per game with the 11th most single-season aces. Junior **KYNA WASHINGTON** ranked second on the team in kills and fourth in digs. Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO**, who earned Louisiana Freshman of the Year honors and was an SEC All-Freshman selection, led the team in blocks and hitting percentage. She earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors on four occasions, the most of any freshman, and recorded the third most season blocks per game in school history.

LSU BRINGS IN ACCOMPLISHED FRESHMEN

The Tigers bring in a quintet of accomplished freshmen to compliment the talented returning players LSU has in place. **SHANNON BALIKOWSKY** earned a redshirt last season and will begin the 2007 season as a freshman. A Baton Rouge phenom, **BRITTNEY JOHNSON** was the Most Valuable Player for Louisiana classes 3A and under. She was also named the state's top volleyball player in all classes while playing at the setter position. A Texas all-state selection and two-time Dallas Morning News Player of the Week selection, **ANGELA BENSEND** comes in as an outstanding outside hitter. The towering 6-4 **TANIA SCHATOW** comes in as the "Best Volleyball Player in Michigan" as rated by Rise Magazine. The last addition to the 2007 class, **HALEY REUTHER** from New Orleans was selected Miss Louisiana Volleyball in 2006.

LSU CLAIMS BACK-TO-BACK SEC WESTERN DIVISION TITLES

The Tigers claimed the outright SEC Western Division title last season after sharing the championship with Arkansas in 2005. With a 16-4 SEC mark, LSU finished four games ahead of Alabama in the West in 2006. The Tigers also finished in second place overall, three games behind Florida. Since the SEC went to the divisional format in 1995, LSU had finished as high as second on three occasions, but never won before 2005. The last time LSU won an SEC title was when the Tigers won three straight overall championships from 1989-1991.
