SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ This weekend serves as the 11th edition of the Easton Tiger Classic. LSU is 46-6 (.885) all-time in the tournament, including 23 consecutive wins.
- ▶ LSU has racked up an impressive 72-5 (.935) record at home during the month of February under head coach Yvette Girouard, including a streak of 52 straight wins.
- ▶ The last loss during both of those streaks mentioned above came against Illinois (Feb. 8) during the 2004 season.
- ▶ LSU has spent 47 consecutive weeks in the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN/USA Softball Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 21 and No. 20 in this week's edition of the polls.
- ▶ LSU picked up a 6-0 victory over McNeese State Wednesday to christen the new Tiger Park in-front of 2,172 fans.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- Pitcher/outfielder Kirsten Shortridge is currently on a four-game hitting streak and is 8-for-15 during the streak with four stolen bases.
- Shortridge and shortstop Juliana Santos have combined for four of LSU's seven multi-hit games this season.
- LSU is 2-0 when pitcher Cody Trahan starts the game in the circle. The Tigers also are 2-0 when Santos hits third, outfielder Rachel Mitchell hits fourth and second baseman Ashley Langoni hits seventh.

TIGER TERRIFIC IN GRAND OPENING

LSU embarked on the next chapter of its storied history by christening the new Tiger Park Wednesday with a 6-0 victory over McNeese State in front of 2,172 fans.

Prior to the game, LSU honored its softball past and present as former alumni joined the current team on the field for the ribbon cutting ceremony.

Head coach Yvette Girouard cut the ribbon and spoke during the dedication along with Chancellor Mike Martin, Athletic Director Joe Alleva and former Athletic Director Skip Bertman. The 2,172 fans were the second-most to view a Tiger softball game.

Each of the head coaches from LSU's women's athletic teams threw out the ceremonial first pitch, including D-D Breaux (Gymnastics), Fran Flory (Volleyball), Brian Lee (Soccer), Adam Schmitt (Swimming & Diving), Dennis Shaver (Track & Field), Karen Bashnen (Golf) and assistant coach Kenya Larkin-Landers (Basketball)

"First, I want to thank the tremendous crowd that came out here this evening," Girouard said. "Now we can breathe. The players were very nervous trying to get acclimated and they didn't look like they were very focused. We had some great things go our way and we pulled through."

LSU dented the scoreboard in the third inning as Kirsten Short-

ridge slapped a single to third base. She stole second and third base before Jazz Jackson ripped a double into the right centerfield gap to give the Tigers a 1-0 edge.

"I wanted our first game [in the new Tiger Park] to be memorable," Jackson said. "I didn't really think about driving in the first RBI. I just wanted our team to win."

LSU struck for five runs in the fifth inning without a hit for the final margin of 6-0. The Tigers capitalized on two McNeese State (0-6) errors and five passed balls in the frame.

A LOOK BACK AT HAWAII

LSU had an amazing trip to the islands that included stops at Pearl Harbor and the Polynesian Culture Center.

The Tigers went 3-2 at the Oceanic Time Warner Cable Paradise Classic, including a pair of wins over host Hawaii (Feb. 6 & 7) and an opening game triumph over UAB (Feb. 5).

LSU overcame a four-run deficit in the seventh inning and won 6-5 in nine innings during the consolation game. The last time the Tigers accomplished that feat came at Georgia in 2003.

Sophomore outfielder Ashley Applegate provided the game-tying hit and game-winning bases loaded walk to complete the comeback.

Junior pitcher/outfielder Kirsten Shortridge and freshman shortstop Juliana Santos earned All-Tournament honors.

Shortridge compiled a pair of three-hit games against Hawaii (Feb. 6) and UAB (Feb. 7) en route to a .471 batting average. She also went 3-for-4 in the stolen base department.

Santos hit .353 and belted her first career home run against Hawaii (Feb. 6). She also had a solid weekend on defense with a 1.000 fielding percentage, including 10 putouts and three assists.

Junior outfielder Rachel Mitchell picked up where she left out in 2008 with a pair of doubles and four RBIs.

Freshman first baseman Anissa Young hit a grand slam during her first collegiate at-bat against UAB (Feb. 5).

Sophomore pitcher Casey Faile hurled a complete game in LSU's 6-5 win against Hawai'i (Feb. 6) during pool play. She also picked up a save against UAB (Feb. 5).

Freshman pitcher Brittany Mack turned in an impressive six-strikeout, five-inning performance against Hawai'i (Feb. 7) that included two scoreless innings during the international tiebreaker.

MITCHELL AND SHORTRIDGE ON USA SOFTBALL POY LIST

Junior outfielder Rachel Mitchell was joined by junior pitcher/outfielder Kirsten Shortridge as two of 50 players named to the eighth annual USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year watch list as announced by the Amateur Softball Association.

The pair were two of 12 players from the SEC to be represented on the list. LSU has had at least two players on this list in four of the last five seasons.

A First-Team SEC pick and Second-Team NFCA All-South Region selection in 2008, Mitchell paced LSU's offense by ranking inside the SEC's Top 10 in seven offensive categories, including batting average (.374), home runs (11), RBIs (51) and slugging percentage (.665).

Shortridge was a dual threat on Baylor's 2007 Women's College World Series team and looks to return to the form that won her the Big 12 Freshman of the Year award. She hit .340 and posted 16 multi-hit efforts for the Bears.

In the circle, Shortridge compiled a 17-6 mark in the circle and secured three wins over nationally ranked foes.

The USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Award, considered the Heisman Trophy of women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country.

Former Tiger three-time All-American Britni Sneed was one of 10 finalists for the award in 2002 followed by two-time All-American Kristin Schmidt during the 2003 season. In 2006 and 2007, three-time All-American Leslie Klein was one of 25 finalists for the honor.

The 2009 Preseason Watch List is comprised of 50 players representing 32 schools and 13 different NCAA Division I Conferences. The ASA will announce the 25 finalists on April 1. A player does not have to appear on the initial watch list to be considered as a Top 25 finalist, but once the Top 25 is named, the remaining finalist must be selected from that list.

Just days before the start of postseason play, a list of 10 finalists will be named and released on May 6. The final three finalists will be announced May 20 with the winner of the 2009 USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award being announced prior to the start of the 2009 NCAA Women's College World Series in Oklahoma City.

MITCHELL NABS SPOT ON PRESEASON ALL-SEC TEAM

Junior outfielder Rachel Mitchell was one of 12 players to earn a spot on the second annual Preseason All-SEC Team as selected by the league's coaches.

Mitchell, a First-Team All-SEC and Second-Team NFCA All-South Region pick in 2008, finished the season by hitting safely in 13 of her last 16 games with a .438 batting clip to go along with six homers, 20 RBIs and a .958 slugging percentage.

TIGERS PICKED SECOND IN SEC WEST

LSU was picked to finish second in the Southeastern Conference Western Division as chosen by the conference's coaches in the league's annual preseason poll.

The Tigers totaled 21 points, 11 points behind division favorite Alabama. Mississippi State was selected third with 30 points, followed closely by Auburn with 35 points. Arkansas and Ole Miss finished out the Western Division with 49 and 50 points, respectively. Florida led the Eastern Division with 10 points. The Gators also picked up 10 of the 11 votes for the overall conference championship. Tennessee, Georgia, South Carolina and Kentucky complete the Eastern Division.
