SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ For the fourth time in program history, LSU will face both Mississippi schools on the road during the same season. It marks the first time that the Tigers will play the two schools back-to-back.
- ▶ The Tigers have won 14 of its last 16 games and are coming off a three-game sweep of Mississippi State where Rachel Mitchell drove home eight of the team's 15 RBIs. For her efforts, Mitchell earned SEC Player of the Week.
- ▶ LSU has won 35 of 40 all-time meetings against Ole Miss, but the Rebels won two of three last season at Tiger Park.
- ▶ Girouard enters the Ole Miss doubleheader 14 wins away from reaching 1,200 career victories.
- ▶ LSU has spent 52 consecutive weeks in both the *USA Today/NFCA* and *ESPN/USA Softball* Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 21 and No. 20 in this week's edition of the polls.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- LSU has won 14 of its last 16 games dating back to the final game of the Easton Tiger Classic on Feb. 15 and have outscored its opponents, 93-42.
- Kirsten Shortridge ignites the offense racking up 37 hits on a .402 batting average. She has reached base in 24 of 26 games in addition to being 14-for-19 in the stolen base department.
- Jazz Jackson has tallied a hit in seven of nine SEC games. She notched a pair of three-hit outings in the series finale against Kentucky and at No. 8 Georgia.
- Juliana Santos has scored a run in 12 of her last 13 games. She also has hit safely in eight of her last nine games and has picked up eight of her 13 RBIs against SEC opponents.
- Rachel Mitchell has knocked a hit in 16 of her last 19 games, including four straight multi-RBI efforts producing 11 RBIs. Five of her six hits scored runs for the Tigers. For her efforts, Mitchell earned SEC Player of the Week.
- The Tigers are 15-1 when Santos hits third followed by Mitchell in the cleanup spot.
- Nine of Ashley Langoni's last 12 hits have produced RBIs, including a fifth inning solo homer in game one and a RBI-single during the first inning of game two against No. 2 Alabama.
- Langoni is batting .324 (11-of-34) and has driven home 12 of her team-leading 15 RBIs from the No. 5 spot in the lineup.
- Ashley Applegate has slapped a hit in six of nine SEC games, including a career-best four hits in game two against Kentucky. The last time a Tiger reached that feat was Killian Roesser against Arkansas during the 2007 season.
- Applegate is one RBI away from matching her total from last season. Her eight RBIs are sixth on the team.
- Nine of Anissa Young's 13 RBIs are on her four home runs. She is hitting .357 (15-for-42) when putting the ball in play.
- Morgan Russell has registered a hit in four of her last eight games when starting at catcher, including her first career

- multi-hit effort at No. 8 Georgia.
- After starting the season 0-for-9, Jessica Mouse is hitting .377 (17-for-45) in her last 18 games, including a stretch of hitting safely in seven of last eight games.
- LSU is 14-2 when Mouse hits at the bottom of the lineup.

CIRCLE NOTES

- Cody Trahan has won six of her last eight starts. She is coming off a seven-strikeout performance over five innings where she picked up a no decision in game one at Mississippi State.
- Brittany Mack earned a pair of wins in Saturday's doubleheader at Mississippi State. She fired two innings of relief with four strikeouts in game one before compiling a complete game allowing one run in three hits during the second game.
- Kirsten Shortridge returned to the circle for the first time since facing UAB (Feb. 21). She fired four innings of three-hit relief and secured LSU's doubleheader sweep over No. 2 Alabama by retiring eight of the last nine batters she faced.
- Casey Faile has not allowed an earned run in her last six appearances, a stretch of 13.1 innings. She tossed three innings of one-hit relief en route to the win during the series finale at Mississippi State.

OFF THE BENCH

- Lauren Capello has reached base in six of her eight at-bats as a pinch hitter with three walks, two hits and a hit-by-pitch.
- Casey Faile has a hit in four of her seven starts, including a seventh inning RBI-double at Hawai'i (Feb. 7).
- Katie Guillory has scored five times as a pinch runner, including the game-tying run in the series finale at Mississippi State. She also has gone 3-for-7 at the plate with an RBI.
- Courtney Hollier has drawn a walk in five of her last 10 games she has registered an at-bat.
- Katie Hamilton has reached base in all four games she has played in, including a three-game hitting streak. She returned to Georgia before LSU's home opener due for personal reasons.

IT'S NOT SO BAD BEING TRENDY

- LSU is 12-1 when hitting a home run against a 8-5 mark when not hitting a homer.
- The Tigers have won 10 of its 15 games decided by one run. Six of LSU's nine SEC games have been decided in this fashion.
- LSU is 13-1 when scoring first, including an unbeaten 9-0 mark when scoring in the first inning.
- The Tigers are 20-3 when scoring three or more runs.
- LSU has won six of its seven games that begin after 6 p.m.

GOING THE DISTANCE

- LSU has already played six extra inning games and had five additional games where the lead has changed hand in the final two innings.
- The Tigers are 7-4 in those games, including a 5-1 comeback victory in the series finale at Mississippi State.
- After trimming the deficit to 5-4 heading into the sixth inning, Jessica Mouse knocked a RBI-triple followed by Kirsten Shortridge RBI-single. LSU added an insurance run in the 7th.
- LSU also completed a four-run comeback victory at Hawai'i (Feb. 7). The Tigers scored four in the seventh before winning the game on an Ashley Applegate walk in the ninth.
- The last time LSU accomplished that feat came at Georgia during the 2003 season.
- The Tigers also overcame two-run deficits on consecutive days to win a pair of one-run games against then-No. 5 Texas A&M (Feb. 14 & 15).

MITCHELL AND SHORTRIDGE ON USA SOFTBALL POY LIST

Junior outfielder Rachel Mitchell was joined by junior pitcher/outfielder Kirsten Shortridge as two of 50 players named to the eighth annual USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year watch list as announced by the Amateur Softball Association.

The pair were two of 12 players from the SEC to be represented on the list. LSU has had at least two players on this list in four of the last five seasons.

The USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Award, considered the Heisman Trophy of women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country.

Former Tiger three-time All-American Britni Sneed was one of 10 finalists for the award in 2002 followed by two-time All-American Kristin Schmidt during the 2003 season. In 2006 and 2007, three-time All-American Leslie Klein was one of 25 finalists for the honor.

The 2009 Preseason Watch List is comprised of 50 players representing 32 schools and 13 different NCAA Division I Conferences. The ASA will announce the 25 finalists on April 1. A player does not have to appear on the initial watch list to be considered as a Top 25 finalist, but once the Top 25 is named, the remaining finalist must be selected from that list.

Just days before the start of postseason play, a list of 10 finalists will be named and released on May 6. The final three finalists will be announced May 20 with the winner of the 2009 USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award being announced prior to the start of the 2009 NCAA Women's College World Series in Oklahoma City.

TIGERS PICKED SECOND IN SEC WEST

LSU was picked to finish second in the Southeastern Conference Western Division as chosen by the conference's coaches in the league's annual preseason poll.

The Tigers totaled 21 points, 11 points behind division favorite Alabama. Mississippi State was selected third with 30 points, followed closely by Auburn with 35 points. Arkansas and Ole Miss finished out the Western Division with 49 and 50 points, respectively.

Florida led the Eastern Division with 10 points. The Gators also picked up 10 of the 11 votes for the overall conference championship. Tennessee, Georgia, South Carolina and Kentucky complete the Eastern Division.
