## SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU and Tennessee renew its rivalry with a critical SEC weekend series at the new Tiger Park. First pitch for Saturday's doubleheader and Sunday's single game is set for 1 p.m.
- ▶ The last time the Lady Vols visited Baton Rouge was as the No.1 team in the nation riding a 25-game winning streak during the 2007 season.
- ▶ LSU won two of three in front of the program's two largest crowds at the old Tiger Park.
- ▶ Emily Turner outdueled Monica Abbott in the series finale en route to sweeping NFCA and USA Softball National Player of the Week accolades.
- ▶ Head coach Yvette Girouard enters the Tennessee series 12 wins away from reaching 1,200 career victories.
- ▶ LSU has spent 54 consecutive weeks in both the *USA Today/NFCA* and *ESPN/USA Softball* Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 18 and No. 17 in this week's edition of the polls.

**STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS**

- LSU has won 16 of its last 19 games dating back to the final game of the Easton Tiger Classic on Feb. 15 and have outscored its opponents, 104-49.
- Kirsten Shortridge ignites the offense racking up 41 hits on a .390 batting average. She has reached base in 26 of 29 games in addition to being 15-for-20 in the stolen base department.
- Jazz Jackson has tallied a hit in nine of 11 SEC games. She notched a pair of three-hit outings in the series finale against Kentucky and at No. 8 Georgia.
- Juliana Santos has scored a run in 14 of her last 16 games. She also has hit safely in 10 of her last 12 games and has picked up nine of her 14 RBIs against SEC opponents.
- Rachel Mitchell has knocked a hit in 17 of her last 22 games. Five of her last seven hits have produced 11 RBIs. She earned SEC, LSWA and NFCA National Player of the Week (Week of March 23).
- The Tigers are 16-2 when Santos hits third followed by Mitchell in the cleanup spot.
- 10 of Ashley Langoni's last 14 hits have driven home RBIs. She has knocked in 14 of her 17 RBIs from the No. 5 spot.
- Ashley Applegate has slapped a hit in seven of 11 SEC games, including four multi-hit efforts. She is one RBI away from matching her total from last season.
- Nine of Anissa Young's 16 RBIs are on her four home runs. She is hitting .360 (18-for-50) when putting the ball in play and has picked up a RBI in three of her last five games.
- Morgan Russell looks to break out of a 0-for-16 slump over her last seven games but drew a pair of walks at Southern Miss that extended innings that eventually scored runs.
- Jessica Mouse is hitting .358 (19-for-53) in her last 21 games and has hit safely in eight of last 11 games. She provided a pair of RBIs last time out at Southern Miss.

- LSU is 16-3 when Mouse hits at the bottom of the lineup.

- After starting the season with six no-decisions, Cody Trahan has gone 6-2 with five complete games. She is coming off an eight-strikeout performance where she carried a no-hitter through six innings at Ole Miss.
- Brittany Mack tossed a complete game with six strikeouts and allowed two runs on four hits at Southern Miss. She has won seven consecutive decisions over her last 13 outings.
- Kirsten Shortridge returned to the circle for the first time since facing UAB (Feb. 21). She fired four innings of three-hit relief and secured LSU's doubleheader sweep over No. 2 Alabama by retiring eight of the last nine batters she faced.
- Casey Faile has not allowed an earned run in her last six appearances, a stretch of 13.1 innings. She tossed three innings of one-hit relief en route to the win during the series finale at Mississippi State.

- LSU is 12-2 when hitting a home run against a 10-5 mark when not hitting a homer.
- LSU has won 10 of its 14 games decided by one run. Seven of the Tigers 10 SEC games have been decided in this fashion.
- LSU is 15-2 when scoring first, including an unbeaten 9-0 mark when scoring in the first inning.
- The Tigers are 22-3 when scoring three or more runs.
- LSU has won nine of its 10 games that begin after 6 p.m.

GOING THE DISTANCE

- In 10 of LSU's 22 wins this season, LSU has entered the fifth inning either trailing or tied.
- Jessica Mouse, Kirsten Shortridge and Jazz Jackson provided back-to-back-to-back RBI singles with two outs during the sixth inning at Southern Miss (April 1).
- Trailing 5-1 going into the fifth inning in the series finale at Mississippi State (March 22), the Tigers scored six runs in the last three innings highlighted by a Mouse RBI-triple and Shortridge RBI-single in the sixth inning to give LSU the lead.
- Mouse broke a 4-4 tie belting a home run during the seventh inning of the series opener at Mississippi State (March 21).
- LSU exploded for five runs in the fifth inning down 5-1 in game two against Alabama (March 18). With the bases loaded, Rachel Mitchell cleared the bases with a game-tying double and used alert base running to score the game-winning run on a Crimson Tide error.
- One week earlier, Morgan Russell scored on a wild pitch in the bottom of the seventh as the Tigers edged Baylor 4-3.
- The Tigers also overcame two-run deficits on consecutive days to win a pair of one-run games against then-No. 5 Texas A&M (Feb. 14 & 15).
- Shortridge and Mitchell provided the late-winning heroics with game-winning singles against the Aggies.
- LSU completed a four-run comeback victory at Hawai'i (Feb. 7). The Tigers scored four in the seventh before winning the game on an Ashley Applegate walk in the ninth.
- The last time LSU accomplished that feat came at Georgia during the 2003 season.

MITCHELL NABS SPOT ON PRESEASON ALL-SEC TEAM

Junior outfielder Rachel Mitchell was one of 12 players to earn a spot on the second annual Preseason All-SEC Team as selected by the league's coaches.

Mitchell, a First-Team All-SEC and Second-Team NFCA All-South Region pick in 2008, finished the season by hitting safely in 13 of her last 16 games with a .438 batting clip to go along with six homers, 20 RBIs and a .958 slugging percentage.

TIGERS PICKED SECOND IN SEC WEST

LSU was picked to finish second in the Southeastern Conference Western Division as chosen by the conference's coaches in the league's annual preseason poll.

The Tigers totaled 21 points, 11 points behind division favorite Alabama. Mississippi State was selected third with 30 points, followed closely by Auburn with 35 points.

Arkansas and Ole Miss finished out the Western Division with 49 and 50 points, respectively.

Florida led the Eastern Division with 10 points. The Gators also picked up 10 of the 11 votes for the overall conference championship.

Tennessee, Georgia, South Carolina and Kentucky complete the Eastern Division.
