SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU enters the SEC Tournament winners of five of its last six games and concluded the regular season by taking two of three at Auburn.
- ▶ LSU's pitching staff has registered a 1.14 ERA during the stretch highlighted by a 4-0 mark by Cody Trahan. She has limited opponents to a .133 batting average.
- ▶ Kirsten Shortridge, Jazz Jackson and Juliana Santos picked up All-SEC accolades. Shortridge notched All-SEC First-Team honors, while Jackson picked up an All-SEC Second-Team selection. Santos was named to the SEC All-Freshman squad.
- ▶ Head coach Yvette Girouard enters the SEC Tournament two wins away from reaching 1,200 career victories.
- ▶ LSU has spent 59 consecutive weeks in both the *USA Today/NFCA* and *ESPN/USA Softball* Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 20 and No. 23 in this week's edition of the polls.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- After starting the season 6-4, LSU has won 26 of its last 38 games (.684). The Tigers enter the SEC Tournament winners of five of its last six games.
- LSU is 34-12 (.739) all-time at the SEC Tournament, including five tournament titles (1999, 2001, 2002, 2004, 2007).
- The Tigers have won two of its three SEC Tournament meetings with Tennessee, including a 1-0 opening round victory in 2003. The Lady Vols earned a 3-0 win in the 2006 final.
- Kirsten Shortridge ignites the offense racking up 74 hits on a .430 batting average as an All-SEC First-Team selection. She has reached base in 42 of 48 games in addition to being 24-for-30 in the stolen base department.
- Shortridge has hit safely in 18 of her last 21 games, including seven consecutive games. She has posted 14 of her team-best 25 multi-hit efforts during the streak. Her 25 multi-hit games are second in the SEC (see page 5).
- Shortridge started the Auburn series 6-for-6 and has gone 13-for-18 over her last six games.
- Jazz Jackson has tallied a hit in 20 of 25 SEC games and returned to the All-SEC Second Team after earning similar honors during the 2007 season.
- Juliana Santos notched a spot on the SEC All-Freshman squad. She picked up RBIs during all three games of the South Carolina and has tallied 19 of her 25 RBIs against SEC opponents.
- Rachel Mitchell has compiled hits in five of her last eight games. She also has collected 22 of her team-best 36 RBIs over her last 25 games.
- Earlier this season, Mitchell swept SEC, LSWA and NFCA National Player of the Week honors (Week of March 23).
- The Tigers are 25-10-1 when Santos hits third followed by Mitchell at cleanup in the batting order.
- Ashley Applegate has slapped a hit in 15 of 26 SEC games, including six multi-hit efforts. Her batting average has dipped below .300 only three times since Feb. 20.

- Applegate has already surpassed her RBI total from a season ago and recorded RBIs during the last two games of the South Carolina series.
- 15 of Anissa Young's 28 RBIs are on her team-leading seven home runs. She has tallied a hit in 14 of her last 24 games with five of her seven multi-hit efforts during that stretch.
- Young also has seen her batting average climb from .190 to .234 over those 24 games. She is hitting .353 (30-for-85) when putting the ball in play this season.
- 12 of Ashley Langoni's last 17 hits have produced RBIs. Nine of those hits have gone for extra bases as Langoni has knocked in 18 of her 23 RBIs from the No. 5 spot in the lineup.
- Langoni snapped an 0-for-21 slump over an 11-game stretch with a two-run home run during the Auburn series finale.
- Langoni, Santos and Young have accounted for 39.6 percent (76-of-192) of LSU's RBIs this season. The trio also has knocked 17 of the team's 27 home runs.
- Morgan Russell has reached base in seven of her last 12 starts at catcher where she registers an at-bat.
- Jessica Mouse has reached base in 17 of her last 40 plate appearances over the last 15 games. She has eight hits to go along with seven walks in addition to being hit-by-a-pitch and reaching on an error once.
- LSU is 26-11-1 when Mouse hits at the bottom of the lineup and has picked up 13 of her 14 RBIs from the No. 9 hole.

CIRCLE NOTES

- Cody Trahan has gone 4-0 with a 0.81 ERA and three complete games over her last four starts.
- Trahan has limited opponents to a .133 opponents and racked up 19 strikeouts. Eight of Trahan's 11 victories have come against SEC opponents.
- Kirsten Shortridge fired a three-hit shutout during game two of the South Carolina series. She is 2-1 with a 1.98 ERA in SEC games and strung together 9.1 consecutive frames without allowing a run.

- Shortridge also tossed four innings of three-hit relief to secure LSU's doubleheader sweep over No. 2 Alabama (March 18).
- Brittany Mack had her streak of eight consecutive wins snapped in game one of the Arkansas series (April 10).
- Mack limited No. 1 Florida (April 18) to one run on five hits over nine innings during the first two games of the series.
- After logging 24.0 innings over the first two months of the season, Casey Faile has racked up 27.0 innings of work in April and May.
- Faile has won two of her three appearances, including mowing down a career-best eight batters in game one against Southeastern Louisiana (April 15).

OFF THE BENCH

- Lauren Capello has reached base in seven of her 17 at-bats as a pinch hitter with three hits, three walks and was hit-by-pitch once.
- Casey Faile has recorded a hit in seven of her last 13 games with seven RBIs. She belted a two-run homer in the seventh inning of the Auburn series finale.
- Katie Guillory has scored six times as a pinch runner, including the game-tying run in the series finale at Mississippi State. She also has gone 3-for-11 at the plate with an RBI.
- Courtney Hollier has appeared in 32 games being used primarily as a defensive replacement at second base.
- After missing LSU's first 26 games, Tiffany Shaw has scored 10 times in 16 pinch running appearances representing the tying runs at Southern Miss (April 1) and Nicholls (April 7) in addition to the winning run at Auburn (May 3).
- Katie Hamilton has reached base in all four games she has played in, including a three-game hitting streak. She returned to Georgia before LSU's home opener due for personal reasons.

IT'S NOT SO BAD BEING TRENDY

- LSU is 16-5-1 when hitting a home run against a 16-10 mark when not hitting a homer.
- LSU has won 12 of its 20 games decided by one run. 11 of the Tigers 26 SEC games were decided in this fashion.
- LSU is 23-2-1 when scoring first, including an unbeaten 14-0-1 mark when scoring in the first inning.
- In 10 of those 14 games, Kirsten Shortridge has scored the game's first run.
- The Tigers are 31-6-1 when scoring three or more runs.
- LSU has won 12 of its 14 games that have begun after 6 p.m.

GOING THE DISTANCE

- In 12 of LSU's 35 wins this season, LSU has entered the fifth inning either trailing or tied.
- With LSU down 1-0 in the fifth inning, Ashley Langoni cranked a two-run home run in the regular season finale at Auburn (May 3). Casey Faile tacked on a two-run dinger in the seventh inning for the 4-1 victory.
- Behind 1-0 in the seventh inning, Juliana Santos scored pinch runner Tiffany Shaw with a triple into a right centerfield gap at Nicholls (April 7). On the next batter, a Colonel fielding error allowed Santos to score the game winning run.
- Jessica Mouse, Kirsten Shortridge and Jazz Jackson provided back-to-back-to-back RBI singles with two outs to turn a 2-1 deficit into a 4-2 advantage during the sixth inning at Southern Miss (April 1).
- Trailing 5-1 going into the fifth inning of the series finale at Mississippi State (March 22), the Tigers scored six runs in the last three innings highlighted by a Mouse RBI-triple and Shortridge RBI-single in the sixth inning to give LSU the lead.
- Mouse broke a 4-4 tie belting a home run during the seventh inning of the series opener at Mississippi State (March 21).
- LSU exploded for five runs in the fifth inning down 5-1 in game two against Alabama (March 18). With the bases loaded, Rachel Mitchell cleared the bases with a game-tying double and used alert base running to score the game-winning run on a Crimson Tide error.
