### TIGERS ON THE TUBE

LSU will play on television six times this season. The Tigers will make two appearances on Cox Sports Television (Channel 37), including the Sept. 23 match against Florida and the Oct. 17 match against Ole Miss, both in the Maravich Center. LSU will also take on Florida in Gainesville on SEC Regional Sports Network (FSN Southwest - Channel 38) on Oct. 26. In addition, Pelican Sports (Digital Cable Channel 113) has picked up a trio of Tiger matches. The local cable access station will televise the Nov. 4 match against Tennessee, the Nov. 18 match against Auburn and regular season finale against Tulane on Nov. 24.

## HEAD COACH FRAN FLORY

Going into her 10th year as head coach at LSU, recording a 155-115 (.574) record ... Overall record in her 17th year as a head coach is 265-229 (.536) ... Three-time Louisiana Coach of the Year (2001, 2005, 2006) ... In 2006, guided the Tigers to back-to-back SEC West titles, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1992 season and a school record 16 SEC wins ... In 2005, guided the Tigers to first SEC West title in school history, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 13 years ... In addition, she led LSU to the most wins since the 1993 season and most SEC wins since 1992 ... In 2004, she led the Tigers to a third place finish in the SEC West, the seventh consecutive year LSU finished at least third in the West ... In second stint with LSU ... Was an assistant coach from 1988-1991 ... Helped Tigers to three conference titles, three SEC tournament titles and two Final Fours ... Spent five years as the head coach at Kentucky, compiling a 78-80 (.494) record ... In first year, led Wildcats to a 29-4 record and took UK to the second round of the NCAA Tournament en route to being named the Tachikara/AVCA South Region Coach of the Year ... Played at Texas from 1980-1983 ... Member of the 1981 AIAW National Championship team ... Named All-Southwest Conference in 1982.

## QUICK HITS

- ▶ LSU moved up to No. 21 in the AVCA/CSTV poll, marking the 17th-straight week the Tigers have been ranked dating back to the first weekly poll of 2006 and the highest ranking for LSU this season after beginning the year at No. 23.
- ▶ LSU has held four of its six opponents to hitting percentages below .100. Only once has an opponent hit over .200 this season. In addition, the Tigers held UL-Monroe to a negative hitting percentage for the match.
- ▶ **ELENA MARTINEZ** has recorded double-digit digs in every match this season. She is just the second player in school history to record 30 digs, joining Luciana Reis in 1993. In addition, **MARTINEZ** has recorded 20 or more digs in three of the Tigers' six matches this season.
- ▶ **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** leads the SEC in blocks per game. In a four-game win over Rice, she recorded 12 blocks, a career best and the fourth most blocks in a four-game match in LSU history. In addition, her nine block assists were the sixth most in a four-game match.
- ▶ **MARINA SKENDER** is second on the team with 0.57 aces per game. For her career, she has recorded 122 aces, only 22 away from breaking into the top 10 in LSU career history. After breaking the Tiger single-season aces per game record last year, **SKENDER** now ranks fifth in LSU career service aces per game.
- ▶ **KYNA WASHINGTON** has recorded a service ace in all six of LSU's matches this year. She currently leads the SEC with 0.86 aces per game.

## OPPONENT NOTES

### DRAKE (2-2, 0-0 MVC)



Drake enters the Iowa Challenge with a record of 2-2. The Bulldogs opened the year with a loss to UMKC, before going 2-1 in the Hampton Inn Invitational last weekend. Drake swept Green Bay and Florida Atlantic, sandwiched around a five-game loss to Furman. Emily Madden leads the Bulldogs with 3.31 kills per game, while Mikayla Sims is second on the team with 3.12 kills per game and leads the team with a .316 hitting percentage. Samantha Nelson is the only Drake player with over a block a game, coming in with 1.06, and Alana Wittenburg leading the Bulldogs with 3.94 digs per game.

### IOWA (4-1, 0-0 Big 10)



Iowa enters the Iowa Challenge with a record of 4-1. The Hawkeyes rebounded from a season-opening five-game loss to nationally ranked BYU to win their last four contests. Catherine Smale leads the Hawkeyes with 2.80 kills per game, one of five Iowa players averaging over two kills per game. The Hawkeyes have two players with over a block per game, led by Laura Kremer with 1.55 and Becky Walters with 1.20.

### IOWA STATE (3-4, 0-0 Big 12)



Iowa State enters the Iowa Challenge with a record of 3-4. The Cyclones dropped two straight to open the year before winning three of their last five contests. Iowa State has wins over Northern Arizona, Long Island and Northern Iowa, but losses to Middle Tennessee, Creighton, New Mexico and Arizona State. Erin Boeve leads the Cyclones with 3.89 kills per game, followed by Lauren Cummings with 3.19 kills per game. Jen Malclom leads ISU with 1.81 blocks per game, while Laura Cady leads the Cyclones with 3.70 digs per game.

## LSU IN THE CSTV/AVCA POLL

After winning the Mizuno Invitational II last weekend to open the season at 6-0, the LSU volleyball team moved up one spot in the AVCA/CSTV Coaches poll to No. 21. The No. 21 national ranking marks the 17th consecutive week the Tigers have been among the Top 25, the longest streak since being ranked for 52 straight weeks from 1989 through 1993.

## LSU VS. RANKED TEAMS

LSU is scheduled to play two matches against nationally ranked teams during the 2007 season, both against No. 6 Florida as part of the SEC round robin schedule. In addition, the Tigers have eight matches scheduled against teams that are currently receiving votes in the national poll. LSU will take on Notre Dame at home in October and Tulane at home in November. The Tigers will also face three teams in the conference that are receiving votes - Tennessee, Arkansas and Ole Miss.

## SERVING SKENDER

For her career, junior **MARINA SKENDER** has recorded 122 service aces, which averages out to 0.513 aces per game. After setting the school record with a .675 service ace per game average in 2006, the Zagreb, Croatia, native moved into the top 10 in career service aces per game. **SKENDER** now ranks fifth in career aces per game and is 22 aces from breaking into the top 10 in career aces.

## **BOTH ON AND OFF**

When LSU's serving is on, it's really on and usually leads directly to points, but when it's not, it also costs points. This season, the Tigers rank second in the SEC with an amazing 2.83 service aces per game. LSU has recorded 65 aces in 23 games, led by 19 from **KYNA WASHINGTON**, 13 from **MARINA SKENDER** and 11 from **ELENA MARTINEZ**. Eight Tigers have recorded an ace this season, including seven with four or more.

Conversely, LSU has also posted 93 service errors in the same period, which averages out to just over four a game. Recording a .850 team serving percentage, the Tigers' best effort came against UL-Monroe when LSU had a season-high 17 aces but also had 14 errors. In no match this year have the Tigers failed to record double-digit service errors, while failing to record double-digit aces just twice.

## **MARTINEZ NAMED SEC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**ELENA MARTINEZ** was named the SEC Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 4. The New Orleans native helped lead the Tigers to a 3-0 record with wins over Illinois, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Rice. In the weekend finale against Rice, **MARTINEZ** recorded 30 digs in the four-game win, which tied for the second-most digs in any match in LSU history. It also marked the second most digs in a four-game match by a Tiger. In the weekend opening win against Illinois, she posted 20 digs in the five-game match, before posting 19 in a three-game win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.

## **DEGIROLAMO, COOPER, WASHINGTON ON MIZUNO INVIT ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM**

Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** was named the Most Valuable Player of the Mizuno Invitational II, while junior **KYNA WASHINGTON** and sophomore **BRITTNEE COOPER** were named to the all-tournament team. It marked the second-straight MVP honor for **DEGIROLAMO** and the second all-tournament team for **COOPER**. **DEGIROLAMO** tied for the fourth most total blocks in a four-game match with 12 and the sixth most block assists with nine. In back-to-back matches, **DEGIROLAMO** tied her career high with 17 kills against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Rice. Against the Islanders, she also hit a team-best .531 with seven blocks and six digs. With her 12 blocks and 17 kills against the Owls, it marked her fourth career double-double. **WASHINGTON HAD** 15 kills against Rice after posting 11 in the match against Corpus Christi, while hitting .360 with four digs and four service aces against the Islanders. **COOPER** posted 11 kills and seven blocks against the Owls.

## **MARTINEZ TIED FOR SECOND MOST DIGS IN LSU HISTORY**

Against Rice on Sept. 1, libero **ELENA MARTINEZ** recorded 30 digs, tying her for the second-most digs in any match in LSU history. It also marked the second most digs in a four-game match by a Tiger. The last time an LSU player posted 30 digs was Luciana Reis with a school-record 31 against Kansas on Dec. 4, 1993. The only other 30-dig match in school history was also by Luciana Reis in a three-game match against Arkansas State on Oct. 22, 1993.

## **DEGIROLAMO BLOCKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS**

Against Rice on Sept. 1, middle blocker **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** tied for the fourth most total blocks in a four-game match with 12 and the sixth most block assists with nine. The last time a Tiger posted 12 blocks in a four-game match was Julie Stempel against Southern California on Nov. 16, 1989, and the last LSU player to post nine block assists in a four-game match was **DEGIROLAMO** last season against Kentucky on Sept. 17.

## DEGIROLAMO, SKENDER, COOPER ON TIGER CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO** was named the Most Valuable Player of the Mizuno Tiger Classic, while junior **MARINA SKENDER** and sophomore **BRITTNEE COOPER** were named to the all-tournament team. A middle blocker, **DEGIROLAMO** led the tournament with a .517 hitting percentage, breaking her career high with a .750 clip against New Orleans. Averaging 3.09 kills per game, she failed to record an error in her first two contests. In addition, she led the tournament with 1.36 blocks per game. **SKENDER** posted the second best hitting percentage on the team at .382, while recording 2.18 kills per game, 0.73 service aces per game, 2.36 digs per game and 0.82 blocks per game. **COOPER** recorded a career-best nine blocks against Saint Louis as she finished the weekend with 1.30 blocks per game. In addition, she posted 2.30 kills per game while hitting .245.

## TIGERS HOLD UL-MONROE TO NEGATIVE HITTING MARK

Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU held the Warhawks to a -.025 hitting percentage, the lowest hitting percentage since holding Nicholls State to a -.056 mark on Aug. 26, 2006. It marked the fourth time in Fran Flory's 10-year tenure at LSU that the Tigers have held an opponent in negative figures hitting. In 2002, Alcorn State also recorded a negative hitting mark, posting a -.043 clip on Aug. 30, 2002, while Georgia hit -.051 on Oct. 3, 1999.

## TIGERS POST EIGHTH MOST ACES IN A THREE-GAME MATCH

Against UL-Monroe on Aug. 25, LSU recorded 17 service aces, the eight most aces in a three-game match in school history. The mark was four behind the school record of 21 aces, which was recorded against Mississippi State on Nov. 12, 1987.

## LSU RETURNS THREE STARTERS FOR 2007

The Tigers return three starters from the 2006 team that won the SEC West and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Junior **MARINA SKENDER**, a 2006 first-team All-SEC selection, led the team in kills and aces and ranked second in digs. She broke the LSU single-season record for aces per game with the 11th most single-season aces. Junior **KYNA WASHINGTON** ranked second on the team in kills and fourth in digs. Sophomore **LAUREN DEGIROLAMO**, who earned Louisiana Freshman of the Year honors and was an SEC All-Freshman selection, led the team in blocks and hitting percentage. She earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors on four occasions, the most of any freshman, and recorded the third most single-season blocks per game in school history.

## LSU BRINGS IN ACCOMPLISHED FRESHMEN

The Tigers bring in a quintet of accomplished freshmen to compliment the talented returning players LSU has in place. **SHANNON BALIKOWSKY** earned a redshirt last season and will begin the 2007 season as a freshman. A Baton Rouge phenom, **BRITTNEY JOHNSON** was the Most Valuable Player for Louisiana classes 3A and under. She was also named the state's top volleyball player in all classes while playing at the setter position. A Texas all-state selection and two-time Dallas Morning News Player of the Week selection, **ANGELA BENSEND** comes in as an outstanding outside hitter. The towering 6-4 **TANIA SCHATOW** comes in as the "Best Volleyball Player in Michigan" as rated by Rise Magazine. The last addition to the 2007 class, **HALEY REUTHER** from New Orleans was selected Miss Louisiana Volleyball in 2006.

## **TIGERS ARE 25-6 IN SEASON OPENERS**

LSU improved to 25-6 all-time in season openers with a 3-0 win over New Orleans at home in the Mizuno Tiger Classic. The Tigers have also won seven straight dating back to 2001. The Tigers are 47-2 overall against New Orleans, including a 3-0 record in season openers. LSU also knocked off the Privateers at home to start the 1982 season and defeated New Orleans on the road to open the 1993 season.

## **TIGERS ARE 13-10 IN SEC OPENERS**

LSU is 13-10 in SEC openers, including a 7-6 mark at home, a 5-4 record on the road and a 1-0 record at neutral sites. The Tigers have now won three in a row. LSU came back from an 0-2 deficit to defeat the Lady Vols in Knoxville and snap Tennessee's 12-match home SEC winning streak last season.

## **LSU PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN SEC WEST**

LSU was picked to finish second in the SEC Western Division in a preseason poll by the league's coaches. The Tigers received 17 points, while Alabama was picked to win the West with 14 points. The LadyBucks were picked third with 28 points, followed by Ole Miss with 36 points. Auburn and Ole Miss rounded out the West with 47 and 53 points respectively.

In the East, Florida, who had earned at least a share of the last 16 SEC championships, was picked to win the title with 10 points and 10 first-place votes. Kentucky, who advanced to the 2006 NCAA Tournament, came in second with 22 points, followed quickly by Tennessee with 25 points. Rounding out the East are Georgia with 41 points and South Carolina with 42.

The Gators were also selected as the overall league champion ahead of the Wildcats, who are receiving votes in the poll, by way of a 10-to-1 vote.

Points were compiled on a 1-2-3-4-5-6 basis for the Western Division and 1-2-3-4-5 for the Eastern Division. Each coach was not allowed to vote for his or her own team and each coach also voted for one team as an overall conference champion

## **LSU CLAIMS BACK-TO-BACK SEC WESTERN DIVISION TITLES**

The Tigers claimed the outright SEC Western Division title last season after sharing the championship with Arkansas in 2005. With a 16-4 SEC mark, LSU finished four games ahead of Alabama in the West in 2006. The Tigers also finished in second place overall, three games behind Florida. Since the SEC went to the divisional format in 1995, LSU had finished as high as second on three occasions, but never won before 2005. The last time LSU won an SEC title was when the Tigers won three straight overall championships from 1989-1991.

## **LSU POSTS GREAT 2006 NUMBERS**

With a 26-5 overall record and a 16-4 mark in SEC play in 2006, LSU recorded the most wins by a Tiger team since the 1992 season and broke the school record for the most conference wins in school history. In 1992, LSU finished the season at 26-9 overall. In 1991, the Tigers were 13-1 in SEC play and won their last SEC championship.
