Postgame Notes

Team Notes

1. LSU's game captains were 70 **Ciron Black**, 84 **Rahim Alem**, 45 **Quinn Johnson**, 32 **Charles Scott** and 6 **Colt David**.
2. LSU won the toss and deferred to the second half. Alabama received the opening kickoff.
3. Tigers extending their notable consecutive starts streak tonight were: LT **Ciron Black** (36), DE **Tyson Jackson** (36), LG **Herman Johnson** (32) and C **Brett Helms** (26).
4. LSU has posted at least 21 points in 30 straight games. The last time the Tigers did not score at least 21 points was at Florida on Oct. 7, 2006.
5. Today's crowd of 93,039 is the largest crowd in the history of Tiger Stadium, surpassing the 92,910 that watched LSU defeat Florida, 28-24 on Oct. 8 last season.
 - a. It represents the 27th straight time the crowd has surpassed 92,000 in Tiger Stadium.
6. Alabama won the toss before the first overtime and elected to play defense.
7. LSU's record in overtime is now 6-5, including a 5-3 mark in Tiger Stadium.

Individual Notes

8. WR **Brandon LaFell** has now caught a pass in 24 straight games dating back to the 2007 Sugar Bowl versus Notre Dame.
 - a. **LaFell** hauled in his sixth receiving touchdown of the season and the 12th of his career on a 14-yard throw from Jarrett Lee with 2:14 left in the second quarter.
9. WR **Demetrius Byrd** has now caught a pass in 19 straight games dating back to last year's Tulane game on Sept. 29.
 - a. **Byrd** hauled in his fourth receiving touchdown of the season and 11th of his career on a 30-yard pass from Jarrett Lee with 6:21 left in the first quarter.
10. QB **Jarrett Lee** tossed his 13th touchdown pass of the season on a 30-yard throw to Demetrius Byrd with 6:21 left in the first quarter.
11. RB **Charles Scott** tallied his 12th rushing touchdown of the season and 22nd of his career on a 30-yard run with 5:57 left in the first quarter.
 - a. **Scott** is one TD shy of Herb Tyler for 10th place in LSU career rushing TDs, and he now moves into ninth place in LSU single-season rushing TDs.
12. S **Chad Jones** forced his second career fumble and first of the season early in the first quarter.
13. CB **Ron Brooks** forced his first career fumble in the first quarter, and K **Josh Jasper** recovered his first career fumble.
14. CB **Patrick Peterson** picked off his first career pass early in the second quarter on the LSU 14-yard line on a throw from Alabama's John Parker Wilson.
15. PK **Colt David** has now made 102 consecutive PATs.
16. DT **Ricky Jean-Francois** blocked the third kick of his career when time expired at the end of the game. Jean-Francois blocked a field goal attempt against Ohio State in the BCS National Championship Game in the second quarter. The first kick he blocked came in 2006.
