SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU is making its 11th NCAA Regional appearance in 13 seasons since softball was reinstated in 1997. The Tigers are 33-20 in NCAA Tournament games, including trips to the 2001 and 2004 Women's College World Series.
- ▶ LSU's .623 NCAA Tournament winning percentage is seventh. An in-depth look at the Tigers NCAA history and individual game records are available on page 7.
- ▶ Kirsten Shortridge, Jazz Jackson and Juliana Santos picked up All-SEC accolades. Shortridge notched All-SEC First-Team honors, while Jackson picked up an All-SEC Second-Team selection. Santos was named to the SEC All-Freshman squad.
- ▶ Head coach Yvette Girouard enters the NCAA Regionals two wins away from reaching 1,200 career victories.
- ▶ LSU has spent 60 consecutive weeks in both the *USA Today/NFCA* and *ESPN/USA Softball* Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 23 in this week's edition of the polls.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- After starting the season 6-4, LSU has won 26 of its last 39 games (.679). The Tigers enter the NCAA Tournament winners of five of its last seven games.
- LSU is a combined 6-6 (.500) against the three other schools participating in the NCAA Tempe Regional.
- Eight of the 12 meetings have come against regional host and No. 10 national seed Arizona State. This weekend marks the fourth time (2001, 2002 & 2003) that the Tigers and Sun Devils have been paired in the same regional. The two teams also met in the 2007 Super Regionals.
- Kirsten Shortridge ignites the offense racking up 75 hits on a .429 batting average as an All-SEC First-Team selection. She has reached base in 43 of 49 games in addition to being 25-for-31 in the stolen base department.
- Shortridge has hit safely in 19 of her last 22 games, including eight consecutive games where she has compiled a sparkling .600 hitting clip (15-for-25). She posted 14 of her team-best 25 multi-hit efforts during SEC games (see page 5).
- Jazz Jackson tallied a hit in 21 of 26 versus SEC opponents and returned to the All-SEC Second Team after earning similar honors during the 2007 season.
- Jackson is second on the squad registering 13 multi-hit efforts, including a trio of three-hit games against Kentucky (March 8), Georgia (March 14) and South Carolina (April 26). She also added a pair of multi-hit games against Florida ace Stacey Nelson (April 18 & 19).
- Juliana Santos notched a spot on the SEC All-Freshman squad. She has picked up RBIs in four of last seven games, including all three games of the South Carolina series (April 25 & 26).
- Santos tallied 20 of her 26 RBIs against SEC opponents and five of her seven multi-RBI efforts highlighted by a five-RBI performance in the series finale against Kentucky (March 8).

- Rachel Mitchell has compiled hits in six of her last nine games. She also has collected 23 of her team-best 37 RBIs over her last 26 games that opened with a three-run double in LSU's 6-5 comeback win over then-No. 2 Alabama (March 18).
- Earlier this season, Mitchell swept SEC, LSWA and NFCA National Player of the Week honors (Week of March 23).
- The Tigers are 25-10-1 (.708) when Santos hits third followed by Mitchell at cleanup in the batting order.
- Ashley Applegate slapped a hit in 15 of 27 SEC games, including six multi-hit efforts. Her batting average has dipped below .300 after four games since Feb. 20.
- Applegate has already surpassed her RBI total from a season ago and recorded four RBIs in her last six games despite going 1-for-18 (.055) at the plate.
- 15 of Anissa Young's 30 RBIs are on her team-leading seven home runs. She has tallied a hit in 15 of her last 25 games with six of her eight multi-hit efforts during that stretch.
- Young also has seen her batting average climb from .190 to .244 over those 25 games. She is hitting .364 (32-for-88) when putting the ball in play this season.
- 12 of Ashley Langoni's last 17 hits have produced RBIs. Nine of those hits have gone for extra bases as Langoni has knocked in 18 of her 23 RBIs from the No. 5 spot in the lineup.
- Langoni snapped an 0-for-21 slump over an 11-game stretch with a two-run home run in the Auburn series finale (May 3).
- Langoni, Santos and Young have accounted for 40.1 percent (79-of-197) of LSU's RBIs this season. The trio also has knocked 17 of the team's 27 home runs.
- Morgan Russell has reached base in seven of her last 13 starts at catcher where she registers an at-bat.
- Jessica Mouse has reached base in 18 of her last 43 plate appearances (.419) over the last 16 games. She has nine hits to go along with seven walks in addition to being hit-by-a-pitch and reaching on an error once.
- LSU is 26-12-1 (.679) when Mouse hits at the bottom of the lineup and has picked up 13 of her 14 RBIs from the No. 9 hole.

CIRCLE NOTES

- Cody Trahan has gone 4-1 with a 1.63 ERA and has tossed three complete games over her last five starts.
- Trahan has limited opponents to a .173 opponents and racked up 23 strikeouts in 30.0 innings of work. Eight of Trahan's 11 victories came against SEC opponents.
- Kirsten Shortridge has strung together 12.1 scoreless innings over her last four appearances, including a three-hitter during the middle game of the South Carolina series (April 25). Her ERA has dropped from 4.70 to 3.16 during that span.
- Shortridge also tossed four innings of three-hit relief to secure LSU's doubleheader sweep over No. 2 Alabama (March 18).
- After logging 24.0 innings over the first two months of the season, Casey Faile has recorded 27.0 innings of work during eight appearances in April and May.
- Faile reeled off a stretch of surrendering only one earned run in 29.2 innings (Feb. 11-April 15). She looks to regain her form after allowing seven earned runs in her last two appearances.
- Brittany Mack won eight straight decisions (Feb. 20-April 10). She notched victories against NCAA Regional foes Texas State (Feb. 21), Baylor (March 11) and Mississippi State (March 21).
- Mack also limited No. 1 Florida (April 18) to one run on five hits over nine innings during the first two games of the series.

OFF THE BENCH

- Lauren Capello has reached base in seven of her 18 at-bats as a pinch hitter with three hits, three walks and was hit-by-pitch
- Casey Faile has recorded a hit in seven of her last 14 games with seven RBIs. She belted a two-run homer in the seventh inning of the Auburn series finale (May 3).
- Katie Guillory has scored six times as a pinch runner, including the game-tying run in the series finale at Mississippi State. She also has gone 3-for-11 at the plate with an RBI.
- Courtney Hollier has appeared in 33 games being used primarily as a defensive replacement at second base.
- After missing LSU's first 26 games, Tiffany Shaw has scored 10 times in 17 pinch running appearances representing the tying runs at Southern Miss (April 1) and Nicholls (April 7) in addition to the winning run at Auburn (May 3).

IT'S NOT SO BAD BEING TRENDY

- LSU is 16-5-1 when hitting a home run against a 16-11 mark when not hitting a homer.
- LSU has won 12 of 21 games decided by one run. 11 of the Tigers 27 games against SEC teams were decided in this fashion.
- LSU is 23-2-1 when scoring first, including an unbeaten 14-0-1 mark when scoring in the first inning. In 10 of those 14 games, Kirsten Shortridge has scored the game's first run.
- The Tigers are 31-7-1 when scoring three or more runs.
- LSU has won 12 of its 15 games that have begun after 6 p.m.

GOING THE DISTANCE

- In 12 of LSU's 35 wins this season, LSU has entered the fifth inning either trailing or tied.
- With LSU down 1-0 in the fifth inning, Ashley Langoni cranked a two-run home run in the regular season finale at Auburn (May 3). Casey Faile tacked on a two-run dinger in the seventh inning for the 4-1 victory.
- Behind 1-0 in the seventh inning, Juliana Santos scored pinch runner Tiffany Shaw with a triple into a right centerfield gap at Nicholls (April 7). On the next batter, a Colonel fielding error allowed Santos to score the game winning run.
- Jessica Mouse, Kirsten Shortridge and Jazz Jackson provided back-to-back-to-back RBI singles with two outs to turn a 2-1 deficit into a 4-2 advantage during the sixth inning at Southern Miss (April 1).
- Trailing 5-1 going into the fifth inning of the series finale at Mississippi State (March 22), the Tigers scored six runs in the last three innings highlighted by a Mouse RBI-triple and

- Shortridge RBI-single in the sixth inning to give LSU the lead.
- Mouse broke a 4-4 tie belting a home run during the seventh inning of the series opener at Mississippi State (March 21).
 - LSU exploded for five runs in the fifth inning down 5-1 in game two against Alabama (March 18). With the bases loaded, Rachel Mitchell cleared the bases with a game-tying double and used alert base running to score the game-winning run on a Crimson Tide error.
 - One week earlier, Morgan Russell scored on a wild pitch in the bottom of the seventh as the Tigers edged Baylor 4-3.
 - The Tigers also overcame two-run deficits on consecutive days to win a pair of one-run games against then-No. 5 Texas A&M (Feb. 14 & 15).
 - Shortridge and Mitchell provided the late-winning heroics with game-winning singles against the Aggies.
 - LSU completed a four-run comeback victory at Hawai'i (Feb. 7). The Tigers scored four in the seventh before winning the game on an Ashley Applegate walk in the ninth.
 - The last time LSU accomplished that feat came at Georgia during the 2003 season.

THE BEST YEAR(S) EVER

- Kirsten Shortridge's .429 batting average second highest in program history for a season only behind Ashlee Ducote's .431 mark during the 2000 season. Her .474 on-base percentage also ranks third for a single season.
- Rachel Mitchell currently holds the program record with a .446 on-base percentage. Camille Harris (2003-06) and Ashlee Ducote (1997-2000) are second at .430.
- Mitchell's .594 career slugging percentage is second only behind Leslie Klein (2004-07) at .607.
