SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ The No. 16 LSU softball team wraps up its regular season schedule and stays on the national stage with a three-game weekend series at No. 18 Tennessee.
- ▶ Games one and three of the series will be televised by ESPN and ESPN U, respectively.
- ▶ The Tigers went 0-3-1 against Tennessee last season, including a 6-5 setback in the quarterfinals of the SEC Tournament on the UT campus. The two teams also combined for the only conference game in league history to finish in a tie.
- ▶ With LSU trailing 3-2, Anissa Young cranked a solo home run during the seventh inning to salvage the tie.
- ▶ An in-depth look at the 2009 season series can be found on pages 8-9 of this packet.
- ▶ LSU has spent 74 consecutive weeks in both the *USA Today/NFCA* and *ESPN/USA Softball* Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 16 and No. 11 in this week's polls.

TIGERS ON THE TUBE

The Tigers are slated to appear on television nine times in 2010, including five games on Cox Sports Network (cable channel 37). As part of the SEC on ESPN television package, LSU's series against Georgia and Tennessee will be carried on ESPN and ESPN U (cable channel 242).

The Tigers have the opportunity to make a multiple television appearances as the entire SEC Tournament is on ESPN and ESPNU. LSU has appeared in seven of the last 10 championship games.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- After starting the season 2-3 at the Time Warner Texas Invitational that featured a quartet of 2009 NCAA Tournament teams, LSU reeled off a program-record 24-game winning streak.
- LSU finished its preconference tournament schedule by winning three consecutive titles at Tiger Park where Ashley Applegate, Rachele Fico [3x], Lauren Houston, Courtney Hollier [2x], Ashley Langoni, Rachel Mitchell, Kirsten Shortridge [2x] and Cody Trahan [2x] all garnered All-Tournament Team accolades.
- The streak marked the third longest run in school history by any LSU team only behind the 1980-81 men's basketball and 1996 & 97 baseball squads.
- LSU outscored its opponents by an impressive 158-18 margin and racked up a .328 team batting average to go along with a stifling 0.58 staff ERA during the streak.
- LSU lost five straight games at No. 6 Florida and No. 6 Alabama, who have appeared in the last two Women's College World Series.
- The Tigers put the skid into the rear view mirror and have strung together a 12-2 mark compiling sweeps over Mississippi State, Arkansas and Kentucky along with a series win over No. 8 Georgia and a mid-week win at Nicholls.
- LSU already has seven players register 20 or more RBIs and are an astonishing 116-for-127 in the stolen base department after the Tigers totaled only 46 stolen bases a season ago. LSU's 2.23 stolen bases per game ranks 10th in the nation.
- The 116 stolen bases are third for a single-season and most during the Yvette Girouard era, while the .913 stolen base success rate is currently on-pace to shatter a program record. The 2008 team notched an .892 mark.
- LSU has played phenomenal defense en route to the SEC's best fielding percentage at .976. The clip also ranks eighth nationally as the Tigers have committed 35 errors over their first 52 games.

- Shortridge, a 2010 All-SEC Preseason Team selection, has slapped hits in 43 of 52 games highlighted by a pair of nine-game streaks [Feb. 21-March 5] & [March 6-20].
- Shortridge has recorded hits during 11 of her last 12 games [April 11-30] and picked up her second SEC Player of the Week award [May 3] after recording a trio of multi-hit efforts against Georgia.
- Shortridge has notched a team-best 26 multi-hit efforts, which are tied for second in the SEC. The Tigers are 23-3 when Shortridge tallies a multi-hit game, while her 77 hits are third in the league.
- After an 8-for-11 weekend at South Carolina, Shortridge joined former All-Americans Kristin Schmidt and Emily Turner as the only Tigers to earn USA Softball Player of the Week [March 16].
- Shortridge has garnered the SEC's second most stolen bases with 42 and swiped multiple bags on 11 occasions this season. She has stolen a base in 14 of her last 25 outings [March 17-April 30], including a steal of home plate to spark LSU's four-run sixth inning in the middle game of the Georgia series [April 30].
- Shortridge has joined Dee Douglas as the only players in program history to steal 40 bases in a season. She needs three stolen bases to match Douglas' single-season mark set during the 1999 season.
- With 28 runs scored over her last 30 games, Shortridge has surged into ninth place in the SEC. She has crossed the plate 45 times and scored the game's first run on 13 occasions this season.
- Rachel Mitchell has collected hits in 18 of her last 23 games [March 20-April 30] highlighted by a quartet of multi-hit performances during her last six outings.
- Mitchell's average has climbed 64 points since the middle game of the Auburn series [March 20] and she checks in with a .357 season clip. Her 15 multi-hit performances are second on the team.
- Mitchell has popped seven home runs and added a team-best 43 RBIs to move into eighth place in the SEC. She belted a two-run homer to open the Georgia series [April 29] to pass three-time All-American Leslie Klein with 33 long balls for the program record.

- Mitchell paces LSU with 13 multi-RBI games and the Tigers are 12-1 when she accomplishes this feat.
- Mitchell has ripped 30 RBIs during her last 29 games [March 13-April 30] sparked by nine in her last six outings [April 24-30] and secured LSWA Hitter of the Week [April 1 & 13] honors twice.
- Mitchell also has drawn 26 walks and is 19-for-20 on the base paths to move into a ninth-place tie in the SEC rankings.
- Both Mitchell and Shortridge were selected to the USA Softball Player of the Year Watch List for the second consecutive season. Shortridge was named one of 25 finalists for the prestigious award [April 7].
- After starting the season 9-for-61, Juliana Santos has reeled off a 9-for-27 clip during her last 11 games [April 14-30]. She has slapped hits in eight of those games highlighted by a two-run shot during the fourth inning of the Kentucky series finale [April 25].
- Santos tallied 20 of her 27 RBIs in SEC action en route to SEC All-Freshmen and NFCA All-South Region First-Team honors in 2009.
- LSU is 30-2 when Allison Falcon starts at shortstop. She turned in a 2-for-2 performance with a clutch two-out RBI-single during the fifth inning to push LSU's lead to 3-1 during the Arkansas series finale [April 18].
- Anissa Young was 9-for-55 at the plate during the month of April but still has managed to add nine RBIs, including a stretch of three of her last five games [April 25-30].
- The Tigers are 19-1 in games where Young has notched RBIs and her 36 RBIs are just outside the SEC's Top 10.
- Young has been issued 21 walks and been hit-by-a-pitch 17 times to set a LSU single-season record. The previous mark was 16 held by Camille Harris during the 2006 season.
- During her two-year career, 33 of Young's 73 RBIs have come on her 15 home runs. The California native also has registered a .332 [69-for-208] hitting clip when putting the ball in play.
- Ashley Langoni has bumped her batting average up to .308 after coming away with a .227 clip last season. She has belted a team-best nine home runs to go along with 32 RBIs.
- Langoni returned to the lineup after missing a 10-game stretch at McNeese State [March 31] and has reeled off 15 RBIs during her last 14 games [April 10-30]. She also earned LSWA Hitter of the Week [April 20] for the second time this season.
- Langoni has produced hits in 10 of those 14 games [April 10-30], including all three games of the Arkansas [April 17-18] and Kentucky [April 24-25] series.
- Langoni matched a career-best with four RBIs against Nicholls [April 14]. She has produced 45 of her 62 career RBIs from either the No. 3 or No. 5 spots in the lineup.
- 35 of Langoni's last 57 hits have produced RBIs with 28 of those hits going for extra bases.
- Ashley Applegate has come away with hits in nine of her last 13 games [April 10-30] and her average is at a .297 mark.
- Applegate has coaxed a team-best 29 walks and been plunked 11 times to garner a .447 on-base clip. She has reached base during 46 of 52 games, including all 24 games of LSU's winning streak earlier this season.
- Applegate is third on the squad with 32 runs scored and LSU is 25-0 this season when she crosses the plate. She laced a RBI-single to break a 1-1 tie during the fifth inning of the series finale against Arkansas [April 18].
- Courtney HOLLIER put an 0-for-12 stretch at the plate behind her and knocked a RBI-single during the series opener against No. 8 Georgia [April 29]. She followed that up with a solo home run in game two to fuel LSU's four-run sixth inning.
- Hollier is hitting .228 for the season and chipped in 20 RBIs after recording a 2-for-32 mark at the plate last season. She recorded a career-best seven-game hitting streak [March 6-17].
- Morgan Russell has gone 15-for-56 and added all 10 of her RBIs during her last 27 games. She ripped a walkoff RBI-single to open the Mississippi State series [April 10].
- Lauren Houston also has produced five RBIs for the Tigers but has gone 0-for-25 during her last 15 games where she earned an at-bat. LSU is 17-1 this season when Houston is the starting catcher.

- Jessica Mouse, who also started one game at catcher, has reached base in 41 of 50 games where she has earned an at-bat.
- Mouse came away with SEC Player of the Week [April 26] accolades after an amazing series at Kentucky [April 24-25] where she went 7-for-8 with five doubles and two RBIs.
- Mouse has boosted her average to .282 for the season and totaled 22 RBIs sparked by six multi-RBI efforts after tallying 14 RBIs during 2009.
- Mouse has produced timely hitting for the Tigers. She is third on the team with 12 two-out RBIs and is only one behind Anissa Young and Ashley Langoni.
- Mouse's defense at third base has been just as impressive and her 94 assists are tied for fourth in the SEC.

- Cody Trahan, Brittany Mack and Rachele Fico continue to anchor the staff that has already tossed 14 shutouts en route to the SEC's lowest and nation's third-best ERA at a 1.32 ratio.
- The trio also ranks individually among the SEC's Top 3 in ERA. Fico and Trahan also are third and fifth in opponent batting average.
- The staff has limited opponents to under three runs in 39 of the team's 52 games as the Tigers have played 32 games versus 13 2009 NCAA Tournament squads.
- Trahan returned to the circle with a vengeance after missing opening weekend. She started her senior campaign with eight consecutive wins before coming off a pair of tough-luck losses to No. 6 Florida [April 3] and No. 6 Alabama [April 7].
- Trahan sports an 12-3 mark to go along with a 1.12 ERA and has yielded only 19 runs during 106.0 innings of work. She also has compiled an impressive 104 strikeouts against 15 walks.
- Trahan has bounced back to produce wins during four of her last decisions [April 10-30, including a masterful complete game to open the Georgia series [April 29] where she limited the high-octane Bulldogs to one run on five singles.
- Trahan also tallied a pair of victories over Arkansas [April 17-18], including a Senior Day triumph to cap the sweep. She also sprayed five hits in a shutout at South Carolina [March 13] where she had to borrow cleats and a glove from her teammates.
- Trahan has garnered SEC Pitcher of the Week [March 22] and also notched LSWA Pitcher of the Week honors [March 10].
- Mack is 9-3 with a 1.59 ERA and has won eight of her last nine decisions. She has posted league wins over South Carolina [March 13], Auburn [March 20], Mississippi State [April 11] and Kentucky [April 25] highlighted by a one-hit gem versus the Gamecocks.
- Mack fired five innings of shutout ball against the Wildcats [April 25] before allowing a solo homer, three infield hits and a pair of walks during the sixth inning before giving way to Fico.
- Mack recently came away with a ESPN The Magazine All-District 6 Second-Team selection from CoSIDA [May 6].

- Mack's three setbacks came at Texas [Feb. 13], against No. 4 Michigan [Feb. 20] and McNeese State [April 21] when she only received one run of support.
- Mack struck out a season-best eight batters and allowed only one earned run versus the Longhorns and Wolverines.
- Fico has turned in a 17-4 record with a SEC-leading 1.09 ERA and secured a program single-season mark with five saves.
- Fico notched back-to-back SEC Pitcher of the Week awards [April 19 & 26] and joined three-time All-American Britni Sneed [March 11 & 18, 2002] as the last player to accomplish that feat. She is the first freshman in program history to win the SEC weekly award.
- Fico has surrendered only two earned runs in her last 40.0 innings of work after her setback at Alabama [April 7]. She has secured six wins and two saves during the stretch.
- Fico shouldered the load at Kentucky [April 24-25]. She notched wins in games one and three of the series without Trahan and limited the Wildcats to one run one four hits during the series finale.
- Fico fired 7.2 frames of five-hit relief with nine strikeouts and sat down the final 12 batters she faced in the middle game of the Arkansas series [April 17]. She also added 4.2 innings of two-hit relief with six strikeouts during game two of the Georgia series [April 30].
- Fico tallied SEC Freshman of the Week [March 22] and also earned LSWA Pitcher of the Week [March 3 & 23, April 2].
- Minus the Florida and Alabama stretch where she was touched up 10 runs, Fico has held her opponents to .163 hitting clip since opening weekend. She has allowed only 11 runs, seven earned, on 54 hits and punched out 96 batters over 97.0 innings of work.
- Earlier this season, Fico put together a stretch of 26.0 straight scoreless frames [March 6-April 3] along with 10 straight wins from LSU's home opener to the Florida series [Feb. 17-April 3].
- Kirsten Shortridge has gone 3-1 over her seven appearances and tossed her first seven-inning complete game of her LSU career during a 4-1 win over No. 21 DePaul [Feb. 13]. She compiled six strikeouts and surrendered only three hits against the Blue Demons.
- Shortridge has yielded only one earned run in four of her six starts and also earned a win over Oklahoma State [Feb. 20]. She has tossed 7.1 frames since the Houston game [Feb. 28].

OFF THE BENCH

- Lauren Capello has reached base in nine of her 27 career at-bats as a pinch hitter with four hits, four walks and one hit-by-pitch.
- Katie Guillory is 0-for-3 after going 3-for-12 at the plate in 2009. She has scored six times as a pinch runner, including three of her last five outings [April 18-30]
- Tiffany Shaw has scored in 18 of her 30 running appearances, including 14 of her last 24 outings dating back to Feb. 28.
- Shaw is 3-for-10 at the plate with a RBI and 17-for-19 in the stolen base department to rank tied for 11th in the SEC. She has recorded a steal in six of her last 10 appearances [April 10-30].
- Jackie Victoriano has crossed the plate in six of her 17 pinch running appearances, while Lindsay Price has scored during seven of her 15 pinch running attempts.
- Heidi Pizer has made 17 appearances and two starts. She was 0-for-7 at the plate before cranking a pair of home runs with three RBIs at Nicholls [April 14].

IT'S NOT SO BAD BEING TRENDY

- LSU won 13 of 22 games decided by one run and 11 of the Tigers SEC tilts were decided in this fashion during the 2009 season. The Tigers have won seven of their last 10 one-run decisions this season after going 0-3 during opening weekend.
- Taking a page from the football program, LSU is 10-3 in night contests against a 31-8 tally in day games. Night contests are when first pitch is after 6 p.m. local time.
- LSU has gone 37-1 when scoring three or more runs with its only setback coming in game two at Alabama [April 7] and has tallied a 31-5 record when scoring first.
- LSU has recorded a 25-2 mark when hitting a home run, while going 16-9 when not hitting a long ball. The Tiger sophomore class has belted 24 of the 33 long balls.

- In 13 of LSU's 34 wins during the 2009 season, LSU entered the fifth inning either trailing or tied.
- The Tigers picked up comeback wins over NCAA Tournament squads No. 5 Texas A&M [Feb. 14 & 15], Baylor [March 11], No. 2 Alabama [March 18], Mississippi State [March 21 & 22], Auburn [May 3] and Cal State Fullerton [May 15].
- LSU has continued that trend and already has picked up eight comeback victories this season.
- Ashley Langoni laced a two-run home run coupled with a two-run Jessica Mouse double as LSU turned a 3-2 deficit into a 6-3 lead in the fifth inning against No. 19 North Carolina [Feb. 13].
- Behind 3-0 to Oklahoma State [Feb. 19], LSU exploded for six runs in the fourth inning. Once again, Langoni and Mouse fueled the frame with a two-run homer and double, respectively.
- Down 4-3 to Houston [Feb. 28], Ashley Applegate provided the game-tying single in the sixth inning before Langoni cranked a walk-off blast three frames later to claim a 5-4 triumph.
- Trailing 1-0 to Campbell [March 6], LSU made the most of two Camel errors to tie the score during the fifth inning to set up Courtney Hollier walk-off long ball to leadoff the eighth inning.
- Tied 1-1 in the fifth inning of game two against Ole Miss [March 17], Kirsten Shortridge manufactured a run and forced the Rebels into a fielding error for the winning run.
- With Mississippi State holding a 1-0 edge in the fifth inning [April 10], Langoni provided the equalizer with a two-out RBI-single. Two frames later, Morgan Russell knocked the game-winning single to hand LSU a 2-1 walk-off victory.
- Down 2-0 against Arkansas [April 17], LSU garnered runs in the fourth and fifth innings before Langoni cranked a walkoff double in the 10th inning for the 3-2 triumph.
- Trailing 3-1 in the middle game of the Georgia series [April 30], LSU reeled off four runs jump started by a Hollier solo home run. Rachel Mitchell provided the equalizer with a sacrifice fly and Shortridge gave the Tigers the lead with a heart-stopping steal of home plate. The Tigers capped the frame via a Juliana Santos bases loaded walk.

BATON ROUGE - The No. 18 LSU softball fell 2-1 and 7-4 to No. 13 Tennessee Saturday at the new Tiger Park. It's the first time since the 2006 season against Georgia that the Tigers have lost the first two games of a SEC doubleheader at home.

"I don't want to take anything away from Tennessee because they played very well today," head coach Yvette Girouard said. "At the same time, this is worst that we've played all season."

LSU (22-9, 8-5 SEC) and Tennessee (29-8, 6-5 SEC) conclude its weekend series Sunday with the program's inaugural "Swing for the Cure" game benefiting the Baton Rouge Affiliate of the Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

"Nothing was smooth for us today," Girouard said. "Everything needs to be much better and much sharper tomorrow," Girouard said. "We just have a bad day and really didn't perform to our expectations."

Game 1 – Tennessee 2, LSU 1

With the score tied at 0-0 heading into the seventh inning, the Lady Vols struck for a pair of runs with two outs.

Nicole Kajitani reached on an infield single and stole second. She came around to score on an RBI-single by Lillian Hammond, who advanced to third base after the throw to the plate got away. Kelly Grieve platted Hammond on a RBI-single through the left side to make it 2-0.

LSU rallied in the home half of the frame behind a leadoff single by Kirsten Shortridge, who alertly advanced to third base on shortstop's Ashley Andrews throwing error.

The Tigers pulled back to 2-1 as Juliana Santos reached on a dropped fly ball by Grieve in centerfield with two outs. After a passed ball moved Santos to third, an international walk to Rachel Mitchell put runners on the corners. Ashley Langoni popped out to Andrews for the final out.

Cody Trahan dropped to 6-3 allowing only one earned run on six hits. She tallied four strikeouts against three walks, while Cat Hosfield improved to 20-7 for the Lady Vols.

Game 2 – Tennessee 7, LSU 4

Juliana Santos and Ashley Applegate provided a pair of RBIs, but Tennessee made the most of four Tiger errors to come away with a 7-4 win.

Down 2-0, Santos ignited the Tigers by driving home Kirsten Shortridge on RBI-single, who cranked a one-out double to left centerfield in the third inning.

Applegate capped a three-run frame with a two-out, two-run single to right center field. The two RBIs pushed Applegate's season total to 10 allowing her to surpass her total from the 2008 season.

Tennessee responded by scoring twice in the fourth inning and adding single runs over the next three innings to grab a 7-3 advantage.

Tiffany Huff picked up a RBI-single in the fourth inning and added a bases loaded walk during the seventh inning. Erinn Webb knocked a RBI-triple in the sixth inning.

Santos platted Shortridge on a fielder's choice in the seventh inning for the final margin of 7-4.

Cat Hosfield held LSU to two hits and an unearned run over three innings to pick up the save for the Lady Vols.

"Hosfield controlled us very well both games," Girouard said. "She was highly recruited and her performance showed it."
