LSU Begins SEC Competition at Auburn

The 25th-ranked LSU gymnastics team will open up Southeastern Conference competition at Auburn Friday. The meet will begin at 7 p.m. CT in the brand new Auburn Arena, and a live broadcast of the meet can be found in the Geaux Zone at www.LSUports.net/live with Mike Smith and commentary provided by Paige Cipolloni and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney.

- Both teams will look to improve from their respective season openers as LSU scored a 193.350 and Auburn posted a 192.775 on the road.
- D-D Breaux is the longest-tenured head coach in the SEC at 34 seasons, and Auburn's Jeff Graba is in his first season as a head coach.
- At least two freshmen, and as many as four, competed in each lineup at Oregon State.
- Sarie Morrison became the first freshman at LSU to open the season in the all-around since April Burkholder in 2003.
- Morrison and senior All-American Samantha Engle tallied LSU's highest scores last week as Morrison earned a 9.825 on bars while Engle posted a 9.825 on floor.

STORYLINES

- LSU has dominated the series with a 62-11 all time record against Auburn, 10-4 at Auburn and 2-0 last season: beating Auburn 195.650-193.900 in Baton Rouge and 195.750-195.575 at the SEC Championship.
- LSU is looking to avenge the last time the Tigers were at Auburn when LSU lost 196.575-195.300 on Jan. 30, 2009.
- Both LSU and Auburn are trying to rebound after falling in the rankings because of the season-opening scores.
- LSU will rely on its young lineup for big scores in a hostile environment at Auburn as LSU's top score this season is a 9.825.
- In the last two seasons LSU has scored lower in the second meet than the opener, so the Tigers will try to buck that trend at Auburn.
- LSU ranks 25th in the national standings, and the Tigers are 15th on vault and 21st on floor. Auburn is ranked ninth on beam and 24th on bars.
- LSU will be without the services of Gloria Johnson for this meet because of an ankle injury she suffered early in the fall.
- LSU will continue its attempt to replace the 2010 senior class that finished with two Super Sixes, four NCAA Championships Appearances, 17 All-America honors and three NCAA individual national titles.
- No LSU gymnast won an event title at Oregon State. That's the first time in a dual meet that no Tiger has won an event title since Feb. 23, 2003 at the Masters Classic at Nebraska.

D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 34TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to shine as one of the nation's best programs, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accomplishments that includes nine-straight NCAA Championships appearances, two Super Sixes in the last three seasons and seven individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2010, LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight year and 22nd time in Breaux's career. Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture NCAA All-Around national title as she became LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 and 2009 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship in 2008. The Tigers finished fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish in program history since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title and one day later Breaux coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more

than 30 years. Her dedication to the student-athlete on an individual basis has transcended into academic success, community involvement, Coach of the Year honors, SEC Championships, NCAA Regional Championships and top-10 national rankings throughout her tenure.

Now entering her 34th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have finished among the nation's top-10 teams 22 times in 33 seasons, placing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 25 separate occasions, winning regional titles nine times in three different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009. Her teams have included seven individual national titles, 98 All-America honors and 47 All-SEC selections.

Additionally, Breaux's Tigers won the inaugural SEC Championship title in 1981 and have gone on to finish second four times and third five other times.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

NOTEBOOK

Last Time Out

- LSU fell 195.400-193.350 to eighth-ranked Oregon State in Corvallis, Ore. in the season opener. Freshman Sarie Morrison competed in the all-around and scored a 38.425.
- Morrison and Samantha Engle led the team by each scoring a 9.825 - Morrison on bars, Engle on floor. Freshman Maliah Mathis and junior Ashley Lee posted a 9.80 on vault.
- The Tigers competed with at least two freshmen in each lineup against Oregon State: four on vault, three on bars, two on beam, four on floor.

Morrison Opens Season in All-Around

- Freshman Sarie Morrison opened the season at Oregon State by competing in the all-around, becoming the first LSU gymnast since April Burkholder in 2003 to begin her career as an all-arounder in her first meet.

Fighting Through Injuries

- LSU will probably be without Sidney Sanabria-Robles for the second-straight meet Friday. However, the coaching staff has decided to redshirt junior Gloria Johnson after she suffered a foot injury in the fall. Coach Breaux was hopeful to have Johnson back at some point this season, but surgery became the best option.
- The Tigers might also be without senior Samantha Engle against Auburn as she injured her ankle during Wednesday's practice. The staff is taking it as a day-to-day approach.

Seeking Improvement

- LSU is looking to rebound from the 193.350 team score at Oregon State, and the Tigers will rely on the freshmen gaining experience and confidence as the season moves forward. The Tigers' highest score of the meet was a 9.825, and the highest event total was a 48.775 on vault.

No Event Titles at Oregon State

- For the first time since Feb. 23, 2003 no LSU gymnast won an event title in a dual meet as the Tigers were shut out at Oregon State. Back in 2003 at Nebraska's Masters Classic, no Tiger finished higher than fifth as LSU competed without freshman sensation April Burkholder and Nebraska exploded for a 198.025. LSU will try to begin a new streak against Auburn.

LSU in the Rankings

- LSU is ranked 25th in the latest GymInfo rankings, and the Tigers are 15h on vault with a 48.775 and 21st on floor with a 48.575 score.
- In the individual rankings, freshman Sarie Morrison ranks 23rd on bars with a 9.825.
- Six of seven SEC teams are ranked - Florida (No. 1), Georgia (No. 6), Alabama (No. 9), Arkansas (10th), Kentucky (16th), LSU (25th). Auburn is the only unranked team.

Opening on the Road

- LSU opened the 2011 season at Oregon State, marking the fourth time in the last five years the Tigers have opened the season away from Baton Rouge. The Tigers finished fourth, out of six, at the 2007 Super Six Challenge in Fayetteville, Ark. LSU won back-to-back titles at the Cancun Classic in 2008 and 2009, and they opened last season at home against Maryland.
- The last time LSU opened a season in a dual meet was Jan. 12, 2001 when the Tigers defeated Kentucky 194.000-193.000 in Lexington, Ky.

Freshmen Galore

- LSU enters the 2011 season with eight freshmen on the roster, including two redshirt freshmen in Kaleigh Dickson and Lainie Fleming.
- It is the most since the 2001 team also entered the year with eight freshmen.

Lone Senior

- Samantha Engle is the only senior on the 2011 team. She entered LSU in a class of four, but injuries to Nikki Lyons and Staci Schwitkis ended their careers and Paige Cipolloni has shifted roles as a team manager.
- This is the first time the team has had only one senior since the 2008 team had Kristi Esposito.

Returning All-Americans

- LSU returns two All-Americans in 2011. Junior Ashley Lee picked up First-Team All-America honors on vault in 2010 while senior Samantha Engle earned second-team honors last year.
- The Tigers lost four All-Americans from 2010 as all four seniors earned All-America recognition during their careers.

Tough Slate in 2011

- LSU will face five teams ranked in the preseason top 10 this season and nine teams in the top 25.
- The Tigers have home meets against No. 3 Florida, No. 7 Georgia and No. 11 Arkansas. LSU will face No. 2 Alabama twice -- in Tuscaloosa and Dallas, No. 8 Oregon State on the road, No. 10 Nebraska in Dallas, No. 13 Missouri in Dallas, No. 15 Auburn on the road and No. 24 Kentucky on the road.
- LSU will face all six ranked SEC foes at the end of the season at the SEC Championship in Birmingham, Ala.

Where Have All the All-Arounders Gone?

- For the first time since the 2003 season opener, not a single gymnast on the roster has competed in the all-around entering the 2011 season.
- Samantha Engle is LSU's most experienced gymnast, but she has never competed on vault as a Tiger. Likewise, Ericka Garcia and Shelby Prunty have never competed on floor. Gloria Johnson has never seen action on bars, Ashley Lee has never competed on bars or beam and Janelle Garcia has not seen action on vault or beam.

Ashleigh Clare-Kearney Returns as a Coach

- Two-time national champion and former LSU gymnast Ashleigh Clare-Kearney has returned to the gymnastics program as a volunteer coach.
- Clare-Kearney is also in law school after earning bachelor's and master's degrees at LSU.
- She developed the choreography for all floor routines in the fall and she assisted coach Breaux in coaching floor in practice.
- As a senior in 2009 she won the NCAA Vault and Floor titles, becoming LSU's first two-time national champion.

A Look Back at the 2010 Season

- LSU made the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight season and finished ninth overall.
- Susan Jackson won two national titles - the all-around title and beam titles. It marked the first time in school history that a gymnast won the all-around and the third time they won the beam.
- Summer Hubbard finished second on bars in the NCAA Individual Event Finals, the first Tiger to take the runner-up spot on bars, and Jackson claimed the runner-up spot on vault for the second-straight year after winning the title in 2008.
- LSU earned seven All-America honors among four gymnasts: Jackson with four (VT, UB, BB, AA), Hubbard with one (UB), Ashley Lee with one (VT) and Samantha Engle with one (UB).
- Jackson and D-D Breaux earned NCAA Central Region Gymnast and Coach of the Year honors - the first of Jackson's career and the fifth of Breaux's career.
- Jackson earned SEC Gymnast of the Year, the first of her career and the fourth time an LSU gymnast won the honor.
- Two gymnasts received All-SEC recognition: Jackson as a first teamer and Gloria Johnson as a second teamer. Jackson also won the SEC vault title for the second time in her career.
- As a team LSU went a perfect 6-0 at home in 2010, and the Tigers have won 10-straight home meets. The last home loss came against Georgia on Jan. 16, 2009.
- Six gymnasts (Engle, Jackson, Sabrina Franceschelli, Kaleigh Dickson, Janelle Garcia and Shelby Prunty) received SEC Academic Honor Roll recognition, and four Tigers received Scholastic All-America honors (J. Garcia, Dickson, Franceschelli and Lainie Fleming).

The 2010 Senior Class - Best Ever?

- Throughout the years LSU has had some senior classes that have had racked up honors and titles, but it is hard to argue with the success of the 2010 senior class comprised of Susan Jackson, Summer Hubbard, Sabrina Franceschelli and Kayla Rogers.
- First and foremost, all four earned undergraduate degrees at LSU. The foursome has also produced: three NCAA individual titles, two NCAA Super Six appearances (the only two in school history), four-straight NCAA Championships appearances, two NCAA Regional titles, 17 All-America honors and two Scholastic All-America honors among other achievements.

Recent Success

- LSU has had arguably the most successful run in its gymnastics program since 2005. The Tigers have made two Super Sixes, won six NCAA Individual titles, captured three NCAA Regional titles, tallied 49 All-America honors, 12 All-SEC honors, three SEC Gymnasts of the Year and seven SEC Event title.

No Printed Media Guide in 2011

- There will be no printed media guide this season. Instead, LSU has decided to create an online media guide only. The guide will contain facts and information about the team as well as videos and green screen shots of the coaches and gymnasts. A link will be included in the notes once the guide is finished.

Susan Jackson's Legacy

- For the first time since 2006 the LSU gymnastics team will not have LSU's most decorated gymnast on its roster. Susan Jackson graduated in 2010 but not before she racked up major awards and titles for the first time in school history.
- Here is a list of Jackson's firsts for LSU gymnastics: Honda Award, AAI Award, All-Around National Champion, three NCAA Individual titles, Roy F. Kramer SEC Female Athlete of the Year, 11 all-around titles in a single season, six straight all-around titles to open a season, ranked No. 1 nationally in the all-around for eight-straight weeks.
