## SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU wraps up a seven-game homestand to start the 2011 campaign Wednesday against Southeastern Louisiana. First pitch is set for 6 p.m. at Tiger Park.
- ▶ LSU has won its last six meetings against Southeastern Louisiana, including a pair of 11-0 victories last season.
- ▶ In Baton Rouge on Feb. 24, Anissa Young cranked a pair of home runs en route to a career-best five RBIs. LSU's pitching trio of Cody Trahan, Brittany Mack and Rachele Fico were touched up for only three hits and combined for eight strikeouts.
- ▶ In Hammond on March 24, Young was joined by Rachel Mitchell and Ashley Applegate with three RBIs apiece. The Tigers pounded out a season-best 15 hits, while Mack went the distance in the circle for her seventh win of the season.
- ▶ LSU has spent 79 consecutive weeks in both the *USA Today/NFCA* and *ESPN/USA Softball* Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 18 and No. 16 in this week's polls.
