LSU Searching for First SEC Win of the Season at Kentucky

LSU is coming off its season high with its first 196 score of the season against Georgia, but the Gym Dogs defeated the Tigers 196.500-196.350 in the Fourth Annual Etta James Memorial Meet. LSU heads into Lexington, Ky., in search of its first Southeastern Conference victory of the season, and the Tigers will compete for back-to-back 196 scores.

- The meet will begin at 6 p.m. CT, and fans can listen to live audio on www.LSUports.net. Live score updates will be available on [Facebook.com/lugym](https://www.facebook.com/lugym) and [Twitter.com/lugym](https://twitter.com/lugym). The meet will be televised on a tape delay basis by FSN and will premiere March 5 at 8 p.m.
- LSU tied season bests on bars (49.000) and beam (49.025) and set a new season high on floor with a 49.275, the highest event score this season for the Tigers. The meet against the Gym Dogs also marked the first time this season LSU hit 49.0 or higher on all four events.
- Kentucky is coming off its season high in a 195.825-195.050 loss at No. 14 Ohio State on Feb. 20. However, the Wildcats posted a school-record 49.400 on vault. Kentucky and LSU are tied in the vault rankings with a 48.975 regional qualifying score.
- The Wildcats rank eighth on floor with a 48.950 RQS and 19th on bars at 48.710. Individually, junior Whitney Rose ranks 11th on vault with a 9.865 RQS and a season-high 9.90. Senior Andrea Mitchell ranks 24th in the all-around with a 38.940 RQS average.

STORYLINES

- LSU scored its first 196 of the season against Georgia, and now the Tigers will look for their first 196 on the road at Kentucky.
- Historically, LSU has dominated Kentucky with a 63-4 record against the Wildcats with a 13-2 record in Lexington. The last time LSU competed in Lexington the Tigers won 196.575-195.225 on Jan. 23, 2009.
- Freshman Sarie Morrison has won three straight all-around titles, including last week's career-high 39.575 that ranks as the fourth-highest all-around mark nationally this season.
- Freshmen continue to pace LSU this season with Morrison, Maliah Mathis and Kaleigh Dickson. Mathis became the seventh gymnast in school history to post a 9.975 on floor when she did it against Georgia, and Dickson continues to team up with Morrison in the all-around.
- LSU's lone senior, Samantha Engle, finally shook off the effects of her injured ankle to post season highs on bars and beam with a 9.825 and 9.90, respectively, against Georgia. Her 9.9 on beam is the first for any LSU gymnast this season, and it earned her the beam title.
- LSU is No. 20 in the rankings heading into the meet, which marks the 146th consecutive poll and 521st straight week that LSU has earned a top 25 ranking. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was almost 10 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.

D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 34TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to shine as one of the nation's best programs, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accomplishments that includes nine-straight NCAA Championships appearances, two Super Sixes in the last three seasons and seven individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2010, LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight year and 22nd time in Breaux's career. Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture NCAA All-Around national title as she became LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 and 2009 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship in 2008. The Tigers finished fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish in program history since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title and one day later Breaux coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more

than 30 years. Her dedication to the student-athlete on an individual basis has transcended into academic success, community involvement, Coach of the Year honors, SEC Championships, NCAA Regional Championships and top-10 national rankings throughout her tenure.

Now entering her 34th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have finished among the nation's top-10 teams 22 times in 33 seasons, placing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 25 separate occasions, winning regional titles nine times in three different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009. Her teams have included seven individual national titles, 98 All-America honors and 47 All-SEC selections.

Additionally, Breaux's Tigers won the inaugural SEC Championship title in 1981 and have gone on to finish second four times and third five other times.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

Last Time Out

- LSU posted a season-high 196.350 against Georgia with season bests on bars (49.000), beam (49.025) and floor (49.275).
- Sarie Morrison won her third straight all-around title with a career-high 39.575, while Maliah Mathis posted a 9.975 on floor to become the seventh gymnast in school history to accomplish that feat. Her score is tied for the best in the nation with Florida's Marissa King. Kaleigh Dickson tied her career-high all-around total with a 39.125.
- LSU won every individual title against Georgia: Morrison won the vault, all-around and tied for the bars crown. Mathis won floor, and Samantha Engle captured the beam title.

Morrison Earns SEC Freshman of the Week Honors After Her Performance Against Georgia

- Sarie Morrison was named SEC Freshman of the Week on Feb. 22 after she captured her third straight all-around title against Georgia with a 39.575.
- The honor is the first of Morrison's career. Morrison's score is the fourth-highest all-around total in the nation. Morrison set career highs on vault with a 9.925, beam with a 9.875 and floor with a 9.90 against the Gym Dogs, and she collected event titles on vault and bars as well as the all-around.

Morrison Posts Best All-Around Mark by an LSU Freshman Since 2003

- Sarie Morrison captured her third straight all-around title against Georgia with a 39.575. Her score is the highest all-around score by an LSU freshman since April Burkholder's school-record 39.875 on March 21, 2003. National Champions Susan Jackson and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney never earned a 39.575 all-around score as a freshman.
- Morrison's score is also tied for the fourth-highest score in the nation and is tied for the third-highest all-around total for a freshman. Mathis Scores Nation-Leading 9.975 on Floor Against Georgia

- Maliah Mathis brought the fans to their feet when she scored a near-flawless 9.975 on floor as the last performance of the meet against Georgia on Feb. 18.
- With her outstanding performance she tied Florida's Marissa King for the highest floor score in the nation.
- Mathis became only the seventh gymnast in school history to score a 9.975 on floor and the first since Ashleigh Clare-Kearney and Susan Jackson both did it in 2009.

Fourth Annual Etta James Memorial Meet A Huge Success

- For the fourth straight year the LSU gymnastics team and the local community worked together to raise money for former LSU football player and current Dallas Cowboys linebacker Bradie James' Foundation 56 to fight breast cancer in the Baton Rouge area.
- James lost his mother to breast cancer when he was a sophomore at LSU in 2001, and he created Foundation 56 in 2007 to raise awareness and promote screenings and research to fight the disease.
- James and LSU hosted the Tailgate for the Fight event on Feb. 16 that included a silent and live auction to raise money for Foundation 56, and donations were also accepted at the Fourth Annual Etta James Memorial Meet on Feb. 18.
- With the outstanding turnout at both events, the gymnastics program and the community raised nearly \$50,000 for Foundation 56 this year and more than \$160,000 in four years to fight breast cancer in Baton Rouge.

Continuing to Improve

- LSU posted a 193.350 in the season-opener at Oregon State, and one week later, without the services of senior Sam Engle, the Tigers scored a 194.475.
- LSU beat its season high by more than one full point with a 195.550 at the Metroplex Challenge, and the Tigers set a new season high with a 195.875 against BYU.
- For the first time all season LSU cracked the 196 mark with a score exactly three points higher than the opener as the Tigers posted a 196.350 versus Georgia on Feb. 18. LSU will try to carry that momentum on the road against Kentucky.

Freshmen Leading the Way

- LSU has two gymnasts in the all-around, and both Tigers are freshmen - Kaleigh Dickson and Sarie Morrison. Dickson has competed in the all-around in six of seven meets, and Morrison has been an all-arounder the entire season.
- Both have hit 39-plus all-around totals, and Morrison has picked up three straight all-around titles to pace the Tigers.
- Maliah Mathis has continued to improve meet by meet, and her 9.975 on floor against Georgia is tied for the national lead in the event and is tied as the best score by a freshman in the nation this season.

LSU in the Rankings

- LSU is ranked 20th in the latest GymInfo rankings with a 194.825 regional qualifying score, and the Tigers are 11th on vault with a 48.975 RQS, 10th on beam with a 48.655 average and 25th on floor with a 48.700 average.
- Freshman Sarie Morrison ranks 20th nationally in the all-around with a RQS of 38.960. Morrison also ranked 22nd on bars with a 9.835 RQS.
- Maliah Mathis moved into the floor rankings at No. 24 with a 9.830 RQS.
- LSU has been ranked in the top 25 in 146 consecutive polls and 521 straight weeks. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was almost 10 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.

Fighting Through Injuries

- LSU will be without Sidney Sanabria-Robles for the eighth-straight meet Friday, and she might have to redshirt.
- The coaching staff has redshirted junior Gloria Johnson after she suffered a foot injury in the fall. Coach Breaux was hopeful to have Johnson back at some point this season, but surgery became the best option.
- All-American senior Samantha Engle might be limited for the seventh-straight meet because of her sprained ankle. Engle injured her ankle during practice prior to the meet against Auburn in the second week of the season, but she has begun competing on beam since the meet against Arkansas. However, she has not competed on floor since the season opener at Oregon State, and last week she rolled her right ankle in warmups against Georgia.
- Freshman Sarah Zoldos might be limited for the fifth-straight meet because of a sprained ankle. She has competed on bars all season, and she competed on vault against Arkansas and Georgia after being held out for two weeks.
- Freshman bars specialist Mckenzie Fox is out for the season after having surgery prior to the Metroplex Challenge. She had competed twice this season on bars.

Career Highs Continue against Arkansas

- Sarie Morrison earned career highs on vault (9.90) and floor (9.850) while Maliah Mathis posted a career-best 9.85 on beam to win the title.
- Junior Ashley Lee tied her career high with a 9.9 on vault, marking the third time in her career she has posted a 9.9.
- Kaleigh Dickson earned a 9.85 on floor to set a new best, and freshman Sarah Zoldos scored a 9.775 on bars.

Tigers Sweep Individual Titles Against BYU

- For the first time since March 19, 2010 at Centenary, LSU won at least a share of every individual title in a meet. Ashley Lee and Maliah Mathis shared the vault title with BYU's Mickell Merrell at 9.80. Sarie Morrison won her third bars title of the year. Ericka Garcia won her first career individual title on beam, and Mathis picked up her second-straight floor title after winning the event with a 9.875 at the Metroplex Challenge. Morrison also won the all-around crown with a 39.150, her first career all-around victory.

Vault Titles are a First for Two Freshmen

- Three Tigers tied for the vault title at Auburn. Junior Ashley Lee and freshmen Maliah Mathis and Sarie Morrison all scored a 9.825 to share the title. It marks Lee's third career vault title and the first for Mathis and Morrison.
- Morrison also won the bars title at Auburn, the first event title of her career. LSU competed on bars first, so the vault title marked the second of her short career.

Morrison Opens Season in All-Around

- Freshman Sarie Morrison opened the season at Oregon State by competing in the all-around, becoming the first LSU gymnast since April Burkholder in 2003 to begin her career as an all-arounder in her first meet.

No Event Titles at Oregon State

- For the first time since Feb. 23, 2003 no LSU gymnast won an event title in a dual meet as the Tigers were shut out at Oregon State. Back in 2003 at Nebraska's Masters Classic, no Tiger finished higher than fifth as LSU competed without freshman sensation April Burkholder and Nebraska exploded for a 198.025. LSU will try to begin a new streak against Auburn.

Opening on the Road

- LSU opened the 2011 season at Oregon State, marking the fourth time in the last five years the Tigers have opened the season away from Baton Rouge. The Tigers finished fourth, out of six, at the 2007 Super Six Challenge in Fayetteville, Ark. LSU won back-to-back titles at the Cancun Classic in 2008 and 2009, and they opened last season at home against Maryland.
- The last time LSU opened a season in a dual meet was Jan. 12, 2001 when the Tigers defeated Kentucky 194.000-193.000 in Lexington, Ky.

Freshmen Galore

- LSU enters the 2011 season with eight freshmen on the roster, including two redshirt freshmen in Kaleigh Dickson and Lainie Fleming.
- It is the most since the 2001 team also entered the year with eight freshmen.

Lone Senior

- Samantha Engle is the only senior on the 2011 team. She entered LSU in a class of four, but injuries to Nikki Lyons and Staci Schwitkis ended their careers and Paige Cipolloni has shifted roles as a team manager.
- This is the first time the team has had only one senior since the 2008 team had Kristi Esposito.

Returning All-Americans

- LSU returns two All-Americans in 2011. Junior Ashley Lee picked up First-Team All-America honors on vault in 2010 while senior Samantha Engle earned second-team honors last year.
- The Tigers lost four All-Americans from 2010 as all four seniors earned All-America recognition during their careers.

Tough Slate in 2011

- LSU will face five teams ranked in the preseason top 10 this season and nine teams in the top 25.
- The Tigers have home meets against No. 3 Florida, No. 7 Georgia and No. 11 Arkansas. LSU will face No. 2 Alabama twice -- in Tuscaloosa and Dallas, No. 8 Oregon State on the road, No. 10 Nebraska in Dallas, No. 13 Missouri in Dallas, No. 15 Auburn on the road and No. 24 Kentucky on the road.
- LSU will face all six ranked SEC foes at the end of the season at the SEC Championship in Birmingham, Ala.

Where Have All the All-Arounders Gone?

- For the first time since the 2003 season opener, not a single gymnast on the roster has competed in the all-around entering the 2011 season.
- Samantha Engle is LSU's most experienced gymnast, but she has never competed on vault as a Tiger. Likewise, Ericka Garcia and Shelby Prunty have never competed on floor. Gloria Johnson has never seen action on bars, Ashley Lee has never competed on bars or beam and Janelle Garcia has not seen action on vault or beam.

A Look Back at the 2010 Season

- LSU made the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight season and finished ninth overall.
- Susan Jackson won two national titles - the all-around title and beam titles. It marked the first time in school history that a gymnast won the all-around and the third time they won the beam.
- Summer Hubbard finished second on bars in the NCAA Individual Event Finals, the first Tiger to take the runner-up spot on bars, and Jackson claimed the runner-up spot on vault for the second-straight year after winning the title in 2008.
- LSU earned seven All-America honors among four gymnasts: Jackson with four (VT, UB, BB, AA), Hubbard with one (UB), Ashley Lee with one (VT) and Samantha Engle with one (UB).
- Jackson and D-D Breaux earned NCAA Central Region Gymnast and Coach of the Year honors - the first of Jackson's career and the fifth of Breaux's career.
- Jackson earned SEC Gymnast of the Year, the first of her career and the fourth time an LSU gymnast won the honor.
- Two gymnasts received All-SEC recognition: Jackson as a first teamer and Gloria Johnson as a second teamer. Jackson also won the SEC vault title for the second time in her career.
- As a team LSU went a perfect 6-0 at home in 2010, and the Tigers have won 10-straight home meets. The last home loss came against Georgia on Jan. 16, 2009.
- 6 gymnasts (Engle, Jackson, Sabrina Franceschelli, Kaleigh Dickson, Janelle Garcia and Shelby Prunty) received SEC Academic Honor Roll recognition, and 4 Tigers received Scholastic All-America honors (J. Garcia, Dickson, Franceschelli and Lainie Fleming).

The 2010 Senior Class - Best in School History?

- Throughout the years LSU has had senior classes that have had racked up honors and titles, but it is hard to argue with the success of the 2010 senior class of Susan Jackson, Summer Hubbard, Sabrina Franceschelli and Kayla Rogers.
- All four earned undergraduate degrees at LSU. The foursome has also produced: three NCAA individual titles, two NCAA Super Six appearances (the only two in school history), four-straight NCAA Championships appearances, two NCAA Regional titles, 17 All-America honors and two Scholastic All-America honors among other achievements.

Recent Success

- LSU has had arguably the most successful run in its gymnastics program since 2005. The Tigers have made two Super Sixes, won six NCAA Individual titles, captured three NCAA Regional titles, tallied 49 All-America honors, 12 All-SEC honors, three SEC Gymnasts of the Year and seven SEC Event title.

Susan Jackson's Legacy

- For the first time since 2006 the LSU gymnastics team will not have its most decorated gymnast on the roster. Susan Jackson graduated in 2010 but not before she racked up major awards and titles, including many firsts in school history.
- Here is a list of Jackson's firsts for LSU gymnastics: Honda Award, AAI Award, All-Around National Champion, three NCAA Individual titles, Roy F. Kramer SEC Female Athlete of the Year, 11 all-around titles in a single season, six straight all-around titles to open a season, ranked No. 1 nationally in the all-around for eight-straight weeks.
- In addition to her list of firsts, Jackson also earned 12 All-America honors (second-most in school history), was named the 2010 Central Region Gymnast of the Year, 2010 SEC Gymnast of the Year, three-time SEC event champion, 2009 Central Regional All-Around champion, three-time First-Team All-SEC member ('08, '09, '10) and a two-time SEC Academic Honor Roll member ('09, '10).
