SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ The No. 20 LSU softball team returns to the road for the prestigious Cathedral City Classic held in Palm Springs, Calif.
- ▶ The Tigers have match-ups slated against Pac-10 powers No. 3 Arizona and No. 14 California along with Fordham and Cal Poly.
- ▶ It marks the first time that LSU and Arizona will meet on the diamond since the 2006 NCAA Super Regionals, a series the Wildcats won 2-1 en route to the national championship.
- ▶ LSU and Cal last met at the 2004 Women's College World Series. The Tigers were seven outs away from defeating the Golden Bears for the second time and advancing to the WCWS championship series. For her amazing efforts and nearly pitching LSU to three wins in one day, Kristin Schmidt was named the WCWS Most Outstanding Player
- ▶ LSU has spent 80 consecutive weeks in both the *USA Today/NFCA* and *ESPN/USA Softball* Top 25 polls. The Tigers check in at No. 20 in this week's polls.
