

LSU FOOTBALL POSTGAME NOTES

#1/2 LSU vs. Kentucky

Oct. 1, 2011 – Tiger Stadium (Baton Rouge, La.)

Team Notes

1. LSU's game captains were 38 **Brad Wing**, 94 **Ken Adams**, 60 **Will Blackwell**, 30 **Drew Alleman** and 12 **Jarrett Lee**.
2. Kentucky won the toss and deferred to the second half. LSU will receive the opening kickoff. It marked the first time the Tigers have received the opening kickoff this season. LSU kicked off in its four previous contests.
3. Tigers making their first career starts: 80 WR **Jarvis Landry**
4. Tigers seeing their first career action today: 14 RB **Terrence Magee**, 49 **Austin Kinchen**, 29 DB **Sam Gibson**
5. 74 **Josh Williford** started at RG and 60 **Will Blackwell** started at LG.
6. LSU has held its opponents scoreless in now 15 of 20 quarters this season.
7. LSU saw its streak of scoring on its first drive of games come to an end. The Tigers had converted first drives into scores in each of its previous four games.
8. Kentucky converted its first third-down conversion with six minutes left in the third quarter. The Wildcats were previously 0-of-8.
9. With **Jordan Jefferson** and **Terrence Magee's** 1-yard touchdown runs, five LSU players have accounted for rushing touchdowns this season.
10. As a result of **Tyrann Mathieu's** fumble return for a touchdown, LSU now has 57 points off 12 takeaways this season.
11. LSU has won 14 straight games when winning the turnover battle as the Tigers forced one Kentucky fumble today and did not turn the ball over. LSU is 30-4 when forcing more turnovers than they give up.
12. **Jordan Jefferson's** 1-yard TD run on fourth down with 7:06 in the first quarter marked LSU's first fourth down attempt and conversion on the season. LSU is now 1-for-1 on the year.
 - a. LSU is now 56-of-88 on fourth down attempts under **Les Miles**.
13. LSU improved to 15-3 all-time in games played as the No. 1 ranked team, including a 3-2 mark under **Les Miles**.
14. LSU improved to 19-13 in day games under **Les Miles**. The Tigers are 48-4 in night games.

Individual Notes

15. QB **Jarrett Lee** now owns a 10-4 record as a starter during his career.
 - a. **Lee** fired his seventh touchdown of the season and 25th of his career on a 51-yard throw to Odell Beckham, Jr. with 11:14 to go in the second quarter. Lee is three TD passes away from entering the LSU career top 10 in that category.
16. QB **Jordan Jefferson** scored his 10th career rushing touchdown when he took a quarterback sneak in from 1-yard out with 7:06 remaining in the first quarter. It was Jefferson's first play of the season since returning from suspension.
 - a. **Jefferson** moved into a tie for fifth place in LSU career rushing TDs with his 10th. He tied Steve Ensminger (1976-79 and current tight ends coach), who also has 10. Jefferson is the sixth QB in LSU history to record double-digit rushing touchdowns.
17. WR **Odell Beckham, Jr.** tallied his second receiving touchdown of the season turning a spectacular play in the open field into a 51-yard touchdown on a pass from Jarrett Lee with 11:14 left in the second quarter.
 - a. **Beckham, Jr.** has had touchdown receptions of 50-plus yards in two straight games. The last time an LSU player had a TD of 50 or more yards in two straight games was in 2005 when Bennie Brazell has a 55-yard TD catch against Ole Miss on Nov. 19 and a 50-yard TD reception versus Arkansas on Nov. 25.
 - b. **Beckham, Jr.** has accounted for LSU's two longest plays from scrimmage this season, including a 52-yard touchdown catch at West Virginia last weekend.
18. RB **Alfred Blue** scored on a 1-yard run with 8:07 left in the third quarter. It was Blue's third rushing touchdown of the season, which put him in a tie for second place on the team in that category.
19. CB **Tyrann Mathieu** recorded a sack, a forced fumble and then returned it 23 yards for his second touchdown of the season.
 - a. **Mathieu** then forced another fumble, the ninth of his career, early in the fourth quarter that was recovered by Kentucky's Tyler Robinson.
 - b. With his first forced fumble of the game, **Mathieu** now holds the LSU career record for forced fumbles all by himself. He has nine in just 18 career games played.
 - c. **Mathieu** has also recovered five of his nine career forced fumbles.
20. RB **Terrence Magee** tallied his first career touchdown on a 1-yard run with 10:39 left in the fourth quarter.
21. DE **Sam Montgomery** tied for the team and tied his career high with six tackles, and he set a new career high with 1.5 sacks for a loss of six yards.
