Stringer has moved to the wing guard position and has eight treys in first four games to give him 65 for career ... Started 34 consecutive games dating back to last year ... 8-of-21 from the arc.
- G 22 Ralston Turner (So., 6-6, Muscle Shoals, Ala.) 11.0 ppg, 3.0 rpg**
Turner started every game he dressed for a year ago, missing first five SEC games after injury suffered late in game at Virginia, Jan. 2 ... Leading scorer a year ago ... Coaches All-SEC Freshman team a year ago.
- F 24 Storm Warren (Sr., 6-7, Monroe, La.) 9.8 ppg, 6.3 rpg.**
Warren has started the season as he ended last year when he finally was healthy ... Seven consecutive double figure scoring games dating back to last season stopped when he scored six against NU ... Had 14 points on 6-of-9 shooting at Coastal (11/15) ... 16-of-25 for the season so far from the field.
- C 41 Justin Hamilton (Jr., 7-0, Alpine, Utah) 12.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg**
Transferred from Iowa State after his sophomore season ... First game action in the opener, with no turnovers in 24 minutes ... Back-to-back double figure games in tourney ... Had 18 points, 9 rebounds in 24 minutes against W. Ky, including 5-of-10 from the field, 8-8 from line ... 15-of-30 from field, 18-of-21 from line for the early year.

STORYLINES

- Justin Hamilton started off the Western Kentucky game in the strangest fashion, shooting four technical free throws in the first 19 seconds on an administrative pre-game tech and then a bench tech on WKY.

- Anthony Hickey and Justin Hamilton are both averaging 14.0 points in the two tournament games ... Hickey is 11-of-24 from the field with two treys, while Hamilton is 9-of-15 from the field and a perfect 10-of-10 from the line.

- After a year with no seniors, the present 12-man roster is spread evenly with three seniors (Bass, Warren, White), juniors (DelPiero, Hamilton, Ludwig), sophomores (Courtney, Stringer, Turner) and freshman (Hickey, Isaac, O'Bryant III).

- Tigers have averaged 7.0 treys in first four games, after averaging 5.0 a year ago ... The highlight early is at the line as LSU is 77-of-98 (78.6%), including 40-50 (80.0%) in the tournament ... LSU shot 44.9 percent from the field in the two tourney games, including 12-of-37 from the

arc. ISU has out rebounded its two tournament opponents, 85-62.

- After playing four games in South Carolina in six days, the Tigers go back to the Maravich Center for a 7 p.m. game Wednesday vs. South Alabama ... That will be LSU's only home game until Dec. 10 as the Tigers will travel to Houston on Nov. 29 and go to Rutgers Dec. 3 for the Big East/SEC Challenge.

- In 3 of the 4 games, LSU has had double digit offensive boards, including 19 vs. Western Kentucky.

In the consolation semifinal, LSU broke open a tight game with a 9-0 run at the start of the second half and followed that up shortly thereafter with a 16-0 run to put the Hilltoppers away to advance to the fifth place contest ... LSU would out score Western Kentucky, 36-19, after leading at the half, 40-38 ... Justin Hamilton led LSU with 18 points, nine rebounds, while Anthony Hickey had 17 points and four assists ...

The Series With Georgia Tech

This is the first time the Tigers and the former SEC member have met since the second round of the NCAA Tournament in Knoxville, Tenn., in 1990 when Georgia Tech scored a 94-91 win over LSU ... The Tigers had the advantage in two previous NCAA appearances, winning in 1987 in Chicago (85-79) and at the Omni in Atlanta in 1996 on the way to LSU's Final Four appearance as an 11th-seed (70-64).

The teams have met a total of 34 times with LSU having a 20-14 advantage. Most of those games came during the time Georgia Tech was a member of the league until 1964 ... The teams have met five times since then with LSU winning the first three

meetings and Georgia Tech winning the last two games.

The 3-1 Yellow Jackets loss to St. Joseph's in the first round of the tournament, 66-53, on Thursday before defeating VCU on Friday, 73-60 ... Ironically in the opening game, Tech had a 28-23 halftime lead only to have St. Joseph's outscore Tech, 43-25 ... Friday night, VCU had a 31-23 advantage at the half only to have Georgia Tech outscore the Rams, 50-29.

Five players were in double figures for the Yellow Jackets Friday led by Glen Rice off the bench, playing 33 minutes and scoring 19 points (7-11 FGs, 3 treys), while Brandon Reed scored 13 and Kammeon Holsey, Daniel Miller and Mfon Udofia each had 10 points.

Georgia Tech shot 50.8 percent from the field, including 61.3 percent (19-31) in the second half. Tech shot 29.4 percent for the game from the arc, but 4-of-8 in the second half. Tech had a 45-28 advantage on the glass.

Brian Gregory is in his first year as head coach after a successful career at Dayton.

Week in South Carolina Comes To A Close

The Tigers will close out a four-games in six-day trip to the state of South Carolina on Sunday, hoping to get out of the state with a 2-2 split after losing the first two games at Coastal Carolina Tuesday and Northwestern Thursday and coming back with a win over Western Kentucky on Friday.

The team is road tested early, going on this trip after one game at home to open the season. LSU will return to face South Alabama Wednesday at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center before going to Houston (Nov. 29) and Rutgers (Dec. 3 Big East-SEC Challenge).

After that it's final exam week on the LSU campus before LSU gets three straight home games against Boise State (Dec. 10), UC-Irvine (Dec. 15) and Marquette (Dec. 19).

Season 41 At The PMAC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU will be trying to get its home field advantage back this season at the Maravich Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers still have a good percentage in the building's history of 462-164 (73.8%) overall, including 248-36 (87.3 percent) in non-conference contests ... Trent Johnson is 29-5 in his three years as head coach at LSU in home non-conference contests.

The Tigers are 1-0 this season at home and will play again in Baton Rouge on Wednesday, Nov. 23, at 7 p.m. against South Alabama. The Cox Sports TV regional network of the New Orleans Hornets and LSU will televise the game.

On The Road

The Tigers had three road wins last year on opponent's courts - at South Alabama, at Auburn and at Mississippi State, finishing 3-8 on opponents home courts last year ... In Trent Johnson's first three seasons at LSU, the Tigers are 9-21 on opponent's home courts ... Overall, LSU is 403-578 (41.1%) on the road in its history.

Neutral Court

LSU's win on the neutral court Friday gets LSU a rare recent win on a neutral court ... LSU is 2-11 since the start of the 2008-09 season on a neutral court, but a fairly strong 123-127 in the history of the program on neutral courts.

Depth Returns To LSU Basketball

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years - depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster ... The main difference for this year's team is that it has allowed players to play their natural position, for example, Eddie Ludwig can now play on the wing facing the basket and last year's point guard, Andre Stringer, is now playing on the wing, although he can play the

Good Start For Mr. Basketball, McDonald's All-American

High school honors are one thing, but will high school stars be able to make the transition to a game where possessions taken off are a recipe for disaster.

Both Kentucky's Mr. Basketball, Anthony Hickey, and McDonald's All-American Johnny O'Bryant III made the most of their time on the court in the opener.

Hickey played 27 minutes, hitting three treys with five assists, four steals and a team best 14 points, while O'Bryant III came off the bench with a flourish to play 21 minutes with six field goals, a team high eight rebounds, two blocks and 12 points.

LSU's other freshman John Isaac also was ready to roll on opening afternoon, scoring 13 points off a couple of treys with three assists.

Against Coastal Carolina, points were harder to come by for Isaac and Hickey, but O'Bryant III came off the bench to hit four field goals, including his first college three-pointer. O'Bryant finished with nine points in 13 minutes before he fouled out.

In the two tournaments games, Hickey has averaged 14.0 points per game, tied for team honors with eight assists, O'Bryant is averaging 11.5 points, although he scored just two points in the Western Kentucky game.

Countdown to Warren Milestone

LSU senior Storm Warren is at the point where the countdown has begun to his 500 career rebound when he would become the 37th player in school history to grab 500 boards ... Warren just missed a double double against Coastal Carolina with nine boards and he now has 466 rebounds, 33 shy of 500.

Tigers Sign Malik Morgan In Early Signing Period

The LSU Athletics Department and men's basketball Coach Trent Johnson announced on last Wednesday that the school has received the signed national letter of intent papers from highly-ranked guard Malik Morgan from River Ridge, La. Morgan, who is 6-3, is entering his senior season at John Curtis High School.

Morgan has garnered national recognition from the recruiting sites, ranking No. 75 overall in The Rivals 150 for the class of 2012. The four-star prospect is also ranked 11th in the country at the shooting guard position.

This past year Morgan averaged 28.9 points a game, including a career-high 52 points in one game against Riverside. He also averaged nine rebounds, two steals and two assists a game.

"We are very excited about the addition of Malik Morgan to the LSU Basketball family," said LSU Coach Trent Johnson. "Besides coming from a great family, Malik is a very, very good basketball player. He is very skilled -- not a good scorer, but a great scorer. One of the most impressive things about Malik besides his offensive skills and his ability to make players better, is his overall competitiveness. He is very competitive and he is going to have a huge impact on our team next year. Without question, I didn't see a better guard in the state of Louisiana, let alone his rankings as one of the best guards in the country."

Morgan's mother, the former Detra Brown, was a four-year letter-winner in volleyball while at LSU where she was twice an All-SEC selection. She still ranks fourth at LSU in career kills (1,504) and is one of only five players in the program's history to ever record 1,000 digs and 1,000 kills in a career.

Morgan chose LSU over Boston College, Georgia Tech, Missouri, Oklahoma and UTEP.

Tigers Back Home on Wednesday
