#### G 1 Anthony Hickey (Fr., 5-11, Hopkinsville, Ky.) 13.4 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.8 apg

Hickey was Mr. Basketball in Kentucky last season and a late period signee for LSU ... Was the first freshman to start at point in opener since 2000 season .... All-Tournament in Charleston ... 20 against Georgia Tech (11/20), 14th in the league in scoring, seventh in assists ... 19 assists, 14 turnovers.

#### G 10 Andre Stringer (So., 5-9, Jackson, Miss.) 10.2 ppg, 1.2 rpg, 2.4 apg

Stringer has moved to the wing guard position and has nine treys (9-24, 37.5%), 12-13 at free throw line ... 12 steals ... Started 35 consecutive games dating back to last year.

#### G 22 Ralston Turner (So., 6-6, Muscle Shoals, Ala.) 10.6 ppg, 3.2 rpg

Turner started every game he has dressed for (32) ... Leading scorer a year ago ... Coaches All-SEC Freshman team a year ago ... Leads team with 11 treys (11-31, 35.5%).

#### F 24 Storm Warren (Sr., 6-7, Monroe, La.) 8.2 ppg, 6.0 rpg

Warren will look to rebound from an 0-of-11 night from the field when he took several nice shots that wouldn't fall ... Closing in on joining the 500 career rebound club at LSU with 471 career boards.

#### C 41 Justin Hamilton (Jr., 7-0, Alpine, Utah) 11.2 ppg, 6.6 rpg, 1.0 apg

Transferred from Iowa State after his sophomore season ... Back-to-back double figure games in tourney ... Had 18 points, 9 rebounds in 24 minutes against W. Ky, including 5-of-10 from the field, 8-8 from line ... Hit 4-of-5 vs. Northwestern (11/17), scoring 10 ... 18-of-42 from field, 20-of-23 from the line.

### STORYLINES

- Tigers return home after playing four games in the state of South Carolina in six days ... LSU was 2-2 overall and more importantly, 2-1 in the Charleston Classic ... In the Classic, LSU lost to Northwestern before beating W. Ky. and Ga. Tech. .

- Anthony Hickey earned All-Tournament honors at Charleston averaging 16.0 points per game in the three games (making 19-of-37 FG) and 6-of-14 from the arc ... Justin Hamilton averaged 12.0 in the three games and Andre Stringer 10.3.

- After a year with no seniors, the present 12-man roster is spread evenly with three seniors (Bass, Warren, White), juniors (DelPiero, Hamilton, Ludwig), sophomores (Courtney, Stringer, Turner) and freshman (Hickey, Isaac, O'Bryant III).

- Tigers return to Baton Rouge for just the second home game of the season, but after Wednesday it is back on the road to Houston (Nov. 29) and at Rutgers (Dec. 3) ... LSU will not be back at home after Wednesday until Dec. 10 when LSU meets Boise State.

- Tigers have averaged 7.2 treys so far after averaging 5.0 a year ago ... The highlight early is at the free throw line, where LSU is far and away the leader in the SEC at 79.6 percent ... The second team in free throws in the SEC is at 76.3 percent.

- In all five games this year, LSU has had double digit offensive boards, including 20 vs. Nicholls and 19 against W. Ky ... LSU is third in the league in offensive rebounds at 16.2 a game ... Hamilton averages 3.6 a game, while O'Bryant III and Warren are at 2.4 a contest.

# Trent Johnson

Head Coach • 4th year at LSU (13th year as head coach)

Trent Johnson, with two strong back-to-back recruiting classes on board, enters his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU Tigers in 2011-12.

Johnson's passion and vision for the LSU basketball program has the Tigers headed in the right direction.

As Johnson and his staff continue to develop players both on the court and off the court, they expected continued improvement athletically, academically and socially from the team.

Johnson, the 20th men's basketball coach at LSU, seeks to build on more than a decade of excellence at LSU, Stanford and Nevada. Having earned Conference Coach of the Year in all three leagues (Western Athletic Conference, Pac-10 and Southeastern Conference), Johnson knows the route to success to getting LSU back in the national spotlight.

In his first season at LSU, Johnson led the Tigers to 27 wins, tied for the third most wins in a season in LSU history. The Tigers won the SEC regular season championship with a record of 13-3. LSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006, advancing to the second round before falling, 84-70, to North Carolina in the closest game the eventual national champions would have to play. LSU had a second half lead on the Tar Heels and the game was still in the balance entering the final eight minutes.

Coach Johnson has a blueprint for success for himself and his layers. As his players grasp the vision for success, they have the opportunity to embrace playing in a fast-paced system where executing in the half court and defending and rebounding are at a high level.

Johnson has a record of success and his team will have the opportunity to blend together and learn from a coach that is a fierce competitor who exudes and demands toughness.

His devotion of the team, his protective beliefs toward his players and his loyalty to his former players is evidenced the fact that three of his former players are now members of the LSU basketball staff. Johnson is a program builder and he has re-established the base of the LSU program by visiting with former players and coaches to bring together the past, the present and the future of the program.

Johnson also is charged with the development of athletes both on and off the court. Off the court, he has worked hard since day one to make sure student-athletes understand the "student" part of their days at LSU. At all three spots in his head coaching career, he has developed not just successful athletes and winning basketball teams, but young men who are having success in life.

In his 12 years combined as a Division I head coach at LSU, Stanford and Nevada, he has won 208 games and taken teams in seven-of-the-last-nine seasons to post-season play, including five NCAA appearances.

Johnson was named the 2009 consensus SEC Coach of the Year and was a finalist for four national coach of the year honors as he became the first LSU men's basketball coach to win the league title and take the team to post-season play in his first year at the school.

Johnson has always been a big believer in special causes and joined former LSU basketball coach Dale Brown and star center Shaquille O'Neal in cutting a series of commercials that aired nationally for the "Be A Match" organization of bone marrow donors.

In June 2010, Johnson was part of a 10-day trip to Africa as part of the Nkomazi Sports Club Organization program that was established to stop the transmission of KIV through culturally relevant, locally sustainable health and life skills education-based programs in communities affected by HIV/AIDS.

He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and has served on the NABC Special Committee on Recruiting and Access. He also gives his time freely to such organizations as the Boy Scouts of America, the Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc., the American Diabestes Association, Samaritan's Feet, Troops First and the Jummy V Foundation for cancer research.

Johnson, was born in Berkeley, Calif., and is married to Jackie and they have two children: a daughter, Tinishia, 28, and a son, Terry, 25.

Johnson's vision and passion is what drives him to make LSU basketball a success. With a coaching staff and a group of players that believe in the same vision and passion, that success has to be very much in site.

### Last Time Out - LSU 59, Georgia Tech 50 (Nov. 20, Charleston Classic)

LSU finishes with a 2-1 record in the Charleston Classic after its final day win over Georgia Tech .... Freshman point guard Anthony Hickey cinched his spot on the All-Tournament team with 20 points, including four treys ... LSU led by four at the half and the game remained close until LSU went on a 9-4 run in which Hickey, Ralston Turner and Andre Stringer all hit threes to put LSU up for good ... LSU made 8-of-18 from the arc and 9-of-10 free thows ... LSU's Stringer was also in double figures at 11 points.

### The Series With South Alabama

This will be the second consecutive year and the third time overall that the Jaguars and the LSU Tigers have done battle on the hardwood ... The teams first met in the championship game of the Hispanic College Funds Classic here in 2002 with LSU a 71-62 winner.

Last season, in the first year of a home-and-home series, LSU has a big first half, shooting 66.7 percent from the field (16-24) and 10-13 (76.9%) from the arc in building



a 48-23 advantage ... LSU would win the game, 80-65, as USA would shoot 60 percent (6-10) from the arc in the second half ... Andre Stringer had 21 points, Ralston Turner 17 and Aaron Dotson 15.

Ronnie Arrow is in his fifth season of his second stint at South Alabama ... He previously coached the Jaquars for eight seasons from 1988-95 before coaching eight years at Texas-Corpus Christi. He was called back to South Alabama in 2007-08.

South Alabama is 1-2 on the season with a home win over Mobile, 74-63 and road losses at Mississippi State, 80-65, and nationally-ranked Florida State, 80-39. In that game, Augustine Rubit was the leading scorer and rebounder with 10 points and eight boards ... South Alabama shot 23.5 percent from the field (23.5%) and was 0-24 from the arc.

### Reviewing the Classic; Hickey All-Tournament

LSU finished the Charleston Classic with a 2-1 record as LSU defeated Western Kentucky, 76-57, and Georgia Tech, 59-50, after an 88-82 first-round loss at Northwestern. In the process, point guard Anthony Hickey was named to the five-member all-tournament team after averaging 16 points for the three game, hitting over 51 percent of his field goal attempts (19-of-37), making six treys and averaging 4.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

Justin Hamilton also averaged 12 points and 7.7 rebounds and Andre Stringer 10.3 points per game.

Against Northwestern, Johnny O'Bryant III led the team with 21 points in 22 minutes, with Stringer getting 15, Hickey 11 and Hamilton 10. LSU had a 41-32 lead at the half, but Northwestern's 1-3-1 zone in the second half caused LSU problems turning the game to a nine-point Northwestern lead with 5:07 left. LSU cut the lead down gradually to one on a Ralston Turner Trey with 48 seconds left, but Northwestern came down and hit a three of its own to put the game out of reach.

The LSU-Western Kentucky affair was a trip to the free throw line in the first half as the teams combined for 53 first half free throws. LSU was 13-of-17 in the half, WKU 14-of-14. In the second half, LSU was 5-of-7 while WKU was 4-of-13. LSU made some key shots and got 22 points off turnovers to win going away. Justin Hamilton had 18 points and Anthony Hickey 17.

The summary of the LSU-Georgia Tech game is in the "Last Game" section earlier in the release.

### Season 41 At The PMAC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU will be trying to get its home field advantage back this season at the Maravich Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers still have a good percentage in the building's history of 462-164 (73.8%) overall, including 248-36 (87.3 percent) in non-conference contests ... Trent Johnson is 29-5 in his three years as head coach at LSU in home non-conference contests.

The Tigers are 1-0 this season at home and this is the first game at home since the opener ... LSU's next three home games will be on regional television as Cox Sports TV begins its four-game locally produced slate of contests ... LSU returns home on Dec. 10 to take on Boise State and plays UC-Irvine on Dec. 15.

### On The Road

The Tigers had three road wins last year on opponent's courts - at South Alabama, at Auburn and at Mississippi State, finishing 3-8 on opponents home courts last year ... In Trent Johnson's first three seasons at LSU, the Tigers are 9-21 on opponent's home courts ... Overall, LSU is 403-578 (41.1%) on the road in its history.

### Neutral Court

LSU's two wins on a neutral court last week stopped a couple of years of non-winning seasons on neutral courts ... LSU is now 4-11 since the start of the 2008-09

season on a neutral court, but 124-127 in the history of the program.

### Depth Returns To LSU Basketball

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years - depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster ... The main difference for this year's team is that it has allowed players to play their natural position, for example, Eddie Ludwig can now play on the wing facing the basket and last year's point guard, Andre Stringer, is now playing on the wing, although he can play the point if needed.

In the first five games, the freshmen have scored 35 percent of the points, the sophomores 29 and the juniors and seniors 17 percent each. So far in five games, freshmen have led LSU in scoring three times (Hickey 2, O'Bryant III 1), a sophomore once (Turner) and a junior (Hamilton). On the rebounding end, a freshman led twice (O'Bryant III), a junior twice (Hamilton) and a senior (Warren).

### Look At The Free Throw Shooting

In an effort to completely jinx our free throw shooting, the Tigers lead the league in charity tossing at 79.6 percent, far and away the best at this early stage of the season ... The unique thing is that it is mostly all over the board with nine players having percentages over 70 and six over 80 ... Hickey is at 70 percent (7-of-10), Hamilton 87 percent (20-23), Turner 76.9 percent (10-13), Stringer 92.3 percent (12-13) and Warren 90 percent (9-of-10) ... Warren's best previous year at the stripe was his sophomore year when he made 68.3 percent (84-123) ... Turner hit 70.3 percent a season ago (64-91) and Stringer was 77.2 percent (98-127).

Last season LSU made 66.5 percent of its free throws (432-650), the second consecutive season LSU was below 70 percent ... This year LSU is 86-of-108 from the line while opponents are 74-of-100 ... LSU has made more free throws than any team in the Southeastern Conference and only Mississippi State (113) has attempted more.

### The Arc Is Better

LSU last season shot 31.2 percent from the three-point arc, making 175 -of-561 attempts (5.4 a game) ... In the first five games this season, LSU's percentage is up to 36.7 percent (36-of-98), averaging 7.2 a contest ... Ralston Turner had 11, Anthony Hickey 10 and Andre Stringer 9. Hickey is at 41.7 percent (10-24), Turner 35.5 percent (11-31) and Stringer 37.5 percent (9-24).

### Good Start For Mr. Basketball, McDonald's All-American

High school honors are one thing, but will high school stars be able to make the transition to a game where possessions taken off are a recipe for disaster.

Kentucky's Mr. Basketball, Anthony Hickey, and McDonald's All-American Johnny O'Bryant III made the most of their time on the court in the opener.

Hickey's All-Tournament performance in the Charleston Classic has been documented early, but O'Bryant III came up big in the Northwestern game when he hit 6-of-8 field goal attempts in 22 minutes and made 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a 21 point effort. O'Bryant III also had a team high eight boards.

O'Bryant III struggled in the Western Kentucky game and while only scoring five against Georgia Tech, did have seven rebounds and an assist in 17 minutes.

### Hamilton Showed Abilities on the Road

The transfer from Iowa State had double figures in two of his three games, highlighted by 18 against Western Kentucky in the second game of the Charleston Classic ... Hamilton had 18 points on 5-of-10 shooting and 8-of-8 at the free throw line and just missed his first double double with nine rebounds ... For the three games, Hamilton averaged 11.2 points and 6.6 boards.

### Countdown to Warren Milestone

LSU senior Storm Warren is at the point where the countdown has begun to his 500 career rebound when he would become the 37th player in school history to grab 500 boards ... Warren just missed a double double against Coastal Carolina with nine

boards and he now has 471 rebounds, 29 shy of 500.

### LSU In Early SEC Stats

Entering the week, LSU was fifth in the league in scoring offense at 75.2 points per game, as documented the leader in free throw percentage (79.6%), but 11th in field goal percentage at 39.9 percent. The Tigers are fourth in three-point field goal percentage at 36.7. LSU is seventh in rebounds at 38.8 percent, but third in offensive rebounds at 16.2 a game ... The Tigers are eighth in the league in assists (12.6), but one of just two teams (Arkansas higher at 10.7) to average over 10 steals a game (10.4).

### Well, Who Knows What Is Ahead For The NBA

As the negotiations get tougher and tougher, the status of the NBA becomes tough to know ... LSU has seven players waiting to find out if, when and where they will go back to work (at least that was the number that finished the season in the league) ... At least two players (Glen Davis and Marcus Thornton) are free agents looking to see what offers there will be once negotiations can become ... Two more, Garrett Temple and Chris Johnson, will be looking to extend the 10-day contracts that had them finishing the season on teams ... What is known is that Shaquille O'Neal has retired and that means that Brandon Bass, entering his seventh season in the league, is LSU's new senior member in the NBA. Here is the way things stood at the end of the regular season:

**Brandon Bass, Orlando Magic – entering his 3rd season with Orlando, 7th in NBA**

**Glen Davis, Boston Celtics – free agent after four seasons in Boston**

**Chris Johnson, Portland Trailblazers – finished with Portland (10-day contracts)**

**Anthony Randolph, Minnesota – entering his fourth season in the NBA**

**Tyrus Thomas, Charlotte – entering 2nd full season with Charlotte, 6th in NBA**

**Marcus Thornton, Sacramento – free agent, traded in mid-season from New Orleans**

**Garrett Temple, Charlotte Bobcats – Has signed 1-year deal with Casale in Italy.**

### The Standings Will Look Different This Year In The SEC

For the first time since the 1991-92 season, the Southeastern Conference men's basketball standings will not be divided into Eastern and Western Divisions. The coaches voted and the athletic directors approved the move back to a league standing sheet that goes 1-12, top to bottom with the top four teams in the standings getting byes on the first night of the SEC Tournament. In the past, the top two teams in each division received the byes.

The 16-game schedule for this year is still based on divisional play of past years, home and home against the west teams and one game against the east, but the schedule for next year is still in a state of flux with new teams entering the league next year. It is expected the men's basketball teams will play some sort of 18-game conference schedule next year.

### Tournament Goes Back To New Orleans

For the third time, the Southeastern Conference Tournament will be held in New Orleans, March 8-11, 2012 ... The tournament was previously held in 1996 and 2003 in New Orleans at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome, but this year's event will be held at the home of the New Orleans Hornets, the New Orleans Arena ... The winner of the event receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

### Tigers Sign Malik Morgan In Early Signing Period

The LSU Athletics Department and men's basketball Coach Trent Johnson announced on last Wednesday that the school has received the signed national letter of intent papers from highly-ranked guard Malik Morgan from River Ridge, La. Morgan, who is 6-3, is entering his senior season at John Curtis High School.

Morgan has garnered national recognition from the recruiting sites, ranking No. 75 overall in The Rivals 150 for the class of 2012. The four-star prospect is also ranked 11th in the country at the shooting guard position.

This past year Morgan averaged 28.9 points a game, including a career-high 52 points in one game against Riverside. He also averaged nine rebounds, two steals and two assists a game.

"We are very excited about the addition of Malik Morgan to the LSU Basketball family," said LSU Coach Trent Johnson. "Besides coming from a great family, Malik is a very, very good basketball player. He is very skilled -- not a good scorer, but a great scorer. One of the most impressive things about Malik besides his offensive skills and his ability to make players better, is his overall competitiveness. He is very competitive and he is going to have a huge impact on our team next year. Without question, I didn't see a better guard in the state of Louisiana, let alone his rankings as one of the best guards in the country."

Morgan's mother, the former Detra Brown, was a four-year letter-winner in volleyball while at LSU where she was twice an All-SEC selection. She still ranks fourth at LSU in career kills (1,504) and is one of only five players in the program's history to ever record 1,000 digs and 1,000 kills in a career.

Morgan chose LSU over Boston College, Georgia Tech, Missouri, Oklahoma and UTEP.
