Hickey was Mr. Basketball in Kentucky last season ... Was the first freshman to start at point in opener since 2000 season All-Tournament in Charleston ... 20 against Georgia Tech (11/20), xxth in the league in scoring, xxth in assists ... 6 assists, no turnovers vs. S. Ala (11/23) ... 25 assists, 14 turnovers for season ... 12-of-28 from arc.

G 10 Andre Stringer (So., 5-9, Jackson, Miss.) 11.8 ppg, 1.3 rpg, 2.7 apg

Stringer, the team's starting point guard a year ago, had his third best college game vs. S. Ala. (11/23) with 20 points on 6-of-10 shooting, including 3 treys ... Now the wing guard, started 36 consecutive games. 12-30 from arc.

G 22 Ralston Turner (So., 6-6, Muscle Shoals, Ala.) 11.0 ppg, 2.8 rpg, 1.5 apg

Turner started every game he has dressed at LSU (33) ... Leading scorer a year ago ... Coaches All-SEC Freshman team a year ago ... Team best 14 treys (14-38, 36.8%).

F 24 Storm Warren (Sr., 6-7, Monroe, La.) 7.8 ppg, 5.7 rpg

Warren 3-of-19 from the field in the last two games ... One of two four-year seniors on the team ... Closing in on joining the 500 career rebound club at LSU with 475 career boards.

C 41 Justin Hamilton (Jr., 7-0, Alpine, Utah) 11.2 ppg, 6.2 rpg, 1.5 apg

Transferred from Iowa State after his sophomore season ... Hit 5-of-6 from field off 11 points in S. Ala. game (11/23) ... 23-of-48 from the field (47.9 percent) and 21-24 from FT line (87.5%) ... Double figures four of the six games, including 18 against Western Kentucky in the Charleston Classic.

STORYLINES

- For the second time in the short season so far, LSU will have a week full of road games starting Tuesday night at Houston ... After Tuesday, LSU will drive back to Baton Rouge and prepare for Saturday's 6 p.m. CST game at Rutgers on the final night of the first Big East/SEC Challenge.

- Anthony Hickey earned All-Tournament honors at Charleston averaging 16.0 points per game in the three games (making 19-of-37 FG) and 6-of-14 from the arc ... Justin Hamilton averaged 12.0 in the three games and Andre Stringer 10.3.

- After a year with no seniors, the present 12-man roster is spread evenly with three seniors (Bass, Warren, White), juniors (DelPiero, Hamilton, Ludwig), sophomores (Courtney, Stringer, Turner) and freshman (Hickey, Isaac, O'Bryant III).

- After shooting over 31 percent from the arc a year ago, the Tigers are shooting 38.3% and making 7.3 treys a game ... That's an improvement of two a game for LSU ... Hickey, Stringer and Turner have combined to make 38 of LSU's 44 treys.

- LSU had its worst game percentage wise at the free throw line against S. Ala (11/23), making just 68 percent to drop the team average to 78.2 percent (97-of-124), still best in the SEC .

- In all six games, LSU has had double digit offensive boards, including 20 vs. Nicholls and 19 against W. Ky.

- With NBA strike settled, several former LSU stars must now get ready to go to training camp. More importantly, players like Glen Davis and Marcus Thornton have to find teams as free agents.

Trent Johnson

Head Coach • 4th year at LSU (13th year as head coach)

Trent Johnson, with two strong back-to-back recruiting classes on board, enters his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU Tigers in 2011-12.

Johnson's passion and vision for the LSU basketball program has the Tigers headed in the right direction.

As Johnson and his staff continue to develop players both on the court and off the court, they expected continued improvement athletically, academically and socially from the team.

Johnson, the 20th men's basketball coach at LSU, seeks to build on more than a decade of excellence at LSU, Stanford and Nevada. Having earned Conference Coach of the Year in all three leagues (Western Athletic Conference, Pac-10 and Southeastern Conference), Johnson knows the route to success to getting LSU back in the national spotlight.

In his first season at LSU, Johnson led the Tigers to 27 wins, tied for the third most wins in a season in LSU history. The Tigers won the SEC regular season championship with a record of 13-3. LSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006, advancing to the second round before falling, 84-70, to North Carolina in the closest game the eventual national champions would have to play. LSU had a second half lead on the Tar Heels and the game was still in the balance entering the final eight minutes.

Coach Johnson has a blueprint for success for himself and his layers. As his players grasp the vision for success, they have the opportunity to embrace playing in a fast-paced system where executing in the half court and defending and rebounding are at a high level.

Johnson has a record of success and his team will have the opportunity to blend together and learn from a coach that is a fierce competitor who exudes and demands toughness.

His devotion of the team, his protective beliefs toward his players and his loyalty to his former players is evidenced the fact that three of his former players are now members of the LSU basketball staff. Johnson is a program builder and he has re-established the base of the LSU program by visiting with former players and coaches to bring together the past, the present and the future of the program.

Johnson also is charged with the development of athletes both on and off the court. Off the court, he has worked hard since day one to make sure student-athletes understand the "student" part of their days at LSU. At all three spots in his head coaching career, he has developed not just successful athletes and winning basketball teams, but young men who are having success in life.

In his 12 years combined as a Division I head coach at LSU, Stanford and Nevada, he has won 208 games and taken teams in seven-of-the-last-nine seasons to post-season play, including five NCAA appearances.

Johnson was named the 2009 consensus SEC Coach of the Year and was a finalist for four national coach of the year honors as he became the first LSU men's basketball coach to win the league title and take the team to post-season play in his first year at the school.

Johnson has always been a big believer in special causes and joined former LSU basketball coach Dale Brown and star center Shaquille O'Neal in cutting a series of commercials that aired nationally for the "Be A Match" organization of bone marrow donors.

In June 2010, Johnson was part of a 10-day trip to Africa as part of the Nkomazi Sports Club Organization program that was established to stop the transmission of HIV through culturally relevant, locally sustainable health and life skills education-based programs in communities affected by HIV/AIDS.

He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and has served on the NABC Special Committee on Recruiting and Access. He also gives his time freely to such organizations as the Boy Scouts of America, the Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc., the American Diabestes Association, Samaritan's Feet, Troops First and the Jummy V Foundation for cancer research.

Johnson, was born in Berkeley, Calif., and is married to Jackie and they have two children: a daughter, Tinishia, 28, and a son, Terry, 25.

Johnson's vision and passion is what drives him to make LSU basketball a success. With a coaching staff and a group of players that believe in the same vision and passion, that success has to be very much in site.

Last Time Out - South Alabama 79, LSU 75 (Nov. 23, Baton Rouge)

The Tigers found themselves unable to hold a double digit lead against South Alabama last Wednesday at the Maravich Center, allowing South Alabama to first tie the game and then take the lead for good en route to a 79-75 overtime triumph for the Jaguars ... LSU led 41-31 at the intermission and led by 11, 61-50, with 8:04 to go before USA outscored the Tigers, 19-8, the rest of the way to go to overtime tied at 67 ...South Alabama made 3-of-6 field goals, while LSU was 1-of-5 in overtime as LSU fell to 2-3 in the Trent Johnson years in overtime games.

LSU had four players in double figures led by Andre Stringer with 20 points and four assists ... It was the third best scoring game of Stringer's career at LSU ... Ralston Turner had 13 points, while Anthony Hickey scored 12 points (with six assists and no turnovers) and Justin Hamilton had 11 ... LSU shot 42.4 percent for the game (28-66), while South Alabama was at 50.8 percent (30-59) ... The Tigers made 8-of-17 from the arc (47.1%) ... LSU and USA both had 12 offensive rebounds, but overall LSU was out boarded, 42-31.

Houston Information; Series

LSU and Houston will meet in the back half of a home-and-home series on Tuesday, and while it will be just the second meeting since 2005, it will be the eighth meeting in the series since 2000 ... Last year, LSU scored a 73-57 win in the Maravich Center, with Ralston Turner lead the Tigers with 15 points; Andre Stringer added 13 (including 11-of-12 at the free throw line) and Storm Warren had 12 points, 11 rebounds and four blocks for the Tigers ... A year ago, LSU shot 50 percent from the field (26-52), compared to 39.7% (23-58) for Houston.

Houston dropped its second home game of the year Saturday night with an 81-80 loss to TCU ... TCU got a desperation bucket after an offensive rebound to get the winning bucket right before the buzzer ... Five players for each team were in double figures with Alandise Harris hitting 8-of-10 field goals for 16 points to lead Houston. Also in double figures for the Cougars were Joseph Young, who had four treys, with 14 points (6 assists), while TaShawn Thomas, Jonathon Simmons and J. J. Thompson each had 12 points ... Houston shot 54.5 percent (30-55) for the game, while TCU posted a 46.9% field goal mark (30-64).

James Dickey is in his second year as the head coach at Houston, while the veteran mentor is in his 12th season overall as a Division I head coach ... Dickey was the head coach at Texas Tech from 1991-01 before taking an assistant coach position at Oklahoma State (2002-08) before being named head coach at Houston prior to the 2010-11 season ... He has also had assistant coach stints in the Southeastern Conference, serving at Arkansas (1981-85) and Kentucky (1985-89) ... He was twice SWC Coach of the Year (1992, 1996).

This will be the 16th meeting between the Tigers and the Cougars with Houston holding a 9-6 lead ... Teams played in 1962, 1965, 1971 and 1981 before a home and home in 1983 and 1984 ... Beginning in 1997 through 2005, the teams had a fairly regular spot on each other's schedule, playing eight times before the series was resumed last year.

Ironically, the focus for both teams are undefeated football teams facing conference championship games this week as Houston will host the C-USA title game; while LSU travels to Atlanta for the SEC Championship game with Georgia.

Reviewing the Charleston Classic; Hickey All-Tournament

LSU finished the Nov. 17-20 Charleston Classic with a 2-1 record as LSU defeated Western Kentucky, 76-57, and Georgia Tech, 59-50, after an 88-82 first-round loss versus Northwestern. In the process, point guard Anthony Hickey was named to the five-member all-tournament team after averaging 16 points for the three games, hitting over 51 percent of his field goal attempts (19-of-37), making six treys and averaging 4.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

Justin Hamilton also averaged 12 points and 7.7 rebounds and Andre Stringer 10.3 points per game.

Against Northwestern, Johnny O'Bryant III led the team with 21 points in 22 minutes, with Stringer getting 15, Hickey 11 and Hamilton 10. LSU had a 41-32 lead at the half, but Northwestern's 1-3-1 zone in the second half caused LSU problems turning the game to a nine-point Northwestern lead with 5:07 left. LSU cut the lead down gradually to one on a Ralston Turner Trey with 48 seconds left, but Northwestern came down and hit a three of its own to put the game out of reach.

The LSU-Western Kentucky affair was a trip to the free throw line in the first half as the teams combined for 53 first half free throws. LSU was 13-of-17 in the half, WKU 14-of-14. In the second half, LSU was 5-of-7 while WKU was 4-of-13. LSU made some key shots and got 22 points off turnovers to win going away. Justin Hamilton had 18 points and Anthony Hickey 17.

In the fifth place game versus Georgia Tech, freshman point guard Anthony Hickey cinched his spot on the All-Tournament team with 20 points, including four treys ... LSU led by four at the half and the game remained close until LSU went on a 9-4 run in which Hickey, Ralston Turner and Andre Stringer all hit threes to put LSU up for good ... LSU made 8-of-18 from the arc and 9-of-10 free throws ... LSU's Stringer was also in double figures at 11 points.

Season 41 At The PMAC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU will be trying to get its home field advantage back this season at the Maravich Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers still have a good percentage in the building's history of 462-165 (73.8%) overall, including 248-37 (87.3 percent) in non-conference contests ... Trent Johnson is 29-6 in his three years as head coach at LSU in home non-conference contests.

The Tigers are 1-1 this season at home ... LSU returns home on Dec. 10 to take on Boise State and plays UC-Irvine on Dec. 15.

On The Road

The Tigers had three road wins last year on opponent's courts - at South Alabama, at Auburn and at Mississippi State, finishing 3-8 on opponents home courts last year ... In Trent Johnson's first three seasons at LSU, the Tigers are 9-21 on opponent's home courts ... Overall, LSU is 403-578 (41.1%) on the road in its history ... LSU's is 0-1 on the road court this year, losing earlier in the month at Coastal Carolina.

Neutral Court

LSU's two wins on a neutral court in the Charleston Classic stopped a couple of years of non-winning seasons on neutral courts ... LSU is now 4-11 since the start of the 2008-09 season on a neutral court, but 124-127 in the history of the program, 2-1 this year.

Depth Returns To LSU Basketball

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years - depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster ... The main difference for this year's team is that it has allowed players to play their natural position, for example, Eddie Ludwig can now play on the wing facing the basket and last year's point guard, Andre Stringer, is now playing on the wing, although he can play the point if needed.

In the first six games, the freshmen have scored 34.8 percent of the points, the sophomores 32 percent, the juniors 17 and seniors 16 percent. So far in six games, freshmen have led LSU in scoring three times (Hickey 2, O'Bryant III 1), a sophomore twice (Turner, Stringer) and a junior once (Hamilton). On the rebounding end, a freshman led three times (O'Bryant III), a junior twice (Hamilton) and a senior (Warren).

Holding The Lead

Twice in LSU's three losses, the Tigers found themselves with double digit leads that they were unable to keep as the game moved through the second half.

Vs. Northwestern (11/17) - The Tigers were able to get a 41-32 halftime advantage, but the Wildcats came back with a 1-3-1 matchup zone that gave the Tigers trouble, allowing Northwestern to even the game and get a nine-point lead heading to the final five minutes. To LSU's credit, the Tigers were able to work the game back down and cut the lead to just one on a Ralston Turner three with 48 seconds left. But Northwestern was able to clinch the game with a three-of-its-own at the 28-second mark en route to the 88-82 win.

Vs. Coastal Carolina (11/23) - LSU was up 41-31 at intermission in the game at the Maravich Center and led by 11, 61-50, at the 8:04 mark before South Alabama made their move as LSU began to get away from its offense ... USA eventually tied the game at 63-63 with 3:31 to play, eventually forcing the game to overtime at 69-69 ... In the overtime, a jumper by the Jaguars followed by a blocked LSU layup and another bucket by USA gave South Alabama a 75-71 lead with 2:22 to play that LSU couldn't overcome.

Look At The Free Throw Shooting

Although the Tigers missed just five three throws against South Alabama, the 11-of-16 effort was just 68 percent from the stripe, the lowest of the season at the free throw line ... However, it dropped LSU's six-game season total to 78.2 percent which is still three points better than anyone in the Southeastern Conference (75.2 percent) ... LSU is 97-of-124 from the stripe and only Kentucky (102) has made more free throws so far this season Leading the Tigers at the line are Andre Stringer (17-19) at 89.5 percent, Justin Hamilton (21-24) at 87.5 percent, Storm Warren (9-11) 81.8 percent and Ralston Turner (12-15) hitting 80 percent.

Opponents are at 73.8 percent (90-122) ... Last season LSU made 66.5 percent of its free throws (432-650), the second consecutive season LSU was below 70 percent.

Stringer is third in the league in free throw percentage with Hamilton sixth and Turner 10th.

The Arc Is Better

LSU last season shot 31.2 percent from the three-point arc, making 175 -of-561 attempts (5.4 a game) ... In the first six games this season, LSU's percentage is up to 38.3 percent (44-of-115), averaging 7.3 a contest ... Ralston Turner has 14, Anthony Hickey and Andre Stringer 12 each ... Hickey is at 42.9 percent (12-28), Stringer 40.0 percent (12-30) and Turner at 36.8 percent (14-38) ... LSU is fourth in the league in three-point shooting with Hickey's percentage 13th in the league ... Turner's 2.3 treys a game average is tied for sixth in the league.

Good Start For Mr. Basketball, McDonald's All-American

High school honors are one thing, but will high school stars be able to make the transition to a game where the game is faster and more is required more often.

Kentucky's Mr. Basketball, Anthony Hickey, and McDonald's All-American Johnny O'Bryant III made the most of their time on the court in the opener.

Hickey's All-Tournament performance in the Charleston Classic has been documented earlier, but he had one of his best games distributing the ball against South Alabama last week, playing 37 minutes with six assists and no turnovers ... Hickey is fourth in the league in assist average at 4.2 a game and eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio with 25 assists and 14 turnovers, a 1.8 ratio ... Hickey leads the team in scoring at 13.2 points per game.

O'Bryant III came up big in the Northwestern game (11/17) when he hit 6-of-8 field goal attempts in 22 minutes and made 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a 21 point effort. O'Bryant III also had a team high eight boards.

Against South Alabama (11/23), O'Bryant III led the team in rebounds for the second time this season with eight. He is just below double figures with 9.7 points and a team best 6.3 rebounds a game.

Hamilton Showing Ability

The transfer from Iowa State had double figures in two of his three games in the Charleston Classic, highlighted by 18 against Western Kentucky ... Hamilton had 18 points on 5-of-10 shooting and 8-of-8 at the free throw line and just missed his first double double with nine rebounds ... For the three games, Hamilton averaged 11.2 points and 6.6 boards ... Hamilton had 11 points in the South Alabama game.

Countdown to Warren Milestone

LSU senior Storm Warren is at the point where the countdown has begun to his 500 career rebound when he would become the 37th player in school history to grab 500 boards ... Warren just missed a double double against Coastal Carolina (11/15) with nine boards and he now has 475 rebounds, 25 shy of 500.

LSU In Early SEC Team Stats

Entering the week, LSU was seventh in the league in scoring offense at 75.2 points per game, as documented the leader in free throw percentage (78.2%), but 10th in field goal percentage at 40.4 percent. The Tigers are ninth in rebounds at 37.5 percent, but third in offensive rebounds at 15.5 a game ... The Tigers are sixth in the

Glen Davis, Boston Celtics – free agent after four seasons in Boston
Chris Johnson, Portland Trailblazers – finished with Portland (10-day contracts)
Anthony Randolph, Minnesota – entering his fourth season in the NBA
Tyrus Thomas, Charlotte – entering 2nd full season with Charlotte, 6th in NBA
Marcus Thornton, Sacramento – free agent, traded in mid-season from New Orleans
Garrett Temple, Charlotte Bobcats – Has signed 1-year deal with Casale in Italy.

The Standings Will Look Different This Year In The SEC

For the first time since the 1991-92 season, the Southeastern Conference men's basketball standings will not be divided into Eastern and Western Divisions. The coaches voted and the athletic directors approved the move back to a league standing sheet that goes 1-12, top to bottom with the top four teams in the standings getting byes on the first night of the SEC Tournament. In the past, the top two teams in each division received the byes.

The 16-game schedule for this year is still based on divisional play of past years, home and home against the west teams and one game against the east, but the schedule for next year is still in a state of flux with new teams entering the league next year. It is expected the men's basketball teams will play some sort of 18-game conference schedule next year.

Tournament Goes Back To New Orleans

For the third time, the Southeastern Conference Tournament will be held in New Orleans, March 8-11, 2012 ... The tournament was previously held in 1996 and 2003 in New Orleans at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome, but this year's event will be held at the home of the New Orleans Hornets, the New Orleans Arena ... The winner of the event receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Tigers Sign Malik Morgan In Early Signing Period

The LSU Athletics Department and men's basketball Coach Trent Johnson announced on last Wednesday that the school has received the signed national letter of intent papers from highly-ranked guard Malik Morgan from River Ridge, La. Morgan, who is 6-3, is entering his senior season at John Curtis High School.

Morgan has garnered national recognition from the recruiting sites, ranking No. 75 overall in The Rivals 150 for the class of 2012. The four-star prospect is also ranked 11th in the country at the shooting guard position.

This past year Morgan averaged 28.9 points a game, including a career-high 52 points in one game against Riverside. He also averaged nine rebounds, two steals and two assists a game.

"We are very excited about the addition of Malik Morgan to the LSU Basketball family," said LSU Coach Trent Johnson. "Besides coming from a great family, Malik is a very, very good basketball player. He is very skilled -- not a good scorer, but a great scorer. One of the most impressive things about Malik besides his offensive skills and his ability to make players better, is his overall competitiveness. He is very competitive and he is going to have a huge impact on our team next year. Without question, I didn't see a better guard in the state of Louisiana, let alone his rankings as one of the best guards in the country."

Morgan's mother, the former Detra Brown, was a four-year letter-winner in volleyball while at LSU where she was twice an All-SEC selection. She still ranks fourth at LSU in career kills (1,504) and is one of only five players in the program's history to ever record 1,000 digs and 1,000 kills in a career.

Morgan chose LSU over Boston College, Georgia Tech, Missouri, Oklahoma and UTEP.
