• LSU and Ole Miss are meeting for the 201st time Saturday with LSU leading 116-84 ... Ole Miss has won the last four games over the past two seasons ... LSU is 74-29 in Baton Rouge.

• LSU's six offensive boards vs. UVA was its lowest total of the year for a team that is averaging a league best 14.4 a game ... Justin Hamilton is second in the league in offensive rebounds at 3.7 a contest.

• In the last 4 games, point guard Anthony Hickey has had 14 assists and 6 TOs and backup point guard Chris Bass has posted 11 assists and 7 TOs ... Bass is well on his way to having a positive assist-turnover ratio all four years of his career.

Trent Johnson

Head Coach • 4th year at LSU (13th year as head coach)

Trent Johnson, with two strong back-to-back recruiting classes on board, enters his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU Tigers in 2011-12.

Johnson's passion and vision for the LSU basketball program has the Tigers headed in the right direction.

As Johnson and his staff continue to develop players both on the court and off the court, they expected continued improvement athletically, academically and socially from the team.

Johnson, the 20th men's basketball coach at LSU, seeks to build on more than a decade of excellence at LSU, Stanford and Nevada. Having earned Conference Coach of the Year in all three leagues (Western Athletic Conference, Pac-10 and Southeastern Conference), Johnson knows the route to success to getting LSU back in the national spotlight.

In his first season at LSU, Johnson led the Tigers to 27 wins, tied for the third most wins in a season in LSU history. The Tigers won the SEC regular season championship with a record of 13-3. LSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006, advancing to the second round before falling, 84-70, to North Carolina in the closest game the eventual national champions would have to play. LSU had a second half lead on the Tar Heels and the game was still in the balance entering the final eight minutes.

Coach Johnson has a blueprint for success for himself and his players. As his players grasp the vision for success, they have the opportunity to embrace playing in a fast-paced system where executing in the half court and defending and rebounding are at a high level.

Johnson has a record of success and his team will have the opportunity to blend together and learn from a coach that is a fierce competitor who exudes and demands toughness.

His devotion to the team, his protective beliefs toward his players and his loyalty to his former players is evidenced by the fact that three of his former players are now members of the LSU basketball staff. Johnson is a program builder and he has re-established the base of the LSU program by visiting with former players and coaches to bring together the past, the present and the future of the program.

Johnson also is charged with the development of athletes both on and off the court. Off the court, he has worked hard since day one to make sure student-athletes understand the "student" part of their days at LSU. At all three stops in his head coaching career, he has developed not just successful athletes and winning basketball teams, but young men who are having success in life.

In his 13 years combined as a Division I head coach at LSU, Stanford and Nevada, he has won 208 games and taken teams in seven-of-the-last-nine seasons to post-season play, including five NCAA appearances.

Johnson was named the 2009 consensus SEC Coach of the Year and was a finalist for four national coach of the year honors as he became the first LSU men's basketball coach to win the league title and take the team to post-season play in his first year at the school.

Johnson has always been a big believer in special causes and joined former LSU basketball coach Dale Brown and star center Shaquille O'Neal in cutting a series of commercials that aired nationally for the "Be A Match" organization of bone marrow donors.

In June 2010, Johnson was part of a 10-day trip to Africa as part of the Nkomazi Sports Club Organization program that was established to stop the transmission of HIV through culturally relevant, locally sustainable health and life skills education-based programs in communities affected by HIV/AIDS.

He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and has served on the NABC Special Committee on Recruiting and Access. He also gives his time freely to such organizations as the Boy Scouts of America, the Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc., the American Diabestes Association, Samaritan's Feet, Troops First and the Jimmy V Foundation for cancer research.

Johnson, was born in Berkeley, Calif., and is married to Jackie and they have two children: a daughter, Tinishia, 28, and a son, Terry, 25.

Johnson's vision and passion is what drives him to make LSU basketball a success. With a coaching staff and a group of players that believe in the same vision and passion, that success has to be very much in sight.

The Virginia Cavaliers ended LSU's seven-game winning streak, making some key baskets down the stretch in what lived up to pre-game billing as a defensive struggle. Tied at 26-26 at the half, LSU was able to move to a five-point, 42-37, lead with 11:02 to play before the game was tied for the ninth and final time at the 7:52 mark at 44-44. Virginia hits a three to go up 51-47, but Anthony Hickey comes back with a trey for LSU to make it 51-50 with 2:08 left. After a missed Virginia shot, the Cavaliers got the rebound and put home another trey to get what would essentially be the winning points at 54-50 with 1:30 left ... In the final 19 seconds, LSU would have the ball down three and got an open look at the top of the key that fails to fall and Virginia adds free throws for the final margin.

Justin Hamilton was the only player in double figures with 21 points, his career high, hitting 9-of-14 field goal attempts with four blocks and two steals in 36 minutes ... Andre Stringer made his return to the LSU lineup, playing 24 minutes and scoring eight points

with two treys.

The Tigers shot 43.8 percent from the field, but just 5-of-18 from the arc (27.8 percent), compared to 6-of-10 for the Cavaliers ... LSU was out rebounded 32-26 as LSU had its fewest offensive rebounds (6) of the season as Virginia had 14 second chance points compared to just eight for LSU.

The Most Important 16 Games Begin Saturday

While LSU's 10-4 record has come with half of those wins either on the road or neutral courts and LSU is one win away from equaling the win total of each of the past two seasons, what begins Saturday is the most important part of the year as LSU's final 16 games are part of Southeastern Conference play.

Plus it's a new day in the league as for the first time since the 1990-91 season, the teams will not play in divisions with standings listing the teams in a 1-12 fashion. The coaches voted and the athletic directors approved the move back to a league standing sheet that goes 1-12, top to bottom with the top four teams in the standings getting byes on the first night of the SEC Tournament. In the past, the top two teams in each division received the byes.

The 16-game schedule for this year is still based on divisional play of past years, home and home against the west teams and one game against the east, but the schedule for next year is still in a state of flux with new teams entering the league. It is assumed the men's basketball teams will play some sort of 18-game conference schedule next year.

SEC Openers

LSU is 43-35 in SEC openers in its long standing as a charter member of the Southeastern Conference ... Last year, LSU stormed out to a 32-6 halftime advantage at Auburn and won 62-55 ... It was LSU's first opening day league win since defeating Arkansas, 63-58, at Arkansas on Jan. 11, 2006 ... LSU's last SEC opening win at home came in 2000 when LSU defeated Alabama, 78-66, to open league play.

Schedule Doesn't Start Easy For Tigers

The SEC schedule makers didn't do any favors for LSU with four road games in the first six league games, including at three of the favorites for possible bye spots in the SEC Tournament in March ... After the Ole Miss game on Saturday, the Tigers go to Alabama (Jan. 11) then Arkansas (Jan. 14) ... After a home game on the 17th against Auburn, LSU must then go to Florida (Jan. 21) and at Mississippi State (Jan. 28).

The Offensive Numbers Are Consistent

In the last five games of LSU's seven game winning streak, the offensive scoring numbers were consistent, with LSU posting point totals of 64, 66, 67, 67 and 69 ... Despite scoring just 52 in the Virginia game, LSU is averaging 67.9 points a game while holding opponents to 60.1 points ... The scoring margin of plus 7.7 at this point of the season is a stark contrast to the last two years when LSU averaged just 62.2 in 2011 and 61.5 in 2010, with a scoring margin of minus 4.4 in 2011 and minus 4.9 in 2010.

LSU is eighth in the SEC in scoring, but third in the league in scoring defense.

It's The "D" Word

The "D" word is definitely "Defense" as LSU has held its last eight opponents under 60 points, winning all but the last game against Virginia:

53 team from Jan. 16 to Feb. 14 held seven consecutive teams under 60.

In that streak of seven games, LSU won three times on the road (at Houston, at Rutgers and at North Texas) and four in the Maravich Center (Boise State, UC Irvine, Marquette and Grambling).

LSU is 30-5 in the Trent Johnson era when holding teams under 60 points.

Nine of LSU's wins have come when they have held teams under 60 points.

10 Wins After Undefeated December

LSU was undefeated in the month of December for the first time since going 7-0 in the 2002-03 season ... LSU's 10 wins entering the new year was the most for an LSU team since the 2008-09 team (Coach Johnson's first at LSU) had 11 wins by New Year's Day ... The 2006-07 team had 10 wins and the 1999-2000 team was 12-0 at the end of December.

Season 41 At The PMAC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU is trying to get its home court advantage back this season at the Maravich Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers are now 5-2 entering the final eight SEC home games ... Overall, LSU is 466-166 in the building (73.8 percent) and 214-128 (62.6 percent) in SEC home games ... Trent Johnson is 10-14 in his first three years in home SEC games.

Wins On The Road

LSU has a 3-1 record on the road this season, the first time LSU has won three times on a road court in the continental United States in non-conference play since the 1985-86 season when LSU was able to defeat Washington, Lamar and Texas.

In the road wins at Houston (59-58), Rutgers (55-50) and North Texas (67-58), LSU had to come from behind in each contest ... The Tigers defeated Houston after the Cougars scored with 9.1 seconds left to take a 58-57 lead ... Anthony Hickey drove the lane, missed a contested layup, and then senior Storm Warren grabbed the rebound with 1.2 seconds left. Warren hit both free throws for the LSU win.

Against Rutgers, LSU was down five with 7:01 to play and allowed just two Rutgers points the rest of the way ... Those points came after LSU had taken a 49-48 lead on a Hickey jumper with 1:20 to play ... Rutgers made two free throws to take a 50-49 lead 15 seconds later, but Hickey got inside and one game after having his layup attempt knocked away, drove back inside and scored to give LSU the lead for good, 51-50. Rutgers would turn the ball over on a charge and on the inbounds, Hickey found Johnny O'Bryant for a dunk with 12 seconds left to make it a three-point game.

Those two road wins marked the first time LSU had won consecutive road games since February of the 2008-09 season when LSU beat Arkansas and Kentucky. The last time LSU won two road games in the same week period and back-to-back on the schedule came in Feb. 2006 when LSU defeated Auburn on Feb. 18, 2006 and then Vanderbilt on Feb. 22, 2006.

Against North Texas (12/22), LSU was tied at the half and used a 10-0 run to get the lead for good and held the lead throughout the second half to get the 67-58 win.

LSU had three road wins all last year on opponent's courts - at South Alabama, at Auburn and at Mississippi State ... Trent Johnson is now 12-21 on opponent's home courts ... Overall, LSU is 406-578 (41.2%) on the road in its history ... With the three neutral court games in Charleston, LSU is 5-2 this year away from the Maravich Center in non-conference play

Turner Dec. 26 SEC Player of the Week; First Since March 2009

The Southeastern Conference selected sophomore guard Ralston Turner as its Player of the Week (12/26) ... It marked the first time an LSU player was named Player of the Week by the league since March 2009 ... Turner helped LSU to wins at home against previously undefeated 10th-ranked Marquette 67-59 (Dec. 19) and then at North Texas (Dec. 22) ... Highlighting the week, Turner had the second highest scoring game of his career in the win over Marquette, hitting 4-of-5 shots from the arc, scoring 22 points against the Golden Eagles.

Turner is averaging 9.9 points per game and 2.5 rebounds ... He has made 25 treys (37.9 percent) and has made 22-of-26 free throws for the season

Ole Miss Information

The Rebels enter SEC play also at 10-4 on the year after a 50-48 win at home on Tuesday night which stopped a three-game Ole Miss losing streak ... The Rebels are 2-2 away from Oxford, with wins at DePaul (70-68), Penn State (72-70) and losses at Southern Miss (82-86) and Dayton (50-62) ... Both Dundrecous Nelson and Terrance Henry are averaging 11.6 points per game, while Jarvis Summers is at 10.2 points per game ... Against SMU, the Rebels had a 28-21 halftime lead before SMU tried to rally in the second half ... Henry led Ole Miss with 13 points ... Reginald Buckner had 11 rebounds to lead the Rebels ... Ole Miss shot 34.1 percent (15-44) overall and 6-of-23 from the arc.

Andy Kennedy is in his sixth year as the head coach at Ole Miss, his seventh total as a head coach which includes one year at Cincinnati ... Kennedy is 115-68 at Ole Miss.

The Students Said It; All Vests Have Wins

It started as a chant and now it's a hash tag on Twitter but as Coach Johnson was being interviewed on Cox Sports TV after the Boise game (12/10), the Maravich Maniacs began chanting, "Fear The Vest!" ... So far the Tigers have won three times with the coaches wearing purple, three also with white, twice with black, once each with brown and grey ... It's not a fashion statement or a trend that Coach Johnson and his staff are trying to make to the rest of the league, just a comfort statement and who can argue with that.

Depth Returns to LSU Basketball

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years - depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster ... Another difference for this year's team is that it has allowed players to play their natural position.

Plus, the importance of depth may have shown more than ever in the Boise game (12/10) when one starter at off-guard and another top reserve guard did not dress for the contest. But LSU was able to attack the game from a bit of a different direction and was able to sustain its defense in the process.

The other main benefit of having depth this year is that LSU has been able to sustain most of the games through the entire 40 minutes, something that LSU was unable to do a year ago.

Through 14 games, there is a remarkable balance in the scoring of the team with freshman having scored 28.5 percent of the points and sophomores 28.9 percent ... The other two classes are also contributing with the juniors having scored 22.6 percent of the points and the senior threesome 19.9 percent ... Consider the seniors are contributing almost 20 percent with three players that are primarily coming off the bench at this time of the year.

Freshmen have led LSU in scoring three times (Hickey 2, O'Bryant III 1), sophomores six times (Stringer 3, Turner 2, Courtney 1), junior four times (Hamilton) and a senior once (Warren).

One of the aspects that has been important for this team is everyone appears to know their roles and has accepted those roles in the team concepts ... It was those three seniors (Warren, White and Bass) that came off the bench with LSU down 13-0 to Marquette (12/19) who came in and slowly began the march back that led LSU to the win ... It was the four post players at North Texas (12/22) who were all in double figures (Warren, White, O'Bryant, Hamilton) that played a big part in that win ... Coach Johnson has substituted four and even five players at a time against some teams.

Stringer Back

Andre Stringer, who missed five games after fainting in practice prior to the Boise State game (12/10), returned and played 24 minutes against Virginia (1/2) and the sophomore had a good effort as he tried to get back in the swing of playing after resuming practice on Dec. 26 ... He had eight points with two treys, shooting 3-of-8 from the field ... Stringer has had a good statistical year moving from point guard as a freshman to off guard this season ... He is averaging 11.7 points per game, averaging 31.4 minutes per game ... He is shooting 32-of-77 from the field and has made 19-of-47 treys (40.4 percent) ... Last year, Stringer averaged 11.2 points per game and 2.6 assists, hitting 57 treys

Ludwig Stepped In

It was Eddie Ludwig, the junior from Metairie, who had to step into the Andre Stringer position in the starting five ... For the game against Boise State (12/10) he responded with a big time effort of 33 minutes ... While he only scored two points, he did have a career high of nine rebounds, an assist and a block and was part of the defensive effort against leading Boise scorer Anthony Drmic, who came in averaging 15 points a game and was held scoreless.

Against UCI (12/15), Ludwig came through as a scorer, equaling his career high of 12 points in 24 minutes ... In those two games, Ludwig played 57 minutes, was 5-of-11 from the field, 2-of-7 from the arc, 2-2 FT, 14 reb, 2 assists, 2 blocks and 14 points ... For the season, Ludwig is averaging 2.5 points and 2.5 rebounds.

It may again be Ludwig who will have to move back to the "4" position if needed with O'Bryant and White both out of this contest.

Hickey All-Tournament At Charleston

LSU finished the Nov. 17-20 Charleston Classic with a 2-1 record as LSU defeated Western Kentucky, 76-57, and Georgia Tech, 59-50, after an 88-82 first-round loss versus Northwestern. In the process, point guard Anthony Hickey was named to the five-member all-tournament team after averaging 16 points for the three games, hitting over 51 percent of his field goal attempts (19-of-37), making six treys and averaging 4.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

After getting 17 against Western Kentucky, Hickey clinched the spot in the fifth place game against Georgia Tech ... Hickey had 20 points, including four treys. LSU led by four at the half and the game remained close until LSU went on a 9-4 run in which Hickey, Ralston Turner and Andre Stringer all hit threes to put LSU up for good.

Good Start For Mr. Basketball, McDonald's All-American

High school honors are one thing, but having high school stars that are able to make the transition to a game where the pace is faster and more is required more often is a key to success.

Kentucky's Mr. Basketball, Anthony Hickey, and McDonald's All-American Johnny O'Bryant III have certainly made a good overall impression in their first 12 games at LSU.

Hickey's All-Tournament performance in the Charleston Classic has been documented above, but since the tournament he has been distributing the ball well to his teammates - South Alabama - 6 assists; Rutgers - 5 assists; Boise State - 5 assists, Marquette - 6 assists, Grambling - 5 assists.

Against Rutgers (12/3), he only scored seven points but had two buckets and an assist in the final 1:20 that helped LSU win the game ... He also had just one turnover in 34 minutes ... Hickey is tied for sixth in the league in assists average (3.9) and the leader in steals at 2.5 a game ... He is tied for fourth in the SEC in assist-turnover ratio at 1.9 a game (55 assists-29 turnovers) ... Hickey is fourth on the team in scoring at 8.8 points per game.

In one three game stretch (UCI, Marquette, N. Texas), Hickey had four steals in each game.

O'Bryant III came up big in the Northwestern game (11/17) when he hit 6-of-8 field goal attempts in 22 minutes and made 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a 21 point effort. O'Bryant III also had a team high eight boards.

Against South Alabama (11/23), O'Bryant III led the team in rebounds for the second time this season with eight ... He started his first college game against Houston and tied for team rebound lead with seven, five of which were offensive ... He posted 11 points at Rutgers (12/3) and 10 points in the Boise State game (12/10) ... Just like the Houston game, O'Bryant had seven boards against UCI (12/15), but five were offensive ... He recorded his first college double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds at North Texas (12/22) ... He is averaging 7.9 ppg and 6.2 rebounds ... He is the third leading freshman rebounder in the league.

Hamilton Showing Ability

The junior transfer big man has shown one thing in the 14 non-conference games - the one year layoff after coming from Iowa State was not detrimental to the center.

Monday versus Virginia (1/2), Hamilton played a season high 36 minutes and made 9-of-14 field goals with a season best four blocks for 21 points and nine rebounds ... Hamilton has been in double figures in 10 of 14 games, including five of the last six ... For the season, Hamilton is hitting 64-of-125 field goals (51.2%) and 44-of-58 at the line (75.9 percent) ... He is averaging 12.3 points and 6.9 rebounds ... Those numbers rank 21st in points and 11th in rebounds in the SEC.

The transfer from Iowa State had double figures in two of his three games in the Charleston Classic, highlighted by 18 against Western Kentucky ... Hamilton had 18 points on 5-of-10 shooting and 8-of-8 at the free throw line and nine rebounds ... Hamilton had his first LSU double double of the season against UCI (12/15) with 14 points and 11 rebounds.

Warren Milestones - Gets His 500th Rebound

LSU senior Storm Warren continued putting special notes on his career and the most prominent came with 14:15 to go in the first half when he pulled down the first of his six rebounds against Grambling (12/29) to make him the 37th LSU player to have 500 career rebounds ... Against Boise State (12/10), he blocked the 100th shot of his career ... He became the eighth player and first since Garrett Temple in 2009 to reach triple figures in blocks ... He also in the month of December became the 22nd LSU player to record 100 career steals.

Warren is averaging 8.0 points and 4.9 rebounds in 18.6 minutes per game.

Chris Bass - Off The Bench To The Point

Senior Chris Bass, the brother of NBA star and former SEC Player of the Year Brandon Bass, has been using his minutes very well to help LSU when he goes in either in place of or with Anthony Hickey in the LSU offense ... Bass, who has had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio each of his first three seasons, is 24 assists and 12 turnovers this year, including 20 assists and seven turnovers in the last six games ... Bass is averaging 13.3 minutes per game ... The Baton Rouge native doesn't shoot often, but he is 9-of-17 from the field this year.

Free Throw Shooting

LSU remains second in the league at 70.9 percent (178-251) behind only Tennessee's 71.2 percent ... LSU led the league for much of the first six weeks of the season.

Storm Warren showed the team's ability late at the free throw line by making the two charity tosses with 1.2 seconds left to win the game at Houston (11/29) ... Warren was a 51.5 percent free throw shooter a year ago (17-33), but this year he has already made 22 free throws in 30 attempts (73.3 percent).

One of the things with Andre Stringer getting back is having his free throw shooting back as he is now 22-of-25 (88.0 percent) ... Ralston Turner is at 84.6 percent (22-26) and Justin Hamilton 75.9 percent (44-of-58).

Last season LSU made 66.5 percent of its free throws (432-650), the second consecutive season LSU was below 70 percent.

50 Percent or Better

LSU topped 50 percent from the field against both Boise and Marquette and for the Trent Johnson years at LSU, the Tigers are 12-0 when they shoot 50 percent from the floor.

While LSU overall through 14 games is 12th in the league in shooting percentage at 40.7 percent, the LSU defense has allowed the Tigers to still have success, holding opponents to 38.8 percent (4th in SEC) ... The Tigers are seventh in three-point percentage (33.9 percent) but third in three-point field goal percentage defense (30.6 percent).

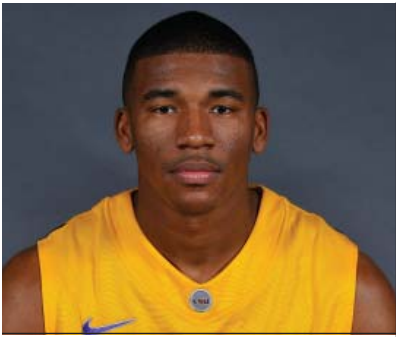
