**C 41 Justin Hamilton (Jr., 7-0, Alpine, Utah) 13.0 ppg, 7.5 rpg, 1.5 bpg**  
Iowa State transfer ... 23 pts-16 reb vs. Ole Miss (1/7) ... In last two games, 44 pts-25 rebs ... Two double doubles ... Shooting 53.3% from field (73-137) and 76.6% (49-64) from line ... 11 games double figures ... 16th in league in scoring; 8th in rebounds, 9th in FT shooting, 7th in blocks, 2nd in offensive rebounds (3.9).

### STORYLINES

• LSU has now held 11 opponents under 60 points this season, winning 10 of those games ... LSU won seven straight of those games while holding opponents under 60, equaling the streak of seven set Jan. 16-Feb. 14, 1953.

\* The 26-point win by LSU equaled the most in a conference opener since a similar 26-point win over Florida to open the 1980-81 season.

\* Justin Hamilton had 23 points and 16 rebounds in the game, the first time an LSU player had 20 points and

15 rebounds since Tasmin Mitchell had 24 points and 18 rebounds against Southeastern La. on Dec. 14, 2009.

\* With Hamilton and Storm Warren both with double doubles it marked the first time for two players to have double ups in the same game since Warren and Malcolm White did it versus UT-Martin on Nov. 18, 2010.

• Alabama leads the overall series, 100-66, with Alabama having won the last four games ... LSU has won four games in Baton Rouge in the last 14 meetings with LSU's last win at

Coleman, a 60-54 decision (1-31-04).

• LSU had 20 offensive boards against Ole Miss, the fifth time LSU has had either 19 of 20 off. boards this season ... Tigers lead the SEC in offensive rebounds average at 14.7 a game ... Hamilton is second in the league at a 3.9 average.

• Freshman Anthony Hickey hit 4-of-5 treys and had 7 assists and no turnovers in the Ole Miss win ... Hickey has 62 assists and just 29 turnovers this year ... The 7 assists tied for the best on opening day in the SEC.

# Trent Johnson

Head Coach • 4th year at LSU (13th year as head coach)

Trent Johnson, with two strong back-to-back recruiting classes on board, enters his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU Tigers in 2011-12.

Johnson's passion and vision for the LSU basketball program has the Tigers headed in the right direction.

As Johnson and his staff continue to develop players both on the court and off the court, they expected continued improvement athletically, academically and socially from the team.

Johnson, the 20th men's basketball coach at LSU, seeks to build on more than a decade of excellence at LSU, Stanford and Nevada. Having earned Conference Coach of the Year in all three leagues (Western Athletic Conference, Pac-10 and Southeastern Conference), Johnson knows the route to success to getting LSU back in the national spotlight.

In his first season at LSU, Johnson led the Tigers to 27 wins, tied for the third most wins in a season in LSU history. The Tigers won the SEC regular season championship with a record of 13-3. LSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006, advancing to the second round before falling, 84-70, to North Carolina in the closest game the eventual national champions would have to play. LSU had a second half lead on the Tar Heels and the game was still in the balance entering the final eight minutes.

Coach Johnson has a blueprint for success for himself and his players. As his players grasp the vision for success, they have the opportunity to embrace playing in a fast-paced system where executing in the half court and defending and rebounding are at a high level.

Johnson has a record of success and his team will have the opportunity to blend together and learn from a coach that is a fierce competitor who exudes and demands toughness.

His devotion to the team, his protective beliefs toward his players and his loyalty to his former players is evidenced by the fact that three of his former players are now members of the LSU basketball staff. Johnson is a program builder and he has re-established the base of the LSU program by visiting with former players and coaches to bring together the past, the present and the future of the program.

Johnson also is charged with the development of athletes both on and off the court. Off the court, he has worked hard since day one to make sure student-athletes understand the "student" part of their days at LSU. At all three stops in his head coaching career, he has developed not just successful athletes and winning basketball teams, but young men who are having success in life.

In his 13 years combined as a Division I head coach at LSU, Stanford and Nevada, he has won 208 games and taken teams in seven-of-the-last-nine seasons to post-season play, including five NCAA appearances.

Johnson was named the 2009 consensus SEC Coach of the Year and was a finalist for four national coach of the year honors as he became the first LSU men's basketball coach to win the league title and take the team to post-season play in his first year at the school.

Johnson has always been a big believer in special causes and joined former LSU basketball coach Dale Brown and star center Shaquille O'Neal in cutting a series of commercials that aired nationally for the "Be A Match" organization of bone marrow donors.

In June 2010, Johnson was part of a 10-day trip to Africa as part of the Nkomazi Sports Club Organization program that was established to stop the transmission of HIV through culturally relevant, locally sustainable health and life skills education-based programs in communities affected by HIV/AIDS.

He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and has served on the NABC Special Committee on Recruiting and Access. He also gives his time freely to such organizations as the Boy Scouts of America, the Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc., the American Diabestes Association, Samaritan's Feet, Troops First and the Jimmy V Foundation for cancer research.

Johnson, was born in Berkeley, Calif., and is married to Jackie and they have two children: a daughter, Tinishia, 28, and a son, Terry, 25.

Johnson's vision and passion is what drives him to make LSU basketball a success. With a coaching staff and a group of players that believe in the same vision and passion, that success has to be very much in sight.

### Last Time Out - LSU 81, Ole Miss 55 (Jan. 7 -- Baton Rouge)

LSU showed for the second time this year that it could respond to a bit of adversity with Johnny O'Bryant III out with a broken hand and Malcolm White out because of a death in the family ... The Tigers were able to jump out quickly on Ole Miss, opening up a double figure lead just 4:30 into the game and led by 20-plus with 8:55 to go in the first half ... The lead was 20 at the half and went to as much as 29 before LSU won by 26, 81-55 ... It was the biggest winning margin for LSU in an SEC opener since defeating Florida by 26 to open the 1980-81 SEC season ... LSU won the SEC opener for the second straight year and is now 44-35 in league openers.

Two players posted double double as Justin Hamilton posted 23 points and 16 rebounds and Storm Warren had 15 points and 11 boards ... Hamilton posted back-to-back 20-plus point games for the first time since Ralston Turner did it against McNeese



and Wichita in December 2010 ... It was also the first time LSU had posted two double doubles in the same game since Malcolm White and Warren did it against UT-Martin on November 18, 2010 ... Hamilton was the first player to go 20-15 since Tasmin Mitchell had 24 points and 18 boards vs. Southeastern on Dec. 14, 2009).

Anthony Hickey was also one of the four in double figures for LSU, hitting 4-of-5 treys, to finish with 12 points ... More importantly he had seven assists and no turnovers with three steals ... Andre Stringer, in his second game back, had 10 points.

### Hamilton Back-To-Back 20-Plus Games; SEC POW For Jan. 9

The junior transfer from Iowa State has shown no ill effects of the one-year transfer rule that kept him off the competitive court as he was over 20 points in both games last week ... Here are the numbers:

**Vs. Iowa State – 36 minutes, 9-of-14 FG, 3-6 FT, 4 blks, 2 stls, 21 points-9 rebounds**  
**Vs. Ole Miss – 29 minutes – 9-of-12 FG, 5-6 FT, 2 blks, 1 stl, 23 points-16 rebounds**  
**Totals – 65 minutes – 18-of-26 FG, 8-12 FT, 6 blks, 3 stls, 44 points-25 rebounds**

The two games, which earned him Southeastern Conference Player of the Week honors, upped his scoring average 1.4 to 13.0 points per game ... He is also averaging 7.5 rebounds a game and 1.5 blocked shots a game ... Hamilton had the first 20 point-15 rebound game for LSU in over two years (see column page 11 for recent past LSU 20-15 games).

Hamilton is hitting 53.3 percent from the floor (73-137) and 49-of-64 from the line (76.6 percent) ... He is averaging 28.1 minutes per game.

### The Most Important Games Have Begun

The most important part of the year began on Saturday with the start of the 16-game Southeastern Conference season and LSU got things going on a positive note with the win over Ole Miss at the Maravich Center.

LSU also won its 11th game of the season, equaling the 11 total wins in both the 2010 and 2011 season.

It's a new day in the league as for the first time since the 1990-91 season, the teams will not play in divisions with standings listing the teams in a 1-12 fashion. The coaches voted and the athletic directors approved the move back to a league standing sheet that goes 1-12, top to bottom with the top four teams in the standings getting byes on the first night of the SEC Tournament. In the past, the top two teams in each division received the byes.

The 16-game schedule for this year is still based on divisional play of past years, home and home against the west teams and one game against the east, but the schedule for next year is still in a state of flux with new teams entering the league. It is assumed the men's basketball teams will play some sort of 18-game conference schedule next year.

### SEC Openers

LSU is now 44-35 in SEC openers in its long standing as a charter member of the Southeastern Conference ... LSU has now won two straight on opening day, but it was LSU's first opening day win at home came in 2000 when LSU defeated Alabama, 78-66.

### Schedule Doesn't Start Easy For Tigers

The SEC schedule makers didn't do any favors for LSU with four road games in the next five league games, including at three of the pre-season favorites for possible bye spots in the SEC Tournament in March ... The Tigers go to Alabama Wednesday then to Arkansas on Saturday ... After a home game on the 17th against Auburn, LSU must then go to Florida (Jan. 21) and at Mississippi State (Jan. 25).

### Ole Miss Game was No. 2,500

Saturday's game with Ole Miss was the 2,500th game for the LSU men's basketball team since the first contest on Jan. 30, 1909 ... LSU has won 1,419 games in that time (56.7 percent) with 10 conference championships, a mythical national championship awarded in 1935 and 4 NCAA Final Fours.

### The Offensive Numbers Are Consistent

After hanging around the mid and high 60s in his wins in non-conference play, the Tigers put 81 on the board in its SEC opener against Ole Miss ... In Trent Johnson's four years at LSU, the Tigers are 19-2 when scoring more than 80 points ... Speaking of the 60s, that used to be a problem for LSU getting wins in the 60s, but this year LSU is 5-1 when scoring in the 60s and 16-16 in the Johnson years.

LSU is now averaging 68.7 points per game and for the first time, the opponents average has fallen below 60 to 59.8 points ... The scoring margin of plus 8.9 at this point of the season is a stark contrast to the last two years when LSU averaged just 62.2 in 2011 and 61.5 in 2010, with a scoring margin of minus 4.4 in 2011 and minus 4.9 in 2010.

LSU is seventh in the SEC in scoring, but third in the league in scoring defense.

### It's The "D" Word

The "D" word is definitely "Defense" as LSU has held its last nine opponents under 60 points, winning all but the game against Virginia (1/2):

It had been almost 50 years since a team of LSU basketball players held opponents under 60 points in each of seven consecutive wins as the 2010-11 team did ... The 1952-53 team from Jan. 16 to Feb. 14 held seven consecutive teams under 60.

In that streak of seven games, LSU won three times on the road (at Houston, at Rutgers and at North Texas) and four in the Maravich Center (Boise State, UC Irvine, Marquette and Grambling).

LSU is 31-5 in the Trent Johnson era when holding teams under 60 points.

A total of 10 of LSU's wins have come when they have held teams under 60 points.

### Season 41 At The PMAC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU is trying to get its home court advantage back this season at the Maravich Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers are now 6-2 with seven SEC home games ... Overall, LSU is 467-166 in the building (73.8 percent) and 215-128 (62.7 percent) in SEC home games ... Trent Johnson is 11-14 in home SEC games.

### Wins On The Road

LSU has a 3-1 record on the road this season, the first time LSU has won three times on a road court in the continental United States in non-conference play since the 1985-86 season when LSU was able to defeat Washington, Lamar and Texas.

In the road wins at Houston (59-58), Rutgers (55-50) and North Texas (67-58), LSU had to come from behind twice in the second half against Houston and Rutgers and from a halftime tie in the North Texas game ... The Tigers defeated Houston after the Cougars scored with 9.1 seconds left to take a 58-57 lead ... Anthony Hickey drove the lane, missed a contested layup, and then senior Storm Warren grabbed the rebound with 1.2 seconds left. Warren hit both free throws for the LSU win.

Against Rutgers, LSU was down five with 7:01 to play and allowed just two Rutgers points the rest of the way ... Those points came after LSU had taken a 49-48 lead on a Hickey jumper with 1:20 to play ... Rutgers made two free throws to take a 50-49 lead 15 seconds later, but Hickey got inside and one game after having his layup attempt knocked away, drove back inside and scored to give LSU the lead for good, 51-50. Rutgers would turn the ball over on a charge and on the inbounds, Hickey found Johnny O'Bryant for a dunk with 12 seconds left to make it a three-point game.

Those two road wins marked the first time LSU had won consecutive road games since February of the 2008-09 season when LSU beat Arkansas and Kentucky. The last time LSU won two road games in the same week period and back-to-back on the schedule came in Feb. 2006 when LSU defeated Auburn on Feb. 18, 2006 and then Vanderbilt on Feb. 22, 2006.

Against North Texas (12/22), LSU was tied at the half and used a 10-0 run to get the lead for good and held the lead throughout the second half to get the 67-58 win.

LSU had three road wins all last year on opponent's courts – at South Alabama, at Auburn and at Mississippi State ... Trent Johnson is now 12-21 on opponent's home courts ... Overall, LSU is 406-578 (41.2%) on the road in its history ... With the three neutral court games in Charleston, LSU is 5-2 this year away from the Maravich Center in non-conference play.

### Turner Dec. 26 SEC Player of the Week; First Since March 2009

The Southeastern Conference selected sophomore guard Ralston Turner as its Player of the Week (12/26) ... It marked the first time an LSU player was named Player of the Week by the league since March 2009 ... Turner helped LSU to wins at home against previously undefeated 10th-ranked Marquette 67-59 (Dec. 19) and then at North Texas (Dec. 22) ... Highlighting the week, Turner had the second highest scoring game of his career in the win over Marquette, hitting 4-of-5 shots from the arc, scoring 22 points against the Golden Eagles.

Turner is averaging 9.7 points per game, third on the team, and 2.5 rebounds ... He has made 26 treys (37.1 percent) and has made 23-of-27 free throws for the season (85.2 percent).

### Alabama Information

The Crimson Tide is 12-3 overall and 1-0 in the league after a 74-59 win at Georgia on Saturday ... It was Alabama's fourth straight win and fourth straight opening day win in SEC ... Freshman guard Trevor Lacey scored a career-high 19 points, while junior forward Tony Mitchell added 17 points. Guard Trevor Releford notched 12 points in the win ... Alabama shot 27-of-49 from the floor and made 6-of-17 treys with 14-of-15 at the FT line ... The Tide had a 35-20 advantage on the boards.

Alabama in its present win streak has wins over Oklahoma State (69-52), Jacksonville (72-55) and at Georgia Tech (73-48) and at Georgia (74-59).

Anthony Grant is in his third year as the head coach at Alabama after three years as head coach at Virginia Commonwealth ... He has a record of 54-30 for the Crimson Tide and 19-14 in SEC games ... His 2011 team won the SEC Western Division title and advanced to the finals of the NIT.

### The Students Said It; Vests Getting Good Reviews

It started as a chant and now it's a hash tag on Twitter but as Coach Johnson was being interviewed on Cox Sports TV after the Boise game (12/10), the Maravich Maniacs began chanting, "Fear The Vest!" ... So far the Tigers have won three times with the coaches wearing purple, three also with white, twice each with black and grey, and, once with brown ... It's not a fashion statement or a trend that Coach Johnson and his staff are trying to make to the rest of the league, just as Coach Johnson has often said, a comfort statement and who can argue with that.

### Depth Back; Contributions Coming From All Classes

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years – depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster ... Another difference for this year's team is that it has allowed players to play their natural position.

Plus, the importance of depth may have shown more than ever in the Boise game (12/10) when one starter at off-guard and another top reserve guard did not dress for the contest. But LSU was able to attack the game from a bit of a different direction and was able to sustain its defense in the process.

Again against Ole Miss (1/7), two forwards were out (one with injury, another bereavement), but LSU responded with strong performances on the perimeter and inside to easily win its conference opener.

The other main benefit of having depth this year is that LSU has been able to sustain most of the games through the entire 40 minutes, something that LSU was unable

to do in the past couple of years.

Through 15 games, there is a remarkable balance in the scoring of the team with freshman having scored 28.0 percent of the points and sophomores 28.5 percent ... The other two classes are also contributing with the juniors having scored 23.3 percent of the points and the senior threesome 20.2 percent ... Consider the seniors are contributing 20 percent with two players primarily coming off the bench and at times before the O'Bryant injury, all three coming off the bench.

Freshmen have led LSU in scoring three times (Hickey 2, O'Bryant III 1), sophomores six times (Stringer 3, Turner 2, Courtney 1), junior five times (Hamilton) and a senior once (Warren).

One of the aspects that has been important for this team is everyone appears to know their roles and has accepted those roles in the team concepts ... It was those three seniors (Warren, White and Bass) that came off the bench with LSU down 13-0 to Marquette (12/19) who came in and slowly began the march back that led LSU to the win ... It was the four post players at North Texas (12/22) who were all in double figures (Warren, White, O'Bryant, Hamilton) that played a big part in that win ... Coach Johnson has substituted four and even five players at a time against some teams.

### Stringer Back

Andre Stringer, who missed five games after fainting in practice prior to the Boise State game (12/10), returned and played 24 minutes against Virginia (1/2) and the sophomore had a good effort as he tried to get back in the swing of playing after resuming practice on Dec. 26 ... He had eight points with two treys, shooting 3-of-8 from the field ... Against Ole Miss (1/7), he played 28 minutes and had 10 points and five assists with one turnover ... Stringer has had a good statistical year moving from point guard as a freshman to off guard this season ... He is averaging 11.5 points per game while playing 31.1 minutes per game ... He is shooting 35-of-88 from the field and has made 20-of-49 treys (40.8 percent) ... Last year, Stringer averaged 11.2 points per game and 2.6 assists, hitting 57 treys (29.5%) and 77.2 percent from the line (98-of-127).

### Ludwig Stepped In

It was Eddie Ludwig, the junior from Metairie, who had to step into the Andre Stringer position in the starting five ... For the game against Boise State (12/10) he responded with a big time effort of 33 minutes ... While he only scored two points, he did have a career high of nine rebounds, an assist and a block and was part of the defensive effort against leading Boise scorer Anthony Drmic, who came in averaging 15 points a game and was held scoreless.

Against UCI (12/15), Ludwig came through as a scorer, equaling his career high of 12 points in 24 minutes ... In those two games, Ludwig played 57 minutes, was 5-of-11 from the field, 2-of-7 from the arc, 2-2 FT, 14 reb, 2 assists, 2 blocks and 14 points ... For the season, Ludwig is averaging 2.4 points and 2.6 rebounds.

It may again be Ludwig who will have to move back to the "4" position if needed with O'Bryant and White both out of this contest.

### Hickey All-Tournament At Charleston

LSU finished the Nov. 17-20 Charleston Classic with a 2-1 record as LSU defeated Western Kentucky, 76-57, and Georgia Tech, 59-50, after an 88-82 first-round loss versus Northwestern. In the process, point guard Anthony Hickey was named to the five-member all-tournament team after averaging 16 points for the three games, hitting over 51 percent of his field goal attempts (19-of-37), making six treys and averaging 4.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

After getting 17 against Western Kentucky, Hickey clinched the spot in the fifth place game against Georgia Tech ... Hickey had 20 points, including four treys. LSU led by four at the half and the game remained close until LSU went on a 9-4 run in which Hickey, Ralston Turner and Andre Stringer all hit threes to put LSU up for good.

### Good Start For Mr. Basketball, McDonald's All-American

High school honors are one thing, but having high school stars that are able to make the transition to a game where the pace is faster and more is required more often is a key to success.

Kentucky's Mr. Basketball, Anthony Hickey, and McDonald's All-American Johnny



O'Bryant III have certainly made a good overall impression.

Hickey's All-Tournament performance in the Charleston Classic has been documented above, but since the tournament he has been distributing the ball well to his teammates – South Alabama – 6 assists; Rutgers – 5 assists; Boise State – 5 assists, Marquette – 6 assists, Grambling – 5 assists; and most recently, Ole Miss – 7 assists, no turnovers..

Against Rutgers (12/3), he only scored seven points but had two buckets and an assist in the final 1:20 that helped LSU win the game ... He also had just one turnover in 34 minutes ... Hickey is tied for fifth in the league in assists average (4.1) and the leader in steals at 2.5 a game ... He is second in the SEC in assist-turnover ratio at 2.1 a game (62 assists-29 turnovers) ... Hickey is fourth on the team in scoring at 9.0 points per game.

Before breaking his hand, O'Bryant III came up big earlier in Charleston Classic in the Northwestern game (11/17) when he hit 6-of-8 field goal attempts in 22 minutes and made 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a 21 point effort. O'Bryant III also had a team high eight boards.

Against South Alabama (11/23), O'Bryant III led the team in rebounds for the second time this season with eight ... He started his first college game against Houston and tied for team rebound lead with seven, five of which were offensive ... He posted 11 points at Rutgers (12/3) and 10 points in the Boise State game (12/10) ... Just like the Houston game, O'Bryant had seven boards against UCI (12/15), but five were offensive ... He recorded his first college double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds at North Texas (12/22) ... He is averaging 7.9 ppg and 6.2 rebounds ... He is the third leading freshman rebounder in the league and 15th overall.

### Warren Milestones – Ups Double Double Total

Warren, who moved back into the starting lineup for O'Bryant on Saturday against Ole Miss (1/7), had a double double in the win, although it was slightly overshadowed by the performance of Justin Anderson ... But Warren's double double was just as important as he had 15 points and 11 rebounds (six offensive) ... While it was his first of the year, but it was his 12th of his LSU career.

LSU senior Storm Warren continued putting special notes on his career and the most prominent came with 14:15 to go in the first half when he pulled down the first of his six rebounds against Grambling (12/29) to make him the 37th LSU player to have 500 career rebounds ... Against Boise State (12/10), he blocked the 100th shot of his career ... He became the eighth player and first since Garrett Temple in 2009 to reach triple figures in blocks ... He also in the month of December became the 22nd LSU player to record 100 career steals.

Among active players in the league in career totals, Warren ranks 15th with 777 points, 5th in rebounds with 521 and 4th in blocks at 101.

Warren is averaging 8.5 points and 5.3 rebounds in 19.5 minutes of playing time.

### Chris Bass – Off The Bench To The Point

Senior Chris Bass, the brother of NBA star and former SEC Player of the Year Brandon Bass, has been using his minutes very well to help LSU when he goes in either in place of/or with Anthony Hickey in the LSU offense ... Bass, who has had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio each of his first three seasons, is well on his way to making it four straight years with 26 assists and 12 turnovers this year ... Plus, while never thought of as a scoring threat, he is coming up this year with good decisions and a score or two in several consecutive games for the Tigers ... Bass is averaging 13.3 minutes per game ... The Baton Rouge native is 11-of-20 from the field this year, averaging 2.1 points per game.

### Free Throw Shooting

LSU remains second in the league at 71.1 percent (194-273) behind only Alabama's 71.7 percent ... LSU led the league for much of the first six weeks of the season.

Storm Warren showed the team's ability late at the free throw line by making the two charity tosses with 1.2 seconds left to win the game at Houston (11/29) ... Warren was a 51.5 percent free throw shooter a year ago (17-33), but this year he has already made 23 free throws in 32 attempts (71.9 percent).
