LSU Faces Familiar Foe Auburn in Home and SEC Opener

One week after facing Auburn in the Cancun Classic, the LSU gymnastics team will see Auburn again as both sets of Tigers will compete in Baton Rouge on Friday. LSU will look to rebound as the Tigers placed fifth out of five teams at the Cancun Classic with a 192.500 while Auburn finished third with a 194.775. LSU's young squad will compete inside the friendly confines of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center for the first time in 2012, and the Tigers will try to use the "home mat" advantage in the rematch with Auburn. Two Tigers will square off for the all-around crown as well. Auburn's Petrina Yokay finished second last week with a 39.200 while Rheagan Courville was third at 39.175. The meet will begin at 7 p.m. CT in the Maravich Center, and live video is available with a Geaux Zone account by logging on to www.LSUsports.net/live.

STORYLINES

• LSU faces rival Auburn for the second straight week and enters the meet with a 63-13 series advantage against Auburn.

• LSU's 192.500 was the lowest team score for the Tigers since Jan. 18, 1998 when LSU scored a 189.050 at the Shakespeare's Festival in

Columbia, Mo.

• Fourteen of the 24 routines were performed by freshmen in Cancun while a staggering 22 of 24 routines were performed by either freshmen or sophomores.

• Rheagan Courville's 39.175 is the highest all-around score by a freshman in a season opener in LSU history.

• Lloimincia Hall posted the first 9.90 score of her career and for the Tigers this season. Can she win her first individual title vs. Auburn?

NOTEBOOK

Last Time Out

- LSU started strong at the Cancun Classic with a 49.200 on vault and struggled after the bye before bars with a 47.975 on bars and a 46.525 on beam. The Tigers rallied for a 48.800 on floor and settled for a 192.500 total, the lowest team score since 1998.
- Despite the team struggles, freshman Rheagan Courville put together a solid meet with freshman season-opening record 39.175 in the all-around, highlighted by a 9.875 on vault and a 9.825 on bars.
- Freshman Lloimincia Hall posted a 9.90 on vault, her first event at LSU. It was the first and only 9.90 of the meet for the Tigers, and it was good enough for second place in the event.

LSU in the Rankings

- Rankings did not come this week. The next set of rankings will be released Monday.
- LSU was ranked No. 12 in the 2012 GymInfo Preseason Coaches Poll. It marked the second-straight season the Tigers were ranked 12th in the preseason poll, and it was the 15th straight year that LSU was ranked in the top 15 in the preseason poll.
- LSU has been ranked in the Top 25 in 153 consecutive polls and 529 straight weeks, counting the 2012 preseason poll. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was more than 10 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.



D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 35TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to shine as one of the nation's best programs, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accomplishments that includes nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, two Super Sixes in the last four seasons and seven individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2010, LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight year and 22nd time in Breaux's career. Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture NCAA All-Around national title as she became LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 and 2009 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship in 2008. The Tigers finished fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish in program history since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title and one day later Breaux coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the

gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years. Her dedication to the student-athlete on an individual basis has transcended into academic success, community involvement, Coach of the Year honors, SEC Championships, NCAA Regional Championships and top-10 national rankings throughout her tenure.

Now entering her 35th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have finished among the nation's top-10 teams 22 times in 34 seasons, placing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 26 separate occasions, winning regional titles nine times in three different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009. Her teams have included eight individual national titles, 106 All-America honors and 45 All-SEC selections.

Additionally, Breaux's Tigers won the inaugural SEC Championship title in 1981 and have gone on to finish second four times and third five other times.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

LSU vs. Auburn

- LSU holds a commanding 63-13 lead in the series history with Auburn, but the two teams have traded victories in the regular season recently. LSU beat Auburn at home in 2008 and 2010, but the Tigers lost at Auburn in 2009 and 2011. Of course, LSU also lost to Auburn in the Cancun Classic a week ago.
- LSU is 19-4 all time against Auburn at home. LSU's last loss at home to Auburn came on Feb. 17, 2006 when 13th-ranked LSU fell to No. 17 Auburn 196.700-196.550.

Record for Rheagan

- No freshman in the history of LSU gymnastics has scored a 39.175 in the all-around in her first meet as a Tiger until Rheagan Courville accomplished that feat in the Cancun Classic. The previous best was a 38.700 by former great April Burkholder in 2003.

D-D Breaux Enters Year 35 as Head Coach

- LSU gymnastics is going into its 38th year of existence, and D-D Breaux has only missed the first three seasons as she enters her 35th year as head of the program. Breaux holds a career record of 585-371-8 in 34 seasons, winning 61.1 percent of the time.
- In her time as coach, LSU has produced 106 NCAA All-Americans, 106 NACGC/W Scholastic All-Americans, 45 All-Southeastern Conference selections, 144 SEC Academic Honor Roll members, eight NCAA individual national champions, 28 AIAW or NCAA Championships appearances and two NCAA Super Six appearances.

Opening on the Road

- This is the third time in the last five seasons that LSU will open up the season at the Cancun Classic and the fourth time in the last five years that the Tigers will begin the year away from Baton Rouge.
- The only season in the last five in which LSU opened at home was 2010 when the Tigers hosted Maryland.
- LSU has won three of the last four season openers, taking the Cancun Classic titles in 2008 and 2009 and beating Maryland in 2010. The Tigers lost at Oregon State last season 195.400-193.350.

Lone Senior

- For the second straight season the LSU gymnastics team only has one senior on the roster. Ashley Lee is the lone senior in 2012. One season ago Samantha Engle was the only senior.
- Until last season LSU had not had a roster with only one senior since 2008 when Kristi Esposito was the only one.

Returning All-Americans

- LSU returns two All-Americans in 2012. Senior Ashley Lee picked up First-Team All-America honors on vault in 2010 while sophomore Kaleigh Dickson earned Second-Team All-America recognition in the all-around. Dickson's All-America honor was the 106th in LSU history as she became LSU's 10th All-American in the all-around dating back to 1986.
- The Tigers lost one All-American from 2011 as Sam Engle graduated.

Tough Slate in 2012

- LSU will face three teams ranked in the preseason top 10 this season and nine teams in the top 25, not including the SEC Championship.
- The Tigers have home meets against No. 2 Alabama, No. 17 Auburn and No. 23 Kentucky. LSU will face No. 11 Arkansas, No. 17 Auburn and No. 25 Iowa twice as all three teams will compete at the Cancun Classic. LSU has road meets at No. 3 Florida, No. 9 Georgia, No. 11 Arkansas, No. 16 Washington and No. 25 Iowa.
- LSU will face all six ranked SEC foes at the end of the season at the SEC Championship in Duluth, Ga.
