### STORYLINES

• LSU has held 11 opponents under 60 points this season, winning 10 of those games ... LSU won seven straight of those games while holding opponents under 60, equaling the streak of 7 set Jan. 16-Feb. 14, 1953.

\* Justin Hamilton has posted double figs in all three SEC games -- 23 vs. Ole Miss, 12 at Alabama, 20 at Arkansas ... He is averaging 18.3 points, 2nd in league game stats; and 10.0 rebounds, tied for 1st in league stats ... Hamilton averages 3.9 offensive rebounds a game, second in the league overall.

\* Hamilton had 23 points and 16 rebounds in the Ole Miss game (1/7), the first time an LSU player had 20 points and 15 rebounds in a game since Tasmin Mitchell had 24 points and 18 rebounds against Southeastern La. on Dec. 14, 2009.

\* Point guard Anthony Hickey has made 6-of-10 treys in SEC games ... Hickey and Andre Stringer (5) have made 11 of the 14 treys the Tigers have made in SEC play.

\* Senior Storm Warren, in the lineup for Johnny O'Bryant III (broken bone in

left hand), has posted 30 points in the 3 SEC games.

• Against Auburn, LSU leads the overall series, 81-62, and 44-23 in games in Baton Rouge ... The teams split games last year with LSU winning 62-55 at Auburn and Auburn winning 60-51 in Baton Rouge ... LSU has won 9 of the last 15 games.

• LSU has had at least 19 offensive boards at least five times this season ... Tigers lead the SEC in offensive rebounds average at 14.8 a game, 16.7 in SEC games (2nd in SEC).

# Trent Johnson

Head Coach • 4th year at LSU (13th year as head coach)

Trent Johnson, with two strong back-to-back recruiting classes on board, enters his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU Tigers in 2011-12.

Johnson's passion and vision for the LSU basketball program has the Tigers headed in the right direction.

As Johnson and his staff continue to develop players both on the court and off the court, they expected continued improvement athletically, academically and socially from the team.

Johnson, the 20th men's basketball coach at LSU, seeks to build on more than a decade of excellence at LSU, Stanford and Nevada. Having earned Conference Coach of the Year in all three leagues (Western Athletic Conference, Pac-10 and Southeastern Conference), Johnson knows the route to success to getting LSU back in the national spotlight.

In his first season at LSU, Johnson led the Tigers to 27 wins, tied for the third most wins in a season in LSU history. The Tigers won the SEC regular season championship with a record of 13-3. LSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006, advancing to the second round before falling, 84-70, to North Carolina in the closest game the eventual national champions would have to play. LSU had a second half lead on the Tar Heels and the game was still in the balance entering the final eight minutes.

Coach Johnson has a blueprint for success for himself and his players. As his players grasp the vision for success, they have the opportunity to embrace playing in a fast-paced system where executing in the half court and defending and rebounding are at a high level.

Johnson has a record of success and his team will have the opportunity to blend together and learn from a coach that is a fierce competitor who exudes and demands toughness.

His devotion to the team, his protective beliefs toward his players and his loyalty to his former players is evidenced by the fact that three of his former players are now members of the LSU basketball staff. Johnson is a program builder and he has re-established the base of the LSU program by visiting with former players and coaches to bring together the past, the present and the future of the program.

Johnson also is charged with the development of athletes both on and off the court. Off the court, he has worked hard since day one to make sure student-athletes understand the "student" part of their days at LSU. At all three stops in his head coaching career, he has developed not just successful athletes and winning basketball teams, but young men who are having success in life.

In his 13 years combined as a Division I head coach at LSU, Stanford and Nevada, he has won 208 games and taken teams in seven-of-the-last-nine seasons to post-season play, including five NCAA appearances.

Johnson was named the 2009 consensus SEC Coach of the Year and was a finalist for four national coach of the year honors as he became the first LSU men's basketball coach to win the league title and take the team to post-season play in his first year at the school.

Johnson has always been a big believer in special causes and joined former LSU basketball coach Dale Brown and star center Shaquille O'Neal in cutting a series of commercials that aired nationally for the "Be A Match" organization of bone marrow donors.

In June 2010, Johnson was part of a 10-day trip to Africa as part of the Nkomazi Sports Club Organization program that was established to stop the transmission of HIV through culturally relevant, locally sustainable health and life skills education-based programs in communities affected by HIV/AIDS.

He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and has served on the NABC Special Committee on Recruiting and Access. He also gives his time freely to such organizations as the Boy Scouts of America, the Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc., the American Diabestes Association, Samaritan's Feet, Troops First and the Jimmy V Foundation for cancer research.

Johnson, was born in Berkeley, Calif., and is married to Jackie and they have two children: a daughter, Tinishia, 28, and a son, Terry, 25.

Johnson's vision and passion is what drives him to make LSU basketball a success. With a coaching staff and a group of players that believe in the same vision and passion, that success has to be very much in sight.

### Last Time Out - Arkansas 69, LSU 60 (Jan. 14, 2012 -- Fayetteville, Ark.)

The Tigers dropped both road games last week, falling in its latest game Saturday in Fayetteville ... LSU did put up a good fight and remained in contention throughout despite hitting just 34.8 percent from the field (24-69) and 3-of-18 from the arc ... Countering, Arkansas was 50 percent from the arc hitting 9-of-18 and 16-of-28 free throws, while LSU made just 9 of 13 attempts ... Despite four players with two fouls in the first half, the Tigers were able to get the final four minutes to halftime, trailing by just one, 30-29.

LSU took a 33-32 lead in the second half before a 9-0 Arkansas run that made it 41-33 ... The Razorbacks got it to nine at one point, but LSU would cut it to four once as they relied on the inside presence of Justin Hamilton. The 7-0 junior center would score 17 second-half points as he topped 20 for the second time in three conference games. Anthony Hickey had 12 points on 5-of-10 shooting with two treys. Hamilton had 8 rebounds,

including 6 offensive as LSU out rebounded the Razorbacks, 46-38, including 17-9 on the offensive boards.

### Schedule Doesn't Start Easy For Tigers

The SEC schedule makers didn't do any favors for LSU with four road games in the first six league games, including at three of the pre-season favorites for possible bye spots in the SEC Tournament in March ... LSU played back-to-back on the road, falling at Alabama and Arkansas this past week and now will get to play its second home game Tuesday versus Auburn ... Following that will be a second back-to-back road swing of games at Florida and at Mississippi State before concluding the month of January with a home game against Kentucky.

LSU has no back-to-back road games in the month of February as the schedule tilts much more in the Tigers favor.

### Ole Miss Game was No. 2,500

The Jan. 7 game with Ole Miss was the 2,500th game for the LSU men's basketball team since the first contest on Jan. 30, 1909 ... LSU has won 1,419 games in that time (56.7 percent) with 10 conference championships, a mythical national championship awarded in 1935 and 4 NCAA Final Fours.

### Offensive Numbers

After hanging around the mid and high 60s in the wins in non-conference play, the Tigers put 81 on the board in its SEC opener against Ole Miss ... In Trent Johnson's four years at LSU, the Tigers are 19-2 when scoring more than 80 points ... Speaking of the 60s, that used to be a problem for LSU getting wins in the 60s, but this year LSU is 5-2 when scoring in the 60s and 16-17 in the Johnson years.

LSU is now averaging 67.3 points per game and opponents average is at 60.9 ... The scoring margin of plus 6.4 at this point of the season is a stark contrast to the last two years when LSU averaged just 62.2 in 2011 and 61.5 in 2010, with a scoring margin of minus 4.4 in 2011 and minus 4.9 in 2010 ... LSU is averaging 64.7 in the three SEC games.

LSU is seventh in the SEC in scoring, but third in the league in scoring defense.

### It's The "D" Word

The "D" word was definitely "Defense" as LSU held nine straight opponents under 60 points, posting an 8-1 record:

It had been almost 50 years since a team of LSU basketball players held opponents under 60 points in each of seven consecutive wins as the 2010-11 team did ... The 1952-53 team from Jan. 16 to Feb. 14 held seven consecutive teams under 60.

In that streak of seven games, LSU won three times on the road (at Houston, at Rutgers and at North Texas) and four in the Maravich Center (Boise State, UC Irvine, Marquette and Grambling).

LSU is 31-5 in the Trent Johnson era when holding teams under 60 points.

A total of 10 of LSU's wins have come when they have held teams under 60 points.

### Season 41 At The PMAC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU is trying to get its home court advantage back this season at the Maravich

Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers are now 6-2 with seven SEC home games ... Overall, LSU is 467-166 in the building (73.8 percent) and 215-128 (62.7 percent) in SEC home games ... Trent Johnson is 11-14 in home SEC games.

### Wins On The Road

LSU has a 3-3 record on the road this season, the first time LSU has won three times on a road court in the continental United States in non-conference play since the 1985-86 season when LSU was able to defeat Washington, Lamar and Texas.

In the road wins at Houston (59-58) and Rutgers (55-50), LSU had to come from behind twice in the second half against Houston and Rutgers ... The Tigers defeated Houston after the Cougars scored with 9.1 seconds left to take a 58-57 lead ... Anthony Hickey drove the lane, missed a contested layup, and then senior Storm Warren grabbed the rebound with 1.2 seconds left. Warren hit both free throws for the LSU win.

Against Rutgers, LSU was down five with 7:01 to play and allowed just two Rutgers points the rest of the way ... Those points came after LSU had taken a 49-48 lead on a Hickey jumper with 1:20 to play ... Rutgers made two free throws to take a 50-49 lead 15 seconds later, but Hickey got inside and one game after having his layup attempt knocked away, drove back inside and scored to give LSU the lead for good, 51-50. Rutgers would turn the ball over on a charge and on the inbounds, Hickey found Johnny O'Bryant for a dunk with 12 seconds left to make it a three-point game.

Those two road wins marked the first time LSU had won consecutive road games since February of the 2008-09 season when LSU beat Arkansas and Kentucky. The last time LSU won two road games in the same week period and back-to-back on the schedule came in Feb. 2006 when LSU defeated Auburn on Feb. 18, 2006 and then Vanderbilt on Feb. 22, 2006.

LSU had three road wins all last year on opponent's courts - at South Alabama, at Auburn and at Mississippi State ... Trent Johnson is now 12-22 on opponent's home courts ... Overall, LSU is 406-580 (41.2%) on the road in its history ... With the three neutral court games in Charleston, LSU is 5-3 this year away from the Maravich Center in non-conference play.

### Auburn Information

The Auburn Tigers won their first conference game, needing double overtime to score a 69-68 win over Ole Miss at the Auburn Arena on Saturday ... Frankie Sullivan played 33 minutes off the bench and hit 6-of-9 field goals, including two treys to finish with 19 points, four assists and four steals. Chris Denson played 38 minutes and scored 16 points, while Kenny Gabriel played 48 minutes and had 11 points, 13 rebounds and four blocked shots in the win ... Auburn shot 22-of-58 for the game (37.9%), and 7-of-18 (38.9%) from the arc ... Auburn was outrebounded, 49-39.

Sullivan is the leading scorer for the team with 11.6 points per game average, with Gabriel averaging 11.5 points and Denson 11.1 points per game. The Auburn Tigers are 10-1 at home and 1-3 in road games this year.

Tony Barbee is in his second year as the head coach at Auburn after four years as the head coach at UTEP.

### The Students Said It; Vests Getting Good Reviews

It started as a chant and now it's a hash tag on Twitter but as Coach Johnson was being interviewed on Cox Sports TV after the Boise game (12/10), the Maravich Maniacs began chanting, "Fear The Vest!" ... So far the Tigers have won three times with the coaches wearing purple, three also with white, twice each with black and grey, and, once with brown ... It's not a fashion statement or a trend that Coach Johnson and his staff are trying to make to the rest of the league, just as Coach Johnson has often said, a comfort statement and who can argue with that.

### Depth Back; Contributions Coming From All Classes

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years - depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster (as of this week, four freshmen because of the addition of a walk-on that expanded the roster to 13) ... Another difference for this year's team is that it has allowed players to play their natural position.

Plus, the importance of depth may have shown more than ever in the Boise game

(12/10) when one starter at off-guard and another top reserve guard did not dress for the contest. But LSU was able to attack the game from a bit of a different direction and was able to sustain its defense in the process.

Again against Ole Miss (1/7), two forwards were out (one with injury, another bereavement), but LSU responded with strong performances on the perimeter and inside to easily win its conference opener.

The other main benefit of having depth this year is that LSU has been able to sustain most of the games through the entire 40 minutes, something that LSU was unable to do in the past couple of years.

Through 17 games, there is a remarkable balance in the scoring of the team with freshman having scored 27.5 percent of the points and sophomores 28.5 percent ... The other two classes are also contributing with the juniors having scored 23.8 percent of the points and the senior threesome 20.2 percent ... Consider the seniors are contributing 20 percent with two players primarily coming off the bench and at times before the O'Bryant injury, all three coming off the bench.

Freshmen have led LSU in scoring three times (Hickey 2, O'Bryant III 1), sophomores seven times (Stringer 4, Turner 2, Courtney 1), junior six times (Hamilton) and a senior once (Warren).

One of the aspects that has been important for this team is everyone appears to know their roles and has accepted those roles in the team concepts ... It was those three seniors (Warren, White and Bass) that came off the bench with LSU down 13-0 to Marquette (12/19) who came in and slowly began the march back that led LSU to the win ... It was the four post players at North Texas (12/22) who were all in double figures (Warren, White, O'Bryant, Hamilton) that played a big part in that win ... Coach Johnson has substituted four and even five players at a time against some teams.

#### Turner Dec. 26 SEC Player of the Week; First Since March 2009

The Southeastern Conference selected sophomore guard Ralston Turner as its Player of the Week (12/26) ... It marked the first time an LSU player was named Player of the Week by the league since March 2009 ... Turner helped LSU to wins at home against previously undefeated 10th-ranked Marquette 67-59 (Dec. 19) and then at North Texas (Dec. 22) ... Highlighting the week, Turner had the second highest scoring game of his career in the win over Marquette, hitting 4-of-5 shots from the arc, scoring 22 points against the Golden Eagles.

Turner has struggled to get the same good shots to go down in the first three league games as he is just 4-of-24 from the field. But for the season, he is still averaging 8.8 points per game, fourth on the team, and 2.5 rebounds ... He has made 26 treys (34.7 percent) and has made 23-of-28 free throws for the season (82.1 percent).

#### Hamilton Back-To-Back 20-Plus Games; SEC POW For Jan. 9

The junior transfer from Iowa State has shown no ill effects of the one-year transfer rule that kept him off the competitive court as he was over 20 points in both games against Virginia (1/2) and Ole Miss (1/7) that earned him LSU's second POW of the season ... Here are the numbers:

**Vs. Virginia - 36 minutes, 9-of-14 FG, 3-6 FT, 4 blks, 2 stls, 21 points-9 rebounds**

**Vs. Ole Miss - 29 minutes - 9-of-12 FG, 5-6 FT, 2 blks, 1 stl, 23 points-16 rebounds**

**Totals - 65 minutes - 18-of-26 FG, 8-12 FT, 6 blks, 3 stls, 44 points-25 rebounds**

He was over 20 against Arkansas Saturday night with a 17-point second half as he dominated play under the bucket ... He made 8-of-17 field goals, 7-of-13 in the second half, in scoring 20 points with eight rebounds (six offensive) ... He enters the week averaging 13.4 points per game and 7.5 rebounds ... Since the start of 2012, Hamilton's scoring average has gone up 1.8 points, his rebound average is up 0.8 and he has 13 blocks in the last four games.

Hamilton's 18.3 scoring average in league play puts him second in the league and he is one of two players averaging 10.0 rebounds in league play.

#### Stringer Back And Performing Well

Andre Stringer, who missed five games after fainting in practice prior to the Boise State game (12/10), returned and played 24 minutes against Virginia (1/2) and the

sophomore had a good effort as he tried to get back in the swing of playing after resuming practice on Dec. 26 ... He had eight points with two treys, shooting 3-of-8 from the field ... Against Ole Miss (1/7), he played 28 minutes and had 10 points and five assists with one turnover and led the team in scoring with 13 with three treys at Alabama (1/11) ... Stringer has had a good statistical year moving from point guard as a freshman to off guard this season ... He is averaging 11.4 points per game while playing 31.8 minutes per game ... He is shooting 24-of-62 from the arc (38.7 percent) ... Last year, Stringer averaged 11.2 points per game and 2.6 assists, hitting 57 treys (29.5%) and 77.2 percent from the line (98-of-127).

### Ludwig Stepped In

It was Eddie Ludwig, the junior from Metairie, who had to step into the Andre Stringer position in the starting five ... For the game against Boise State (12/10) he responded with a big time effort of 33 minutes ... While he only scored two points, he did have a career high of nine rebounds, an assist and a block and was part of the defensive effort against leading Boise scorer Anthony Drmic, who came in averaging 15 points a game and was held scoreless.

Against UCI (12/15), Ludwig came through as a scorer, equaling his career high of 12 points in 24 minutes ... In those two games, Ludwig played 57 minutes, was 5-of-11 from the field, 2-of-7 from the arc, 2-2 FT, 14 reb, 2 assists, 2 blocks and 14 points ... ### Hickey All-Tournament At Charleston

LSU finished the Nov. 17-20 Charleston Classic with a 2-1 record as LSU defeated Western Kentucky, 76-57, and Georgia Tech, 59-50, after an 88-82 first-round loss versus Northwestern. In the process, point guard Anthony Hickey was named to the five-member all-tournament team after averaging 16 points for the three games, hitting over 51 percent of his field goal attempts (19-of-37), making six treys and averaging 4.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

After getting 17 against Western Kentucky, Hickey clinched the spot in the fifth place game against Georgia Tech ... Hickey had 20 points, including four treys. LSU led by four at the half and the game remained close until LSU went on a 9-4 run in which Hickey, Ralston Turner and Andre Stringer all hit threes to put LSU up for good.

### Hickey Backing Up Mr. Basketball Title

Kentucky's Mr. Basketball has shown his worth to the LSU Tigers, averaging 9.1 points per game, 3.8 rebounds and 66 assists in 17 games and more importantly a positive assist-to-turnover ratio of 66 assists to 36 turnovers. He also leads the SEC with 42 steals (2.5 average) and is in the top 10 in assists and assist-to-turnover ratio ... Hickey had his second double figure game in three league games at Arkansas with 12 points (8 for the season) and has had 10 games of four assists or more, including a seven-assist-no turnover game versus Ole Miss ... In the three SEC games, he is 13-of-23 from the field and 6-of-10 from three-point range ... He has had three steals or more in 11 games and is certainly on pace to have a steal total that could be in the top 10 for an LSU single season.

### McDonald's All-American Wants Back On Court

Well the broken bone in Johnny O'Bryant III's left hand hasn't caused him to completely leave the court, but he would like to be back inside the line because most of the time while practice is going on, he is running around the court trying to keep his conditioning up for when he can return.

Before breaking his hand, O'Bryant III came up big earlier in Charleston Classic in the Northwestern game (11/17) when he hit 6-of-8 field goal attempts in 22 minutes and made 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a 21 point effort. O'Bryant III also had a team high eight boards.

Against South Alabama (11/23), O'Bryant III led the team in rebounds for the second time this season with eight ... He started his first college game against Houston and tied for team rebound lead with seven, five of which were offensive ... He posted 11 points at Rutgers (12/3) and 10 points in the Boise State game (12/10) ... Just like the Houston game, O'Bryant had seven boards against UCI (12/15), but five were offensive ... He recorded his first college double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds at North Texas



(12/22) ... He is averaging 7.9 ppg and 6.2 rebounds ... He is the third leading freshman rebounder in the league.

### Warren Milestones – Ups Double Double Total

Warren, who moved back into the starting lineup for O'Bryant against Ole Miss (1/7), had a double double in the win, although it was slightly overshadowed by the performance of Justin Anderson ... But Warren's double double was just as important as he had 15 points and 11 rebounds (six offensive) ... While it was his first of the year, but it was his 12th of his LSU career.

LSU senior Storm Warren continued putting special notes on his career and the most prominent came with 14:15 to go in the first half when he pulled down the first of his six rebounds against Grambling (12/29) to make him the 37th LSU player to have 500 career rebounds ... Against Boise State (12/10), he blocked the 100th shot of his career ... He became the eighth player and first since Garrett Temple in 2009 to reach triple figures in blocks ... He also in the month of December became the 22nd LSU player to record 100 career steals.

Warren is averaging 8.4 points and 5.5 rebounds in 19.7 minutes of playing time.

### Chris Bass – Off The Bench To The Point

Senior Chris Bass, the brother of NBA star and former SEC Player of the Year Brandon Bass, has been using his minutes very well to help LSU when he goes in either in place of/or with Anthony Hickey in the LSU offense ... Bass, who has had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio each of his first three seasons, is well on his way to making it four straight years with 29 assists and 16 turnovers this year ... Plus, while never thought of as a scoring threat, he is coming up this year with good decisions and a score or two in several consecutive games for the Tigers ... Bass is averaging 13.6 minutes per game ... The Baton Rouge native is 11-of-21 from the field this year, averaging 1.9 points per game.

### The Newest Tiger – Ronald Martin

The newest member of the LSU team, Ronald Martin, joined the team this past Thursday for the first time after the conclusion of the LSU football team ... The football star on the White Castle football team and the point guard of the successful White Castle basketball team, has joined the team for the remainder of the season ... He was first team all-state in both football and basketball, leading football team to state title as QB and safety and the state championship in basketball ... He was also an all-district performer in baseball and ran 400 meters and participated in the long jump and triple jump in track and field.

He dressed for the first time at Arkansas (1/14).

During his freshman football season he played in three games with two solo tackles and three total tackles with two pass breakups.

### Free Throw Shooting

LSU is fourth in the league in free throw shooting at 70.6 percent (214-303) ... LSU led the league for much of the first six weeks of the season.

Storm Warren showed the team's ability late at the free throw line by making the two charity tosses with 1.2 seconds left to win the game at Houston (11/29) ... Warren was a 51.5 percent free throw shooter a year ago (17-33), but this year he has already made 30 free throws in 42 attempts (71.4 percent).

One of the things with Andre Stringer getting back is having his free throw shooting back as he is now 25-of-30 (83.3 percent) ... Ralston Turner is at 82.1 percent (23-28) and Justin Hamilton 76.6 percent (59-77).

Last season LSU made 66.5 percent of its free throws (432-650), the second consecutive season LSU was below 70 percent.

### 50 Percent or Better

LSU topped 50 percent from the field against both Boise and Marquette and for the Trent Johnson years at LSU, the Tigers are 12-0 when they shoot 50 percent from the floor.

While LSU overall is 12th in the league in shooting percentage at 40.2 percent, the
