## LSU Heads Back on the Road to Face No. 3 Arkansas

After falling to Auburn in the Cancun Classic, LSU exacted revenge with a 195.025-193.800 victory against Auburn in Baton Rouge last week. Now, No. 25 LSU seeks to avenge a loss to third-ranked Arkansas in the Cancun Classic when the Tigers travel to Fayetteville for Friday's meet. LSU will be facing an Arkansas team that has been red hot to open the season, scoring above a 196 in both meets. The Tigers made a significant improvement between the first two meets, and LSU hopes to welcome back several Tigers who have missed time with injuries. Shelby Prunty, Ericka Garcia, Sarie Morrison and Maliah Mathis have all been limited. Kaleigh Dickson is expected back after sitting out all of last week. The meet will begin at 7 p.m. CT in Barnhill Arena, and live audio is available for free by logging on to [www.LSUports.net/live](http://www.LSUports.net/live).

### STORYLINES

- LSU is looking to continue last meet's occurrence with an improved team score and a victory after losing to Arkansas at the Cancun Classic.

- were performed by freshmen. Twenty of the 24 total routines were performed by a Fr. or So.

- LSU swept the all-around awards with three freshmen vs. Auburn. Lloimincia Hall won the title. Jessie Jordan was 2nd, and Rheagan Courville was 3rd.

- All four freshmen competed in the all-around against Auburn - a first in school history - and that means 16 of the 24 routines (two thirds)

- Shooting for 49's: LSU has hit for a 49.025 or better both times on vault, but the Tigers have yet to hit 49 on any other event.

- LSU is 4-0-1 all time at Arkansas, but the two teams tied at 196.2 last time LSU visited in 2010.

### NOTEBOOK

#### Last Time Out

- LSU avenged a loss to Auburn in the season opener with a 195.025-193.800 victory in Baton Rouge.
- LSU improved the team score on each event from the first meet except vault, but the Tigers still earned a 49.025 on vault. LSU only counted one fall on beam and one on floor in the meet.
- Freshman Lloimincia Hall was named SEC Freshman of the Week after she earned a 39.200 to win the all-around title. Fellow freshmen Jessie Jordan and Rheagan Courville took second and third in the all-around with a 39.025 and 38.925, respectively.

#### LSU in the Rankings

- LSU dropped from No. 12 to No. 25 in the team rankings with a 193.763 average after two meets.
- The Tigers rank ninth on vault with a 49.113 average and 13th on floor with a 48.875 average.
- Individually, Rheagan Courville is 10th on vault with a 9.90 average, and Lloimincia Hall is 13th on floor with a 9.875 average.
- LSU has been ranked in the Top 25 in 154 consecutive polls and 530 straight weeks. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was more than 10 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.



# D-D Breaux

## HEAD COACH • 35TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to shine as one of the nation's best programs, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accomplishments that includes nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, two Super Sixes in the last four seasons and seven individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2010, LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight year and 22nd time in Breaux's career. Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture NCAA All-Around national title as she became LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 and 2009 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship in 2008. The Tigers finished fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish in program history since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title and one day later Breaux coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the

gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years. Her dedication to the student-athlete on an individual basis has transcended into academic success, community involvement, Coach of the Year honors, SEC Championships, NCAA Regional Championships and top-10 national rankings throughout her tenure.

Now entering her 35th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have finished among the nation's top-10 teams 22 times in 34 seasons, placing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 26 separate occasions, winning regional titles nine times in three different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009. Her teams have included eight individual national titles, 106 All-America honors and 45 All-SEC selections.

Additionally, Breaux's Tigers won the inaugural SEC Championship title in 1981 and have gone on to finish second four times and third five other times.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

## NOTEBOOK CONTINUED

### LSU vs. Arkansas

- LSU holds a 19-4-1 record against Arkansas, but the series has been even lately. LSU tied Arkansas the last time the Tigers were in Fayetteville as both teams scored a 196.200. LSU lost both meetings to Arkansas last season, losing at home and in the SEC Championship.
- LSU is 4-0-1 in Fayetteville, but the Tigers enter as underdogs this season having lost to Arkansas in the Cancun Classic.

### Hall Earns SEC Freshman of the Week vs. Auburn

- LSU freshman Lloimincia Hall was named SEC Freshman of the Week after scoring a 39.200 and winning the all-around against Auburn. She also shared the floor title with Rheagan Courville as both tallied a 9.90.
- Hall's 39.200 all-around total was the highest total last week by a freshman in the SEC, and it is the highest score for an LSU gymnast since Sarie Morrison earned a 39.575 on Feb. 18, 2011 against Georgia.

### LSU Adds Britney Taylor to Roster Prior to Arkansas Meet

- Britney Taylor, a junior transfer from Central Michigan, joined LSU prior to the spring semester on Jan. 17, 2012, and she is immediately eligible to compete for the Tigers.
- Taylor comes to LSU after two successful seasons at Central Michigan where she earned Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year and First-Team All-MAC honors in 2010 and Second-Team All-MAC recognition as a sophomore last season.
- While at Central Michigan, Taylor accumulated career highs of 9.875 on vault, 9.825 on bars, 9.850 on beam, 9.850 on floor and 39.275 in the all-around. Taylor posted a 9.80 or higher 16 times as a freshman and 10 times last year.

### Record for Rheagan

- No freshman in the history of LSU gymnastics has scored a 39.175 in the all-around in her first meet as a Tiger until Rheagan Courville accomplished that feat in the Cancun Classic. The previous best was a 38.700 by former great April Burkholder in 2003.

### LSU Takes Fifth in Cancun Classic

- LSU started strong at the Cancun Classic with a 49.200 on vault and struggled after the bye before bars with a 47.975 on bars and a 46.525 on beam. The Tigers rallied for a 48.800 on floor and settled for a 192.500 total, the lowest team score since 1998.
- Despite the team struggles, freshman Rheagan Courville put together a solid meet with freshman season-opening record 39.175 in the all-around, highlighted by a 9.875 on vault and a 9.825 on bars.
- Freshman Lloimincia Hall posted a 9.90 on vault, her first event at LSU. It was the first and only 9.90 of the meet for the Tigers, and it was good enough for second place in the event.

## D-D Breaux Enters Year 35 as Head Coach

- LSU gymnastics is going into its 38th year of existence, and D-D Breaux has only missed the first three seasons as she enters her 35th year as head of the program. Breaux holds a career record of 586-371-8 in 34 seasons, winning 61.1 percent of the time.
- In her time as coach, LSU has produced 106 NCAA All-Americans, 106 NACGC/W Scholastic All-Americans, 45 All-Southeastern Conference selections, 144 SEC Academic Honor Roll members, eight NCAA individual national champions, 28 AIAW or NCAA Championships appearances and two NCAA Super Six appearances.

## Opening on the Road

- This is the third time in the last five seasons that LSU will open up the season at the Cancun Classic and the fourth time in the last five years that the Tigers will begin the year away from Baton Rouge.
- The only season in the last five in which LSU opened at home was 2010 when the Tigers hosted Maryland.
- LSU has won three of the last four season openers, taking the Cancun Classic titles in 2008 and 2009 and beating Maryland in 2010. The Tigers lost at Oregon State last season 195.400-193.350.

## Lone Senior

- For the second straight season the LSU gymnastics team only has one senior on the roster. Ashley Lee is the lone senior in 2012. One season ago Samantha Engle was the only senior.
- Until last season LSU had not had a roster with only one senior since 2008 when Kristi Esposito was the only one.

## Returning All-Americans

- LSU returns two All-Americans in 2012. Senior Ashley Lee picked up First-Team All-America honors on vault in 2010 while sophomore Kaleigh Dickson earned Second-Team All-America recognition in the all-around. Dickson's All-America honor was the 106th in LSU history as she became LSU's 10th All-American in the all-around dating back to 1986.
- The Tigers lost one All-American from 2011 as Sam Engle graduated.

## Tough Slate in 2012

- LSU will face three teams ranked in the preseason top 10 this season and nine teams in the top 25, not including the SEC Championship.
- The Tigers have home meets against No. 2 Alabama, No. 17 Auburn and No. 23 Kentucky. LSU will face No. 11 Arkansas, No. 17 Auburn and No. 25 Iowa twice as all three teams will compete at the Cancun Classic. LSU has road meets at No. 3 Florida, No. 9 Georgia, No. 11 Arkansas, No. 16 Washington and No. 25 Iowa.
- LSU will face all six ranked SEC foes at the end of the season at the SEC Championship in Duluth, Ga.
