### STORYLINES

• LSU has held 12 opponents under 60 points this season, winning 11 of those games ... LSU won seven straight of those games while holding opponents under 60, equaling the streak of 7 set Jan. 16-Feb. 14, 1953.

\* Justin Hamilton is part of a number of categories in the SEC stats -- 10th in points (13.6), 8th rebounds (7.2), 5th in FG Pct (51.9%), 10th FT Pct (75.6%), 8th blocks (1.4), 2nd off. boards (3.5) ... In league games only, his averages ranked 4th in scoring (16.1) and 6th in rebounds (7.7).

\* Point guard Anthony Hickey is

shooting just under 50 percent overall in SEC games, making 31-of-63 ... He is 15-of-31 from the arc ... Hickey, Andre Stringer (9) and Ralston Turner (7) have 31-of-the-37 treys in league play.

\* LSU and Arkansas are meeting for the second time this season, with Arkansas winning in Fayetteville by a 69-60 decision ... In the game Justin Hamilton had 20 points with three blocks and eight rebounds (6 offensive), while Anthony Hickey hit 5-of-10 shots (2 treys) to get 12 points ... LSU shot 34.8 percent overall, 3-of-18 from the arc ... LSU out rebounded the Hogs, 46-38, including 17-9 on the offensive boards.

• Arkansas leads the overall series 31-22, having won two straight overall ... LSU has won the last three meetings in Baton Rouge and has a 12-10 advantage in games played in the PMAC and is 14-8 in the last 22 meetings.

• LSU has had at least 19 offensive boards at least five times this season ... Tigers lead the SEC in offensive rebounds average at 13.7 a game ... LSU has not had double figure offensive rebounds in just five games this season.

• LSU will travel to Nashville on Wednesday night for an 8 p.m. game against Vandy (CSS/COX4/CST).

# Trent Johnson

Head Coach • 4th year at LSU (13th year as head coach)

Trent Johnson, with two strong back-to-back recruiting classes on board, enters his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU Tigers in 2011-12.

Johnson's passion and vision for the LSU basketball program has the Tigers headed in the right direction.

As Johnson and his staff continue to develop players both on the court and off the court, they expected continued improvement athletically, academically and socially from the team.

Johnson, the 20th men's basketball coach at LSU, seeks to build on more than a decade of excellence at LSU, Stanford and Nevada. Having earned Conference Coach of the Year in all three leagues (Western Athletic Conference, Pac-10 and Southeastern Conference), Johnson knows the route to success to getting LSU back in the national spotlight.

In his first season at LSU, Johnson led the Tigers to 27 wins, tied for the third most wins in a season in LSU history. The Tigers won the SEC regular season championship with a record of 13-3. LSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006, advancing to the second round before falling, 84-70, to North Carolina in the closest game the eventual national champions would have to play. LSU had a second half lead on the Tar Heels and the game was still in the balance entering the final eight minutes.

Coach Johnson has a blueprint for success for himself and his players. As his players grasp the vision for success, they have the opportunity to embrace playing in a fast-paced system where executing in the half court and defending and rebounding are at a high level.

Johnson has a record of success and his team will have the opportunity to blend together and learn from a coach that is a fierce competitor who exudes and demands toughness.

His devotion to the team, his protective beliefs toward his players and his loyalty to his former players is evidenced by the fact that three of his former players are now members of the LSU basketball staff. Johnson is a program builder and he has re-established the base of the LSU program by visiting with former players and coaches to bring together the past, the present and the future of the program.

Johnson also is charged with the development of athletes both on and off the court. Off the court, he has worked hard since day one to make sure student-athletes understand the "student" part of their days at LSU. At all three stops in his head coaching career, he has developed not just successful athletes and winning basketball teams, but young men who are having success in life.

In his 13 years combined as a Division I head coach at LSU, Stanford and Nevada, he has won 208 games and taken teams in seven-of-the-last-nine seasons to post-season play, including five NCAA appearances.

Johnson was named the 2009 consensus SEC Coach of the Year and was a finalist for four national coach of the year honors as he became the first LSU men's basketball coach to win the league title and take the team to post-season play in his first year at the school.

Johnson has always been a big believer in special causes and joined former LSU basketball coach Dale Brown and star center Shaquille O'Neal in cutting a series of commercials that aired nationally for the "Be A Match" organization of bone marrow donors.

In June 2010, Johnson was part of a 10-day trip to Africa as part of the Nkomazi Sports Club Organization program that was established to stop the transmission of HIV through culturally relevant, locally sustainable health and life skills education-based programs in communities affected by HIV/AIDS.

He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and has served on the NABC Special Committee on Recruiting and Access. He also gives his time freely to such organizations as the Boy Scouts of America, the Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc., the American Diabestes Association, Samaritan's Feet, Troops First and the Jimmy V Foundation for cancer research.

Johnson, was born in Berkeley, Calif., and is married to Jackie and they have two children: a daughter, Tinishia, 28, and a son, Terry, 25.

Johnson's vision and passion is what drives him to make LSU basketball a success. With a coaching staff and a group of players that believe in the same vision and passion, that success has to be very much in sight.

### Last Time Out - Kentucky 74, LSU 50 (Jan. 28, 2012 -- Baton Rouge)

No. 1 ranked Kentucky had an answer for everything LSU tried during their battle before the 14th-largest paid attendance since the 2005 renovation and capacity change of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center ... LSU made one major first half run cutting a 10-point, 24-14 deficit, to just one point, 25-24, with 3:22 left in the first half ... But Kentucky went on a 7-0 run to end the first half and followed it with a 9-0 run to open the second half to put the game away.

LSU had two players in double figures led by Johnny O'Bryant III who returned to the starting lineup, played 28 minutes and had 12 points, nine rebounds and two blocks ... Storm Warren played 21 minutes off the bench and hit 5-of-9 shots for 11 points. LSU shot 39.6 percent overall (26-55) and just 1-of-9 from the arc ... Kentucky out rebounded the Tigers, 39-29.

### From The Arc

After hitting 11 treys in the game at Mississippi State on Jan. 24, equaling the season high set in the first game (11/12) against Nicholls State, the Tigers were able to manage just one trey

a week ago against Kentucky ... The Mississippi State game marked the eighth time in Trent Johnson's years at LSU that the Tigers have tallied double figure three-pointers in a game ... Ironically, the only other time against an SEC school, also came at Mississippi State when LSU made 10 in the 2009 SEC season.

### We Can't Find The Line?

It's become just too noticeable to ignore ... In the seven SEC games, the Tigers are 61-of-90 from the stripe, averaging 8.7 made per game and 12.86 attempts a conference game ... On the other hand, LSU opponents are +37 on makes, +68 on attempts (98-158) ... LSU league opponents are making an average of 14.0 free throws a game while attempting 22.57 a contest.

In the past three games, on the road at Florida and at Mississippi State and at home versus Kentucky, LSU is 18-of-29 in the three games while the opponents are a combined 53-of-77.

When the Tigers have been at the line, LSU is fifth in the league in free throw shooting at 70.1 percent (239-341) ... LSU led the league for much of the first six weeks of the season.

Storm Warren showed the team's ability late at the free throw line by making the two charity tosses with 1.2 seconds left to win the game at Houston (11/29) ... Warren was a 51.5 percent free throw shooter a year ago (17-33), but this year he has already made 35 free throws in 50 attempts (70 percent) ... One of the things with Andre Stringer getting back is having his free throw shooting back as he is now 34-of-39 (87.2 percent) ... Justin Hamilton is at 75.6 percent (62-of-82).

Last season LSU made 66.5 percent of its free throws (432-650), the second consecutive season LSU was below 70 percent.

### January Adventure Over

The Tigers were not the favorites in the month of January of the league schedule makers with two back-to-back road trips in the first six conference games ... After opening at home against Ole Miss, LSU had to travel to Tuscaloosa and Fayetteville back-to-back ... LSU then got to play Auburn at home on Jan. 17 before finding itself on another back-to-back road trip again at Florida (Jan. 21) and at Mississippi State (Jan. 25).

LSU closed the month of January with a home game against Kentucky on Jan. 28.

LSU has no back-to-back road games in the month of February as the schedule appears to tilt a little more in the Tigers favor.

This latest stretch of games vs. Florida-Mississippi State and Kentucky marked the first time LSU played three consecutive nationally-ranked AP opponents in the regular season since the Tigers met # 22 Mississippi State, #4 Florida and #23 Alabama at the end of January 2003.

### Tigers Raise Mark With Auburn Win

For the first time since the 2008-09 season, the Tiger basketball team has topped the 11-win mark with the victory against Auburn, its 12th of the season ... The LSU team won 11 games in both 2010 and 2011.

### Offensive Numbers

After hanging around the mid and high 60s in the wins in non-conference play, the Tigers put 81 on the board in its SEC opener against Ole Miss ... In Trent Johnson's four years at LSU, the Tigers are 19-2 when scoring more than 80 points ... Speaking of the 60s, that used to be a problem for LSU getting wins in the 60s, but this year LSU is 6-3 when scoring in the 60s and 17-18 in the Johnson years.

LSU is now averaging 66.4 points per game and opponents average is at 62.8 ... The scoring margin of plus 3.6 at this point of the season is a stark contrast to the last two years when LSU averaged just 62.2 in 2011 and 61.5 in 2010, with a scoring margin of minus 4.4 in 2011 and minus 4.9 in 2010 ... LSU is averaging 63.4 in the seven SEC games.

LSU is seventh in the SEC in scoring, but fourth in the league in scoring defense.

### It's The "D" Word

The "D" word has been definitely "Defense" as LSU has held 12 opponents under 60 points including a string of seven straight wins and an 11-1 record in those games:

It had been almost 50 years since a team of LSU basketball players held opponents under 60 points in each of seven consecutive wins as the 2010-11 team did ... The 1952-53 team from Jan. 16 to Feb. 14 held seven consecutive teams under 60.

In that streak of seven games, LSU won three times on the road (at Houston, at Rutgers and at North Texas) and four in the Maravich Center (Boise State, UC Irvine, Marquette and Grambling).

LSU is 32-5 in the Trent Johnson era when holding teams under 60 points.

### Turnovers Second Half

Coach Trent Johnson has preached taking care of the basketball since the first day he stepped on the basketball court ... In the final 20 minutes of the last two road games, at Florida and at Mississippi State, that taking care of the basketball has shown itself ... Against Florida, after turning the ball over 10 times in the first half, LSU turned it over just once ... Against Mississippi State, after seven first-half turnovers, LSU turned it over just three times in the second half ... Earlier in league play after turning it over 11 times in the first half at Alabama, LSU had just four turnovers in the final 20 minutes.

Even in the troubles with Kentucky in the last game, LSU turned the ball over just nine total times, four in the first half and five in the second half.

For the SEC games, LSU is sitting with a positive assist-to-turnover ratio (91-80) and is just below even (266-270) in overall assist-to-turnover numbers.

### Season 41 At The PMAC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU is trying to get its home court advantage back this season at the Maravich Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers are now 7-3 with five SEC home games left ... Overall, LSU is 468-167 in the building (73.7 percent) and 216-129 (62.6 percent) in SEC home games ... Trent Johnson is 12-15 in home SEC games.

### Wins On The Road

LSU has a 3-5 record on the road this season, the first time LSU has won three times on a road court in the continental United States in non-conference play since the 1985-86 season when LSU was able to defeat Washington, Lamar and Texas.

In the road wins at Houston (59-58) and Rutgers (55-50), LSU had to come from behind twice in the second half against Houston and Rutgers ... The Tigers defeated Houston after the Cougars scored with 9.1 seconds left to take a 58-57 lead ... Anthony Hickey drove the lane, missed a contested layup, and then senior Storm Warren grabbed the rebound with 1.2 seconds left. Warren hit both free throws for the LSU win.

Against Rutgers, LSU was down five with 7:01 to play and allowed just two Rutgers points the rest of the way ... Those points came after LSU had taken a 49-48 lead on a Hickey jumper with 1:20 to play ... Rutgers made two free throws to take a 50-49 lead 15 seconds later, but Hickey got inside and one game after having his layup attempt knocked away, drove back inside and scored to give LSU the lead for good, 51-50. Rutgers would turn the ball over on a charge and on the inbounds, Hickey found Johnny O'Bryant for a dunk with 12 seconds left to make it a three-point game.

Those two road wins marked the first time LSU had won consecutive road games since February of the 2008-09 season when LSU beat Arkansas and Kentucky. The last time LSU won two road games in the same week period and back-to-back on the schedule came in Feb. 2006 when LSU defeated Auburn on Feb. 18, 2006 and then Vanderbilt on Feb. 22, 2006.

LSU had three road wins all last year on opponent's courts - at South Alabama, at Auburn and at Mississippi State ... Trent Johnson is now 12-24 on opponent's home courts ... Overall, LSU is 406-582 (41.1%) on the road in its history ... With the three neutral court games in Charleston, LSU is 5-6 this year away from the Maravich Center.

### Game No. 400 For Coach J

The first game in February against the Razorbacks will mark the 400th game for Coach Trent Johnson in his 13-year career as a head coach ... The LSU mentor, in his fourth year as

head coach in Baton Rouge, also coached five years at Nevada and four years as the head coach at Stanford before being named LSU's 20th head coach.

He was 79-74 in five years at Nevada with one Western Athletic Conference title and NIT appearance and an NCAA Sweet 16 showing ... After that at Stanford in the Pac-10, the Cardinal was 80-47 with one NIT appearance and three NCAA appearances, including a Sweet 16 showing ... At LSU presently in his fourth year, he is 61-58 with one SEC title and an NCAA Tournament second round appearance.

He has won Coach of the Year honors in all three leagues and enters Saturday's game with an overall record of 220-179.

### Against Ranked Teams

The Tigers are 1-4 this season against ranked teams, defeating No. 10 Marquette on Dec. 19, 67-59, and losing to 21st-ranked Virginia on Jan. 2, 57-52, #17 Florida (1/21), 76-64; a 76-71 loss to #18 Mississippi State and the 74-50 loss to No. 1 Kentucky ... LSU is 2-17 in the Trent Johnson era against ranked teams ... The other win before Marquette came against nationally-ranked Butler in the first round of the 2009 NCAA Tournament ... LSU is 60-231 all-time against ranked teams in the AP poll since it started in 1948-49.

### Arkansas Information

Arkansas scored 50 second half points at home against Vanderbilt on Tuesday night en route to an 82-74 win, their fourth in the league ... Arkansas made 45.9 percent of their field goal attempts (55.2, 16-29 in the second half) and 9-of-23 from the arc (6-12 in the second half) ... Arkansas had a 36-29 rebound advantage with just eight turnovers as Arkansas rallied from 34-32 down at the half ... Five players were in double figures with Rickey Scott scoring 18, Jylusses Nobles 17, BJ Young 12 and Mardracus Wade and Rashad Madden 10 each.

Mike Anderson is in his first year at the University of Arkansas in the head coaching role ... He also has been the head coach at UAB and Missouri and of course, was the long-time assistant at Arkansas for Nolan Richardson.

### The Students Said It; Vests Getting Good Reviews

It started as a chant and now it's a hash tag on Twitter but as Coach Johnson was being interviewed on Cox Sports TV after the Boise game (12/10), the Maravich Maniacs began chanting, "Fear The Vest!" ... So far the Tigers have won four times with the coaches wearing purple, three also with white, twice each with black and grey, and, once with brown ... It's not a fashion statement or a trend that Coach Johnson and his staff are trying to make to the rest of the league, just as Coach Johnson has often said, a comfort statement and who can argue with that.

### Depth Back; Contributions Coming From All Classes

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years - depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster ... Another difference for this year's team is that it has allowed players to play their natural position.

Plus, the importance of depth may have shown more than ever in the Boise game (12/10) when one starter at off-guard and another top reserve guard did not dress for the contest. But LSU was able to attack the game from a bit of a different direction and was able to sustain its defense in the process.

Again against Ole Miss (1/7), two forwards were out (one with injury, another bereavement), but LSU responded with strong performances on the perimeter and inside to easily win its conference opener.

The other main benefit of having depth this year is that LSU has been able to sustain most of the games through the entire 40 minutes, something that LSU was unable to do in the past couple of years.

Through 21 games, there is a remarkable balance in the scoring of the team, especially among the lower three classes with freshman having scored 27.9 percent of the points and sophomores 28.1 percent ... With Hamilton coming on strong in SEC play, the juniors represent now 24.2 percent of LSU's scoring ... The three senior players account for 19.8 percent of the scoring.

Consider the face the seniors are contributing right under 20 percent with two players primarily coming off the bench and at times, all three coming off the bench.

Freshmen have led LSU in scoring five times (Hickey 3, O'Bryant III 2), sophomores eight times (Stringer 5, Turner 2, Courtney 1), junior seven times (Hamilton) and a senior once (Warren).

One of the aspects that has been important for this team is everyone appears to know their roles and has accepted those roles in the team concepts ... It was those three seniors (Warren, White and Bass) that came off the bench with LSU down 13-0 to Marquette (12/19) who came in and slowly began the march back that led LSU to the win ... It was the four post players at

It marked the first time an LSU player was named Player of the Week by the league since March 2009 ... Turner helped LSU to wins at home against previously undefeated 10th-ranked Marquette 67-59 (Dec. 19) and then at North Texas (Dec. 22) ... Highlighting the week, Turner had the second highest scoring game of his career in the win over Marquette, hitting 4-of-5 shots from the arc, scoring 22 points against the Golden Eagles.

Turner has struggled to get the same good shots to go down in the first three league games as he was just 4-of-24 from the field. But he knew that things were going to change his way by not changing and he came out and hit his first two three-pointers against Auburn and finished 4-of-9 from the field (3-7 from the arc) with 11 points in 25 minutes.

Overall, he is averaging 8.6 points per game and he is making 36 percent from the arc (32-of-89).

### Hamilton Earns SEC POW Jan. 9; Just Keeps Going

The junior transfer from Iowa State has shown no ill effects of the one-year transfer rule that kept him off the competitive court ... He was over 20 points in both games against Virginia (1/2) and Ole Miss (1/7) that earned him LSU's second POW of the season ... Here are the numbers:

**Vs. Virginia - 36 minutes, 9-of-14 FG, 3-6 FT, 4 blks, 2 stls, 21 points-9 rebounds**

**Vs. Ole Miss - 29 minutes, 9-of-12 FG, 5-6 FT, 2 blks, 1 stl, 23 points-16 rebounds**

**Totals - 65 minutes - 18-of-26 FG, 8-12 FT, 6 blks, 3 stls, 44 points-25 rebounds**

In two of LSU's road league games, he has also been strong, topping 20 points at Arkansas (1/14) and at Florida (1/21):

**At Arkansas - 28 minutes, 8-of-17 FG, 4-7 FT, 3 blks, 20 pts-8 rebounds**

**At Florida - 38 minutes, 13-of-22 FG, 1-1 3FG, 1 ast, 27 pts-8 rebounds**

In the second half against Arkansas, Hamilton had 17 points and at Florida he had 18 of his points in the final 20 minutes ... He had his seven consecutive double figure scoring game streak stopped against UK and that equaled the longest streak of recent times that Storm Warren had late in the 2011 season ... His 13 made field goals against Florida marked the second most FGs for an LSU player in the Trent Johnson era, topped only by the 15 that Tasmin Mitchell made against Auburn in 2010 ... The last player to top 25 points before Hamilton did against Florida was Bo Spencer who had 26 against Auburn on Feb. 27, 2010.

Hamilton is now averaging 13.6 points per game and 7.2 rebounds ... Since the start of 2012, Hamilton's scoring average has gone up two full points from 11.6 to 13.6 points per game ... In the seven SEC games, Hamilton is fourth in the league with an SEC only average of 16.1 points per game.

### Stringer Back And Performing Well

Andre Stringer, who missed five games after fainting in practice prior to the Boise State game (12/10), returned and played 24 minutes against Virginia (1/2) and the sophomore had a good effort as he tried to get back in the swing of playing after resuming practice on Dec. 26 ... He had eight points with two treys, shooting 3-of-8 from the field ... Against Ole Miss (1/7), he played 28 minutes and had 10 points and five assists with one turnover and led the team in scoring with 13 with three treys at Alabama (1/11).

Coach Johnson had Stringer come off the bench at Starkville (1/25) and he responded with an impressive 17-point effort which included two treys and 5-5 at the free throw line ... Stringer has had a good statistical year moving forward from point guard as a freshman to off guard this season ... He is averaging 10.6 points per game while playing 31.5 minutes per game ... He is shooting 28-of-79 from the arc (35.4 percent) ... Last year, Stringer averaged 11.2 points per game and 2.6 assists, hitting 57 treys (29.5%) and 77.2 percent from the line (98-of-127).

This year, he is 34-of-39 at the line (87.2 percent),

### Ludwig Stepped In

It was Eddie Ludwig, the junior from Metairie, who had to step into the Andre Stringer position in the starting five ... For the game against Boise State (12/10) he responded with a big time effort of 33 minutes ... While he only scored two points, he did have a career high of nine rebounds, an assist and a block and was part of the defensive effort against leading Boise



scorer Anthony Drmic, who came in averaging 15 points a game and was held scoreless.

Against UCI (12/15), Ludwig came through as a scorer, equaling his career high of 12 points in 24 minutes ... In those two games, Ludwig played 57 minutes, was 5-of-11 from the field, 2-of-7 from the arc, 2-2 FT, 14 reb, 2 assists, 2 blocks and 14 points ... For the season, Ludwig is averaging 2.2 points and 2.3 rebounds.

### Hickey All-Tournament At Charleston

LSU finished the Nov. 17-20 Charleston Classic with a 2-1 record as LSU defeated Western Kentucky, 76-57, and Georgia Tech, 59-50, after an 88-82 first-round loss versus Northwestern. In the process, point guard Anthony Hickey was named to the five-member all-tournament team after averaging 16 points for the three games, hitting over 51 percent of his field goal attempts (19-of-37), making six treys and averaging 4.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

After getting 17 against Western Kentucky, Hickey clinched the spot in the fifth place game against Georgia Tech ... Hickey had 20 points, including four treys. LSU led by four at the half and the game remained close until LSU went on a 9-4 run in which Hickey, Ralston Turner and Andre Stringer all hit threes to put LSU up for good.

### Hickey Backing Up Mr. Basketball Title

Kentucky's Mr. Basketball has shown his worth to the LSU Tigers, averaging 9.7 points per game, 3.8 rebounds and 4.0 assists ... More importantly, he has a positive assist-to-turnover ratio of 85 assists to 41 turnovers (2.1, fourth in the league) ... In SEC games, Hickey has 30 assists and 12 turnovers, a 2.5 ratio, third in the league game only stats ... He also leads the SEC with 47 steals (2.2 average) and is sixth in assists ... Despite having to come off the bench as a penalty for missing a team video session, Hickey responded with the second best scoring game of his career in the Auburn win (1/17) getting 18 points with a season high tying seven rebounds ... He also had six assists and just one turnover in 39 minutes of play ... He made 6-of-12 field goal attempts, including two treys ... At Florida, he was in double figures again with 10 points with two assists and no turnovers.

At Mississippi State, he led an LSU charge in the final two minutes with three treys as LSU came from nine back to within a point in the final few seconds. Hickey finished with 16 points on 6-of-12 shooting, 4-of-7 from the arc with six assists and three steals ... Despite struggling to get a clear shot at the goal against the Wildcats last Saturday, he posted five assists and no turnovers during the course of the game.

Hickey has had 13 games of four assists or more, including a seven-assist-no turnover game versus Ole Miss ... In the seven SEC games, he is 31-of-63 from the field and 15-of-31 from the arc ... He has had three steals or more in 12 games and is certainly on pace to have a steal total that could be in the top 10 for an LSU single season.

### McDonald's All-American Back On Court And Back Starting

Well the broken bone in Johnny O'Bryant III's left hand that he suffered on Jan. 4 and had surgery on Jan. 5, didn't cause him to completely leave the court, but is happy to be back inside the lines playing again because most of the time while practice was going on, he was running around the court trying to keep his conditioning up for his return.

That return came at Mississippi State (1/25) as O'Bryant played 20 minutes with six points and four rebounds ... He returned to the starting lineup against Kentucky (1/28), leading the team with 12 points and nine rebounds in 28 minutes.

Before breaking his hand, O'Bryant III came up big earlier in Charleston Classic in the Northwestern game (11/17) when he hit 6-of-8 field goal attempts in 22 minutes and made 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a 21 point effort. O'Bryant III also had a team high eight boards.

Against South Alabama (11/23), O'Bryant III led the team in rebounds for the second time this season with eight ... He started his first college game against Houston and tied for team rebound lead with seven, five of which were offensive ... He posted 11 points at Rutgers (12/3) and 10 points in the Boise State game (12/10) ... Just like the Houston game, O'Bryant had seven boards against UCI (12/15), but five were offensive ... He recorded his first college double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds at North Texas (12/22) ... He is averaging 8.1 ppg and 6.3 rebounds.

### Warren Adding On To Milestones Of 500-100-100

Warren, who moved back into the starting lineup for O'Bryant against Ole Miss (1/7) and started six games in this stretch, had a double double in the win, although it was slightly overshadowed by the performance of Justin Anderson ... But Warren's double double was just as important as he had 15 points and 11 rebounds (six offensive) ... While it was his first of the year, it was his 12th of his LSU career.

LSU senior Storm Warren continued putting special notes on his career and the most prominent came with 14:15 to go in the first half when he pulled down the first of his six rebounds
