## LSU Returns Home to Face SEC Rival Kentucky

After two weeks on the road in conference meets, No. 14 LSU will be back in the Maravich Center to take on Kentucky at 7 p.m. Friday. The Tigers are looking to hit 196 or higher for the second time this season after narrowly missing 196 at Georgia with a 195.750. LSU benefitted from having sophomore Kaleigh Dickson back in three lineups as she scored a 9.80 or higher in all three events (vault, beam, floor). Freshman Jessie Jordan picked up her first all-around title as a Tiger with a 39.250, while fellow freshmen Rheagan Courville and Lloimincia Hall won the vault (9.95) and floor (9.90) titles, respectively. LSU is seeking to score a 49.0 or higher on all four events for the first time this season. The Tigers came close at Georgia with 48.975's on beam and floor as well as a 48.500 on bars. Kentucky is coming in off a season-high 195.050.

### STORYLINES

- LSU is trying to score a 49.000 or higher on all four events for the first time this season and eclipse the 196.000 mark for the second time.

- LSU is looking to go 2-0 at home for the first since the 2010 season when the Tigers finished 6-0.

- Three of LSU's freshmen have shined all season as leaders on the team, and all three compete in the all-around: Rheagan Courville, Lloimincia Hall and Jessie Jordan.

- For the first time this season LSU might have Maliah Mathis back in the floor lineup. Mathis was

a stalwart in the event last year, scoring a season-high 9.975.

- LSU is looking for revenge against the Wildcats who have beaten the Tigers in back-to-back seasons. LSU lost at Kentucky last season as well as at the Lady Luck Invite in Las Vegas in 2010.

### NOTEBOOK

#### Last Time Out

- LSU made small mistakes that cost the Tigers a chance at a 196 score at No. 7 Georgia as LSU fell 197.250-195.750 last week.
- Freshman Jessie Jordan won the first all-around title of her career with a 39.250, beating teammate Lloimincia Hall by the smallest margin of .025 as both Hall and Georgia's Noel Couch finished with 39.225 scores.
- Hall won her second floor title of the season with a 9.90, and Rheagan Courville posted a 9.95 on vault to win her third vault title of the year.

#### First Road All-Around Title for a Tiger Since 2010

- Jessie Jordan's all-around title at No. 7 with a 39.250 marked the first time an LSU gymnast won the all-around crown away from Baton Rouge since Susan Jackson won the NCAA All-Around title with a 39.625 at the 2010 NCAA Championships in Gainesville, Fla. The title was the first of Jordan's young career.

#### Tigers Looking to Post Regular Season Win Against Kentucky

- LSU is 64-5 all-time against Kentucky, but two of the losses have come in the 2010 and 2011 regular seasons. LSU did beat the Wildcats in both the 2010 and 2011 SEC Championships, but the Tigers have not beaten Kentucky in a regular season dual meet since Jan. 23, 2009.



# D-D Breaux

## HEAD COACH • 35TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to shine as one of the nation's best programs, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accomplishments that includes nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, two Super Sixes in the last four seasons and seven individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2010, LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight year and 22nd time in Breaux's career. Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture NCAA All-Around national title as she became LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 and 2009 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship in 2008. The Tigers finished fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish in program history since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title and one day later Breaux coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the

gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years. Her dedication to the student-athlete on an individual basis has transcended into academic success, community involvement, Coach of the Year honors, SEC Championships, NCAA Regional Championships and top-10 national rankings throughout her tenure.

Now entering her 35th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have finished among the nation's top-10 teams 22 times in 34 seasons, placing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 26 separate occasions, winning regional titles nine times in three different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009. Her teams have included eight individual national titles, 106 All-America honors and 45 All-SEC selections.

Additionally, Breaux's Tigers won the inaugural SEC Championship title in 1981 and have gone on to finish second four times and third five other times.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

## NOTEBOOK CONTINUED

### Tremendous Trio Leading the Way

- Three LSU freshmen have been the catalysts for great scores all season for the Tigers. Rheagan Courville, Lloimincia Hall and Jessie Jordan have led the way for LSU as all-arounders.
- Courville leads the team with four individual titles this season (3 on vault, 1 on floor), while Hall is second with three titles (2 on floor, 1 in the all-around) and Jordan is tied for third with one title in the all-around.
- Both Hall and Jordan have been recognized as SEC Freshmen of the Week this season, the first time in school history that two freshmen have won the weekly honor in the same season.

### Jordan Named SEC Co-Freshman of the Week at Georgia

- Jessie Jordan captured the all-around title with a 39.250 score at No. 7 Georgia, and she set season highs on vault (9.875) and bars (9.750) on the way to her first individual title at LSU.
- Jordan's 39.250 was the highest all-around score by a freshman in the SEC last weekend, beating out teammate Lloimincia Hall who finished .025 behind Jordan for the all-around title at Georgia with a 39.225.
- It also marked the first time an LSU gymnast won the all-around crown away from Baton Rouge since Susan Jackson won the NCAA All-Around title with a 39.625 at the 2010 NCAA Championships in Gainesville, Fla.

### Freshmen All-Arounders Make LSU History

- For the first time in LSU history three freshmen scored a 39.300 or higher in the all-around when Rheagan Courville (39.375), Lloimincia Hall (39.325) and Jessie Jordan (39.300) accomplished the feat on Jan. 20 at No. 3 Arkansas.
- It also marked the first time that three LSU gymnasts scored a 39.3 or better in a single meet since Feb. 20, 2009 in a tri-meet against North Carolina and Illinois-Chicago in Baton Rouge. Ashleigh Clare-Kearney scored a 39.625, Susan Jackson earned a 39.500 and Staci Schwitkiv went 39.350.
- Until this freshmen trio accomplished the feat, the last time three LSU gymnasts went 39.3 or better in an SEC road meet was March 2, 2007 at Alabama when Ashleigh Clare-Kearney scored a 39.500, Kelly Phelan scored a 39.425 and Nicki Butler scored a 39.400.

### LSU Still Hoping to Break the SEC Road Winless Streak

- The last time LSU won on the road in the SEC and came away with a victory was Feb. 13, 2009 when the 11th-ranked Tigers upended the fifth-ranked Alabama Crimson Tide 196.625-195.750.
- Since that victory, LSU is 0-7-1 with the tie coming at Arkansas in 2010. LSU finished 0-2-1 in 2010 on the road against SEC teams, 0-3 in 2011 and is currently 0-2 in 2012.

### LSU Posts a 196.325 in a Loss at No. 3 Arkansas

- LSU earned a season-high 196.325 at No. 3 Arkansas, the highest team score for LSU since the Tigers went 196.350 against Georgia at home last season.
- LSU tallied a 49.500 on vault, the highest vault score since the Tigers went 49.625 in the NCAA Central Regional in 2008.
- The 49.5 is tied for the sixth-best vault score in LSU history.
- All three freshmen all-arounders went 39.300 or better and scored season highs at Arkansas: Rheagan Courville (39.375), Lloimincia Hall (39.325), Jessie Jordan (39.300).

### Oh So Close to a 49.000 or Higher on All Four Events

- LSU tallied a 49.500 on vault, 49.000 on bars, 49.025 on beam and 48.800 on floor at No. 3 Arkansas. The Tigers are seeking their first meet with a 49.0-plus on all four events since Feb. 18, 2011 when LSU did it against Georgia.
- The last time LSU scored a 49.0 or higher in all four events on the road was March 19, 2010 at Centenary, and the last time LSU did it on the road against an SEC opponent was Feb. 13, 2009 at Alabama.

### LSU in the Rankings

- LSU moved up three spots to No. 14 in the newest GymInfo rankings with a season average of 194.900 after scoring a 195.750 at Georgia.
- The Tigers rank fifth on vault with a 49.256 average, 15th on floor with a 48.881 average and 23rd on bars at 48.481.
- Individually, Rheagan Courville is No. 4 on vault with a 9.925 average and 24th in the all-around (39.144). Lloimincia Hall is 17th on floor (9.869,) and Jessie Jordan is 22nd on beam (9.825).
- LSU has been ranked in the Top 25 in 156 consecutive polls and 532 straight weeks. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was more than 10 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.

### Hall Earns SEC Freshman of the Week vs. Auburn

- LSU freshman Lloimincia Hall was named SEC Freshman of the Week after scoring a 39.200 and winning the all-around against Auburn. She also shared the floor title with Rheagan Courville as both tallied a 9.90.
- Hall's 39.200 all-around total was the highest total last week by a freshman in the SEC, and it is the highest score for an LSU gymnast since Sarie Morrison earned a 39.575 on Feb. 18, 2011 against Georgia.

### LSU Adds Britney Taylor to Roster Prior to Arkansas Meet

- Britney Taylor, a junior transfer from Central Michigan, joined LSU prior to the spring semester on Jan. 17, 2012, and she is immediately eligible to compete for the Tigers.
- Taylor comes to LSU after two successful seasons at Central Michigan where she earned Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year and First-Team All-MAC honors in 2010 and Second-Team All-MAC recognition as a sophomore last season.
- While at Central Michigan, Taylor accumulated career highs of 9.875 on vault, 9.825 on bars, 9.850 on beam, 9.850 on floor and 39.275 in the all-around. Taylor posted a 9.80 or higher 16 times as a freshman and 10 times last year.

### Record for Rheagan

- No freshman in the history of LSU gymnastics has scored a 39.175 in the all-around in her first meet as a Tiger until Rheagan Courville accomplished that feat in the Cancun Classic. The previous best was a 38.700 by former great April Burkholder in 2003.

### LSU Takes Fifth in Cancun Classic

- LSU started strong at the Cancun Classic with a 49.200 on vault and struggled after the bye before bars with a 47.975 on bars and a 46.525 on beam. The Tigers rallied for a 48.800 on floor and settled for a 192.500 total, the lowest team score since 1998.
- Despite the team struggles, freshman Rheagan Courville put together a solid meet with freshman season-opening record 39.175 in the all-around, highlighted by a 9.875 on vault and a 9.825 on bars.
- Freshman Lloimincia Hall posted a 9.90 on vault, her first event at LSU. It was the first and only 9.90 of the meet for the Tigers, and it was good enough for second place in the event.

### D-D Breaux Enters Year 35 as Head Coach

- LSU gymnastics is going into its 38th year of existence, and D-D Breaux has only missed the first three seasons as she enters her 35th year as head of the program. Breaux holds a career record of 586-373-8 in 34-plus seasons, winning 61.0 percent of the time.
- In her time as coach, LSU has produced 106 NCAA All-Americans, 106 NACGC/W Scholastic All-Americans, 45 All-Southeastern Conference selections, 144 SEC Academic Honor Roll members, eight NCAA individual national champions, 28 AIAW or NCAA Championships appearances and two NCAA Super Six appearances.

## Opening on the Road

- This is the third time in the last five seasons that LSU will open up the season at the Cancun Classic and the fourth time in the last five years that the Tigers will begin the year away from Baton Rouge.
- The only season in the last five in which LSU opened at home was 2010 when the Tigers hosted Maryland.
- LSU has won three of the last four season openers, taking the Cancun Classic titles in 2008 and 2009 and beating Maryland in 2010. The Tigers lost at Oregon State last season 195.400-193.350.

## Lone Senior

- For the second straight season the LSU gymnastics team only has one senior on the roster. Ashley Lee is the lone senior in 2012. One season ago Samantha Engle was the only senior.
- Until last season LSU had not had a roster with only one senior since 2008 when Kristi Esposito was the only one.

## Returning All-Americans

- LSU returns two All-Americans in 2012. Senior Ashley Lee picked up First-Team All-America honors on vault in 2010 while sophomore Kaleigh Dickson earned Second-Team All-America recognition in the all-around. Dickson's All-America honor was the 106th in LSU history as she became LSU's 10th All-American in the all-around dating back to 1986.
- The Tigers lost one All-American from 2011 as Sam Engle graduated.

## Tough Slate in 2012

- LSU will face three teams ranked in the preseason top 10 this season and nine teams in the top 25, not including the SEC Championship.
- The Tigers have home meets against No. 2 Alabama, No. 17 Auburn and No. 23 Kentucky. LSU will face No. 11 Arkansas, No. 17 Auburn and No. 25 Iowa twice as all three teams will compete at the Cancun Classic. LSU has road meets at No. 3 Florida, No. 9 Georgia, No. 11 Arkansas, No. 16 Washington and No. 25 Iowa.
- LSU will face all six ranked SEC foes at the end of the season at the SEC Championship in Duluth, Ga.
